Assessment of mixed finds from the Brecon to Tirley pipe line project (BRT44)

A small quantity of finds were recovered from fieldwork on the line of the Brecon to Tirley pipeline by Network Archaeology Ltd (Site Code BRT44). All the finds came from plot 430, ID 86010, and where they can be dated are of post-medieval or later date.

Description

Ceramic Building Material

A single fragment of pantile was recovered. Pantiles were first used in Wales and the Welsh borderland no earlier the 17th century although they were introduced to eastern England at least a century earlier.

Clay Tobacco Pipe

A single fragment of a spurred clay tobacco pipe was recovered. The bore diameter suggests a 17th or 18th century date.

Glass

A wall fragment from a dark green bottle was recovered. The size and shape of the fragment and the degree of weathering suggest that it came from a bottle dating between the mid 17th and mid 18th centuries.

Ivory

A fragment of ivory comb was recovered. A photograph of this comb was shown to lan Riddler, a specialist in bone, antler and ivory artefacts, who comments that it is probably 18th or 19th century and of a fairly common type.

Pottery

A fragment of a refined whiteware cup with blue sprigged decoration was recovered. Vessels of this type appear to date to the mid 19th century and later.

Assessment

The finds from Plot 430 form a mixed assemblage of post-medieval and later date. They might be represent the nearby presence of occupation and it is unlikely that the ivory would have survived for long in a ploughsoil.

Further Work

No further work is recommended.

Retention

Assuming that the finds are unstratified, there is little to be gained from retaining these finds for future study. However, it may be that the comb could be used as part of a teaching collection.
