

Assessment of finds from the South Crowborough to Cottage Hill Water Main (ROT 36)

A mixed collection of finds (ceramic building material, fired clay and pottery) recovered from archaeological fieldwork on the line of the South Crowborough to Cottage Hill water main by Network Archaeology Ltd was submitted to the authors for identification and assessment.

The finds include pottery of late medieval or early post-medieval date and a possible fragment of Roman brick. In the main, however, the finds are of post-medieval and later date.

Description

A total of 387 finds were examined and identified (Table 1).

Ceramic Building Material

Two hundred and fifty three fragments of ceramic building material were recorded. Based on their form, fabric, method of manufacture and condition these were divided into four groups (Table 2). Visual examination was also used to divide the material into fabric groups and a representative sample of each fabric was extracted to form a fabric series.

The first group, Roman tile, consisted of a single fragment of brick from Plot 12 (Fabric 5). This was identified as Roman partly through its thickness (29mm) and partly through its unusual fabric.

The main group, medieval tile, consists mostly of fragments of flat roof tile with a single hip tile, a single brick and 17 fragments which are probably from flat tiles. Both square/rectangular and round peg holes were present. Only three were round, indicating that square/rectangular holes were the norm. There was no correlation of fabric and peg hole shape and examples occurred in Fabrics 1, 2, 3, and 6. A distinctive feature of a number of flat roof tiles was the presence of an indented band along one edge. This is presumed to be the result of using a block of wood to tamp the clay into the mould along the edges. Seven examples occurred in total and the bands ranged from 7mm to 22mm in width.

Examples of several Fabric 1 and 2 tiles show signs of overfiring although no examples which could not have been used were present and therefore these tiles might be seconds rather than waste. They occur on eight plots (1, 2, 9, 12, 17, 23, 26 and 27) and therefore form a small element in all the tile assemblages except for the smallest groups (Plots 11, 21, and 25).

Post-medieval material consisted of bricks, in fabrics 1 and 4. Some of these bricks also showed signs of high firing.

Modern material consisted of three fragments of brick and one drain.

Fired Clay and possible Fired Clay

Two fragments of fired clay were recorded. One of these is clearly not deliberately fired ceramic building material whilst the other is too small to be certain. Neither show any signs of their original function.

Clay Tobacco Pipe

Two fragments of clay tobacco pipe stem were recorded. From their bore diameters one was assigned to the later 17th to 18th century and the other to the late 18th or 19th century.

Pottery

Twenty three fragments of well-fired brick red untempered earthenware, similar in fabric to that produced at Lower Parrock, were recorded. Most, however, were glazed and probably later in date than the Lower Parrock material (Freke 1979). Most of these probably came from internally-glazed bowls but one jar, glazed inside and out, and one externally-glazed jug were identified. In the accompanying database these are coded as later medieval wares (lmed).

Eighteen sherds of post-medieval date were recorded. Only two of these were lead-glazed earthenwares (a black-glazed ware, BL, and a misc glazed red earthenware, GRE), suggesting that the redwares described above are actually contemporary with these wares.

The post-medieval vessels include English stonewares and slipwares (London stoneware – LONS, Staffordshire Mottled ware – STMO, Staffordshire Slipware – STSL) and English

white salt-glazed stoneware – SWSG). In addition, one sherd of Frechen stoneware, from the middle Rhine, and one possible example were present. The latter types are of later 16th to mid 17th century date and the English wares of later 17th and 18th century date.

The majority of the pottery, however, consisted of types dating to the later 18th and 19th centuries and includes several types which only came into use in the early 19th century and 24 sherds of miscellaneous refined whiteware (WHITE) of mid 19th century or later date. This pottery includes a range of forms associated with food preparation, dining, tea drinking and gardening and is therefore domestic waste.

Assessment

A comparison of the estimated dating of the ceramic building material and the pottery by plot (Table 4) suggests that the ceramic building material is actually of much later date than that estimated from visual appearance alone. A number of plots produced only early modern pottery (i.e. later 18th century or later) and mainly “medieval” and “post-medieval” ceramic building material. Thus, both the ceramic building material and the pottery appear to have features which in other parts of southern England would point to an early date but in this case appear to be later in date. On this basis, it seems that the first activity which can reliably be identified dates to the later 16th to mid 17th century (the two Frechen stoneware vessels) whilst flat roof tiles with peg holes probably continued to be produced into the later 18th and 19th centuries, at which time in other parts of southern England pantiles seem to have been ubiquitous. No pantiles were recognised in this collection at all.

Using this revised dating, no material earlier than the later 16th century was present and only 41 artefacts of definite post-medieval date were recovered (Table 5). This material shows no strong concentrations but occurs in isolated groups of plots: Plot 2; {Plots 9, 10 and 11; Plot 17; Plots 21, 23 and 24; Plot 26 and Plot 27). These plots are the only ones which can be demonstrated from the finds to have been under the plough in the post-medieval period.

Further Work

No further work is recommended at present on these finds.

Retention

The Ceramic Building Material fabric series should be retained, as should the post-medieval material listed in Table 5. The early modern pottery, the fired clay and the remainder of the ceramic building material collection could be discarded.
