## Abstraction and interpretation of magnetometer anomalies

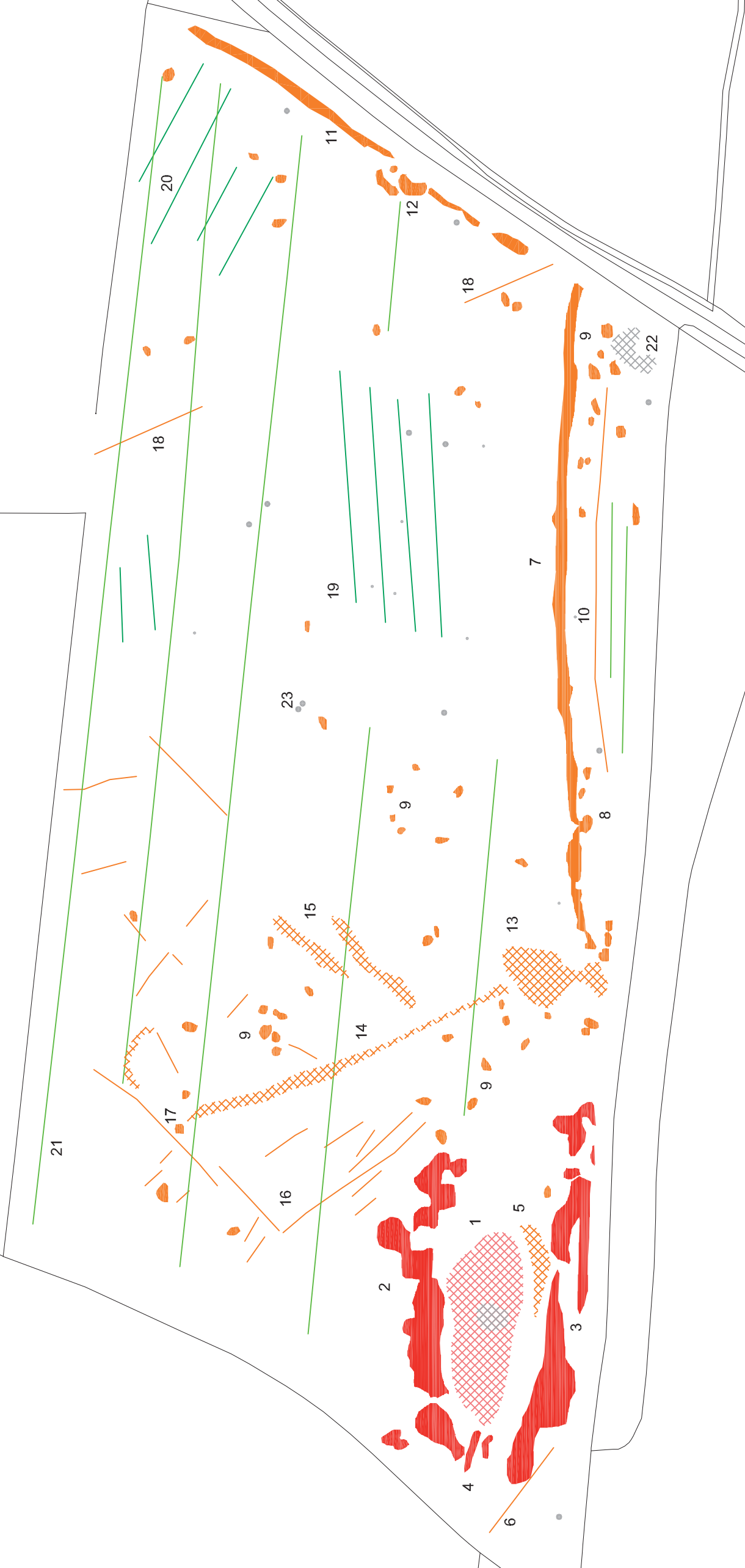
-  Positive linear anomaly - cut feature of archaeological origin
-  Discrete positive response - cut feature of archaeological origin
-  Variable magnetic response - associated with remains of barrow mound
-  Positive linear anomaly - possible ditch-like feature
-  Discrete positive response - possible pit-like feature
-  Weak positive response - of uncertain origin
-  Linear anomaly - of agricultural origin (trend only shown)
-  Linear anomaly - ridge and furrow
-  Magnetic debris - spread of magnetically thermoremanent/ferrous material
-  Strong dipolar anomaly - ferrous object
