

Appendix 2. Barton-Upon-Humber Parish Registers: a Hand-List

Separate registers have been maintained for St Peter's and St Mary's churches at least since 1561–62. There are complete series of registers extant for St Peter's from 1566 and St Mary's from 1570¹. The existence of earlier, separate registers may be deduced from fragmentary transcripts which survived in the Bishop's Registry at Lincoln².

St Peter's Church

Partial transcripts are preserved from a lost burial register of 1561–62, and from a register of baptisms, marriages and burials of 1562–63³. The extant registers comprise 29 volumes, down to the 1960s.
