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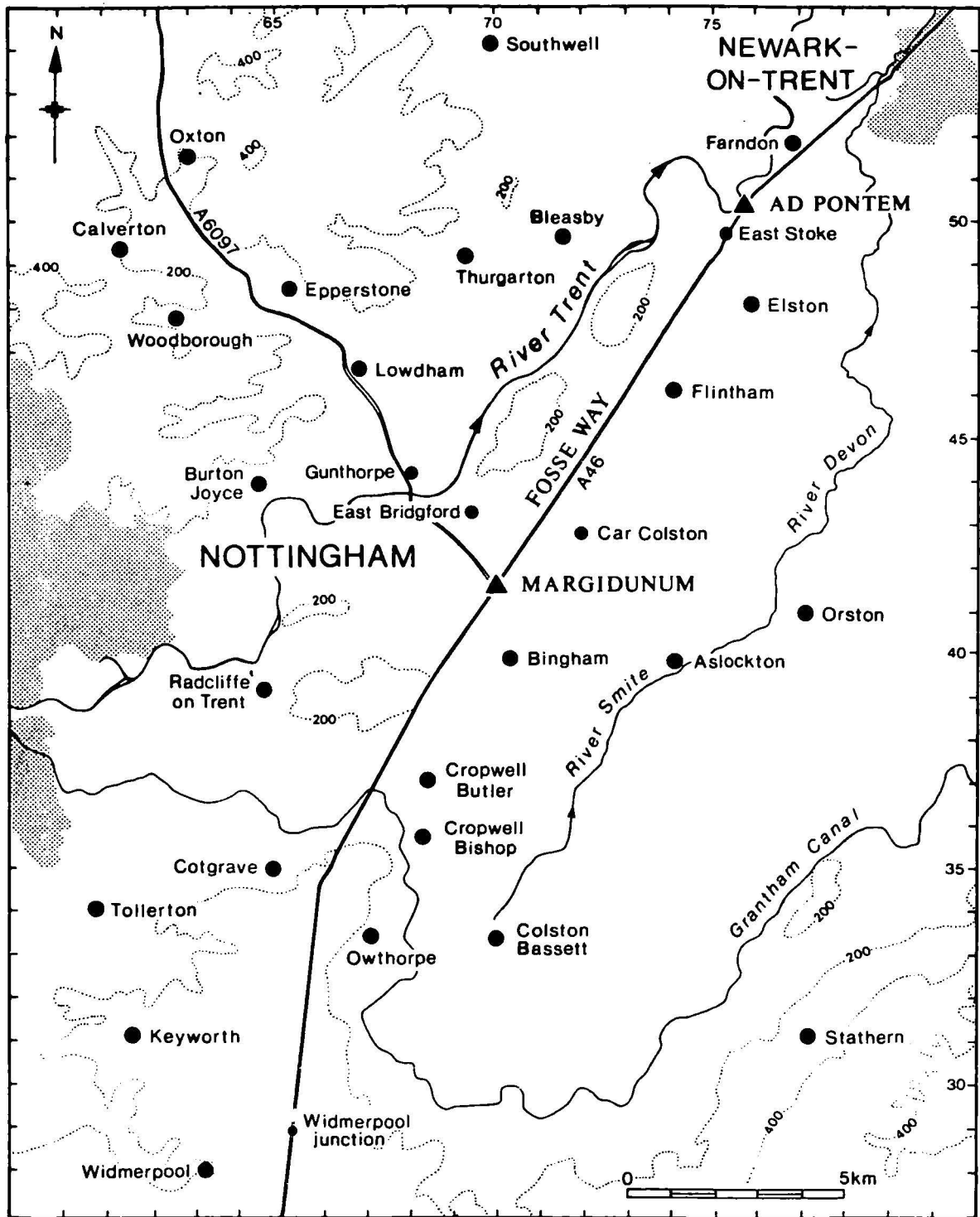


Figure 1. Location of Fosse Way, Widmerpool-Newark.

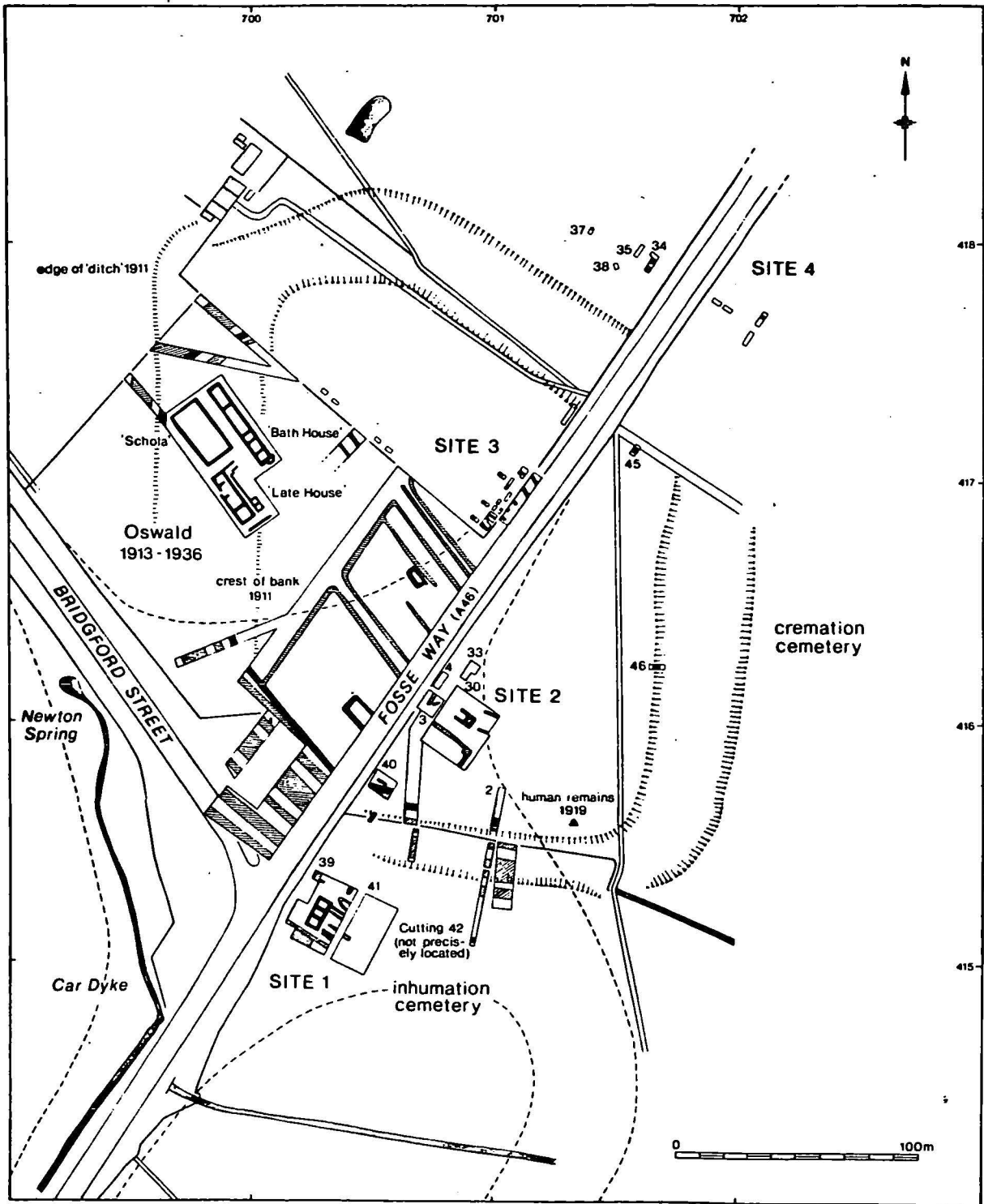


Figure 5. *Margidurum*: Previous excavations in the defended area.

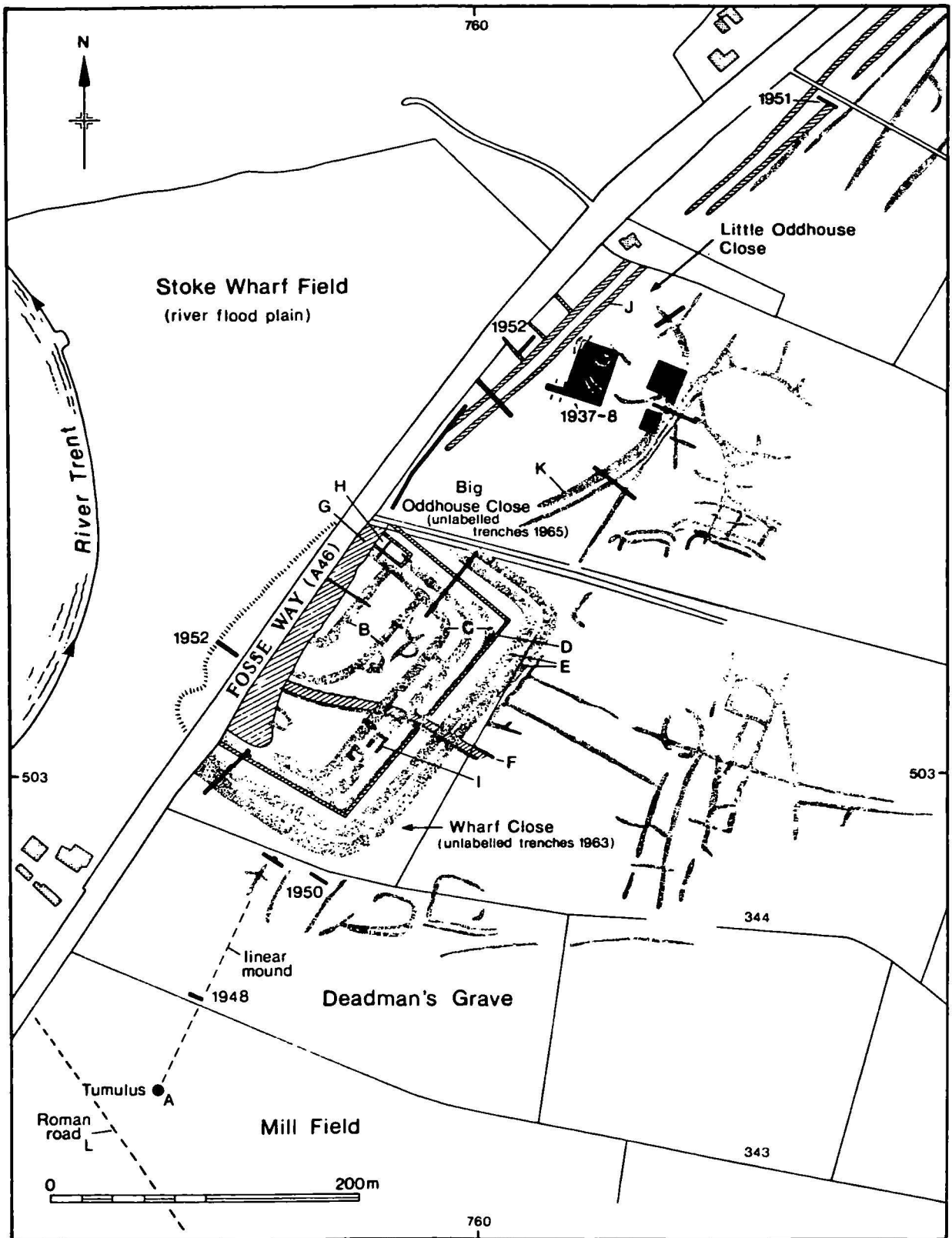


Figure 23. *Ad Pontem*: Plan of cropmark features and excavation areas in the vicinity of the defended area; letters refer to sites mentioned in the text (Sections 1.4.5 and 1.4.6).



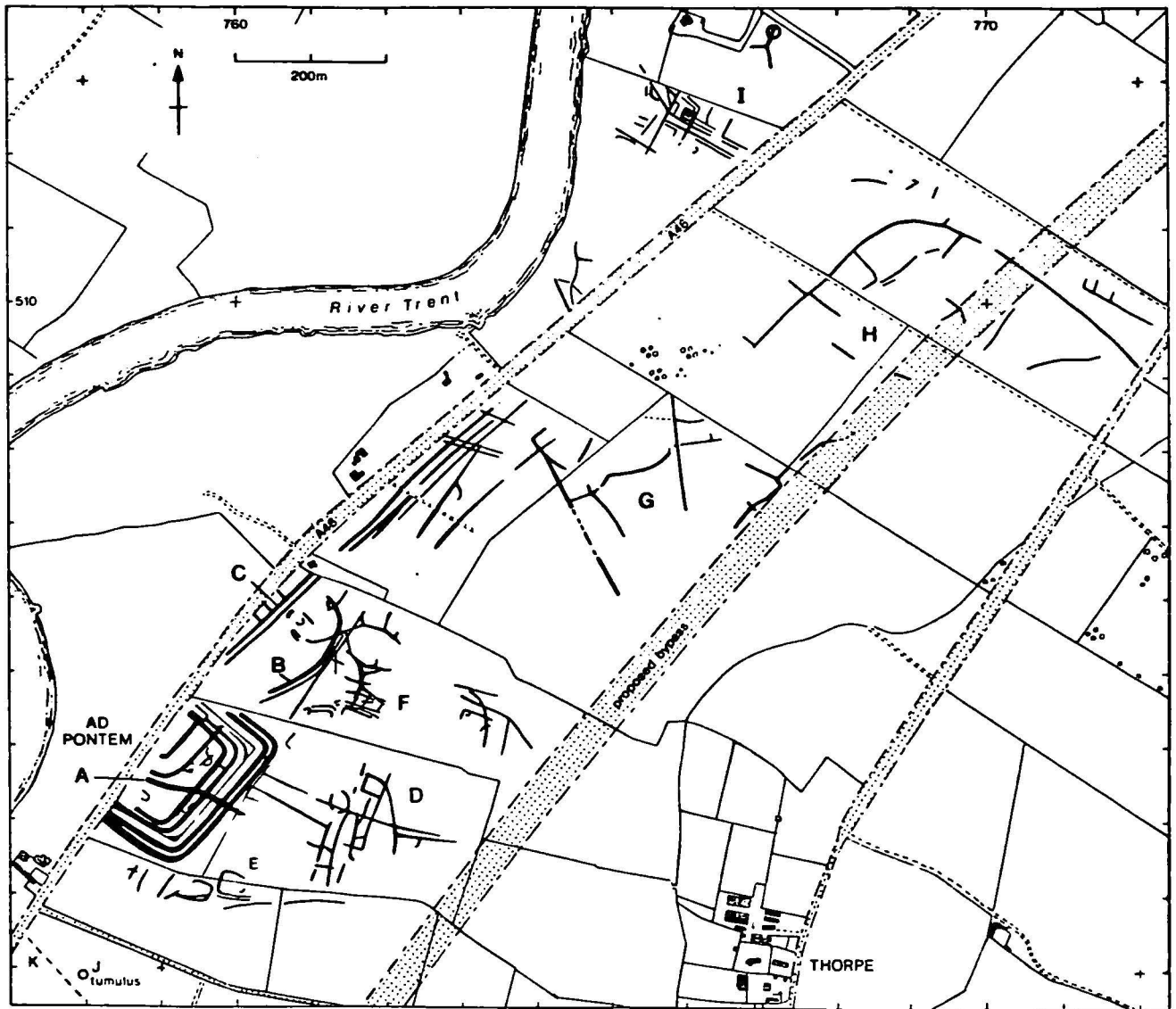


Figure 31. Site 16 (A-K): Cropmarks and finds concentrations in the environs of Ad Pontem.

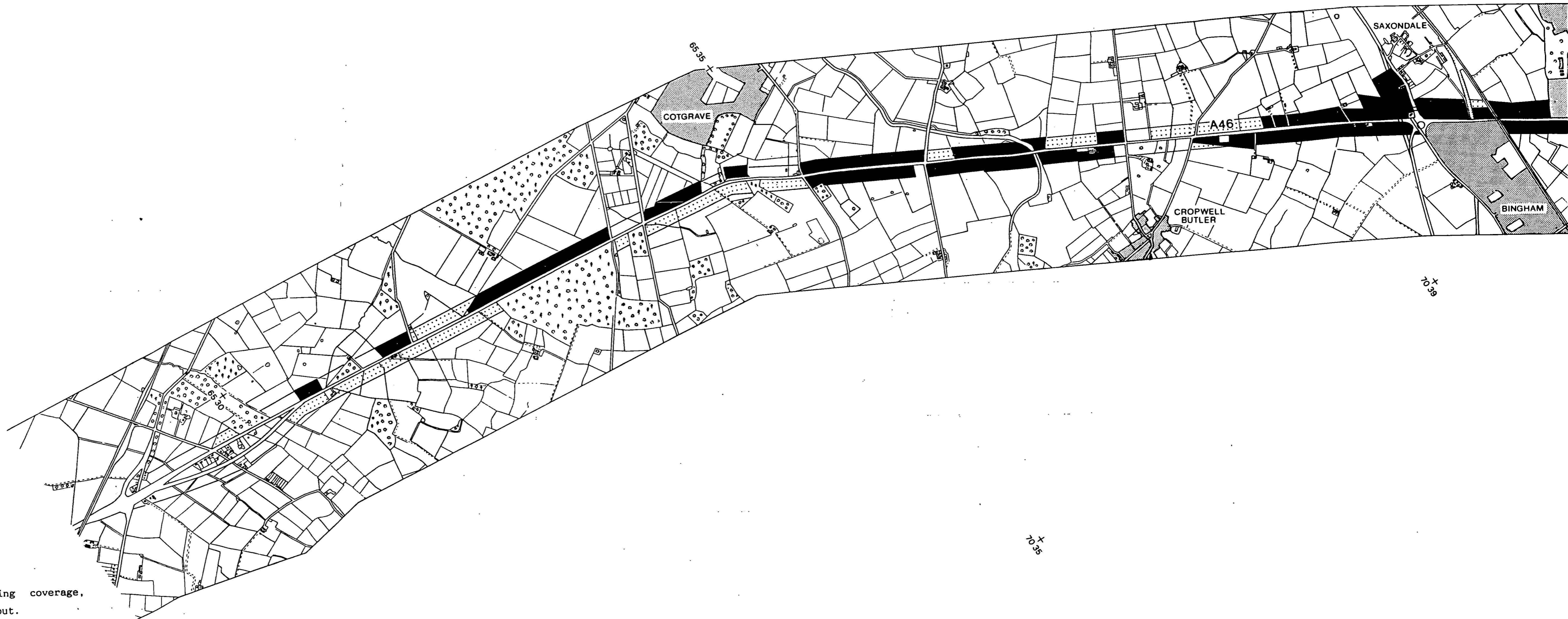


Figure 42. Extent of fieldwalking coverage, Widmerpool to Saxondale roundabout.

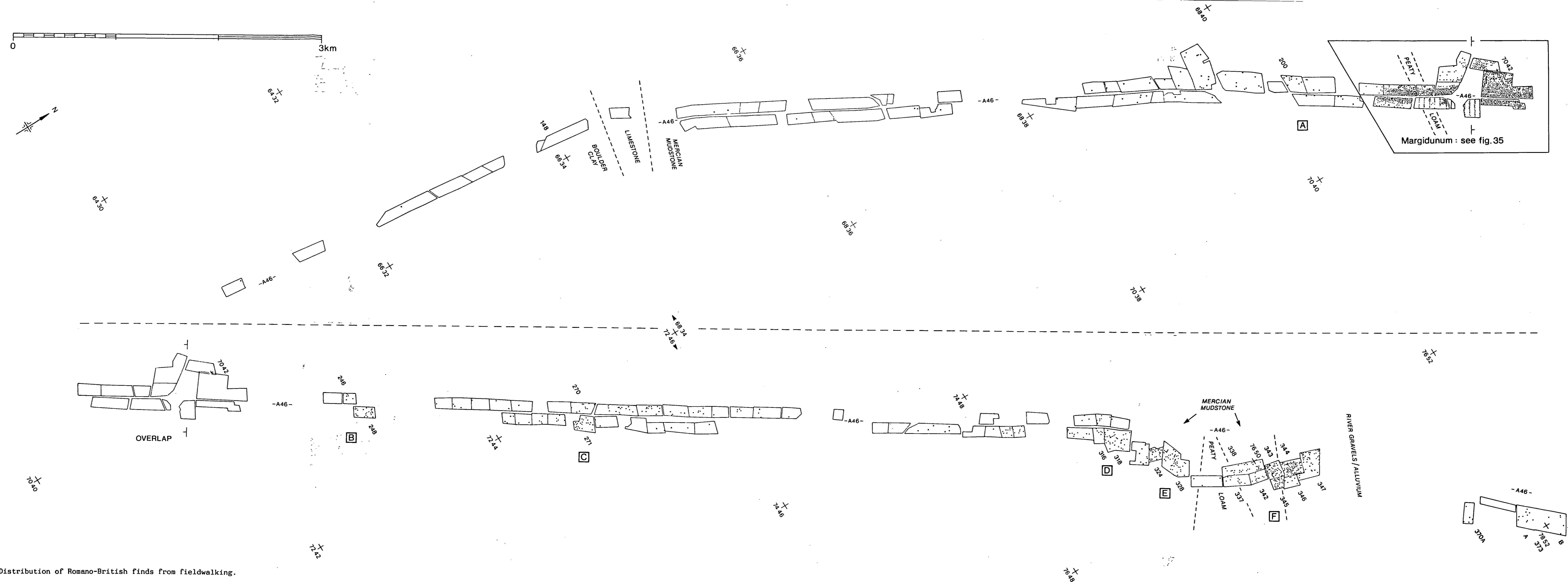


Figure 40. Distribution of Romano-British finds from fieldwalking.




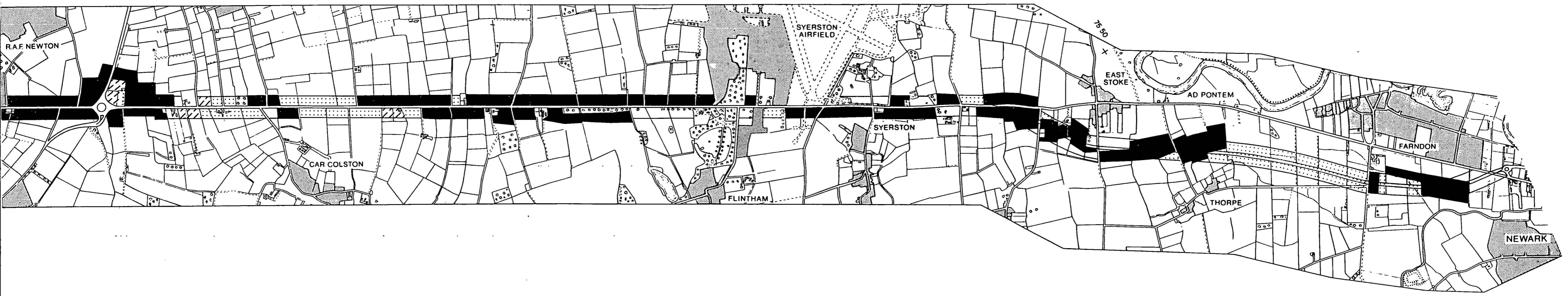
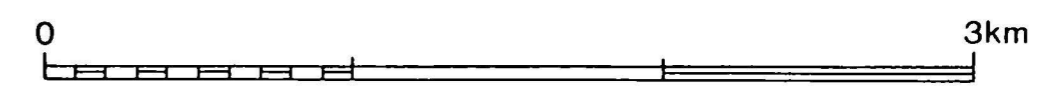


Figure 43. Extent of fieldwalking coverage, Margidunum to Farndon.

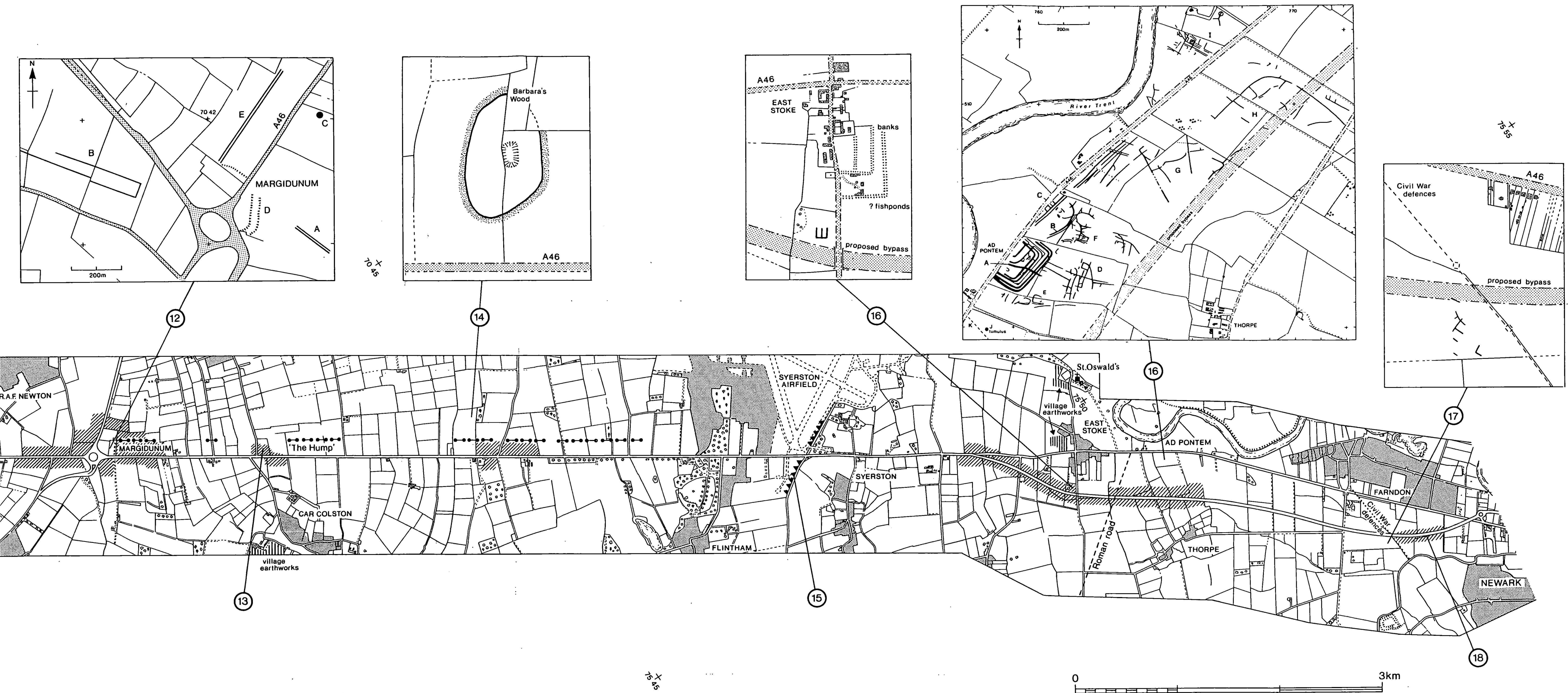


Figure 37. Principal sites threatened by the proposed road, Margidunum to Farndon (Sites 12-18).

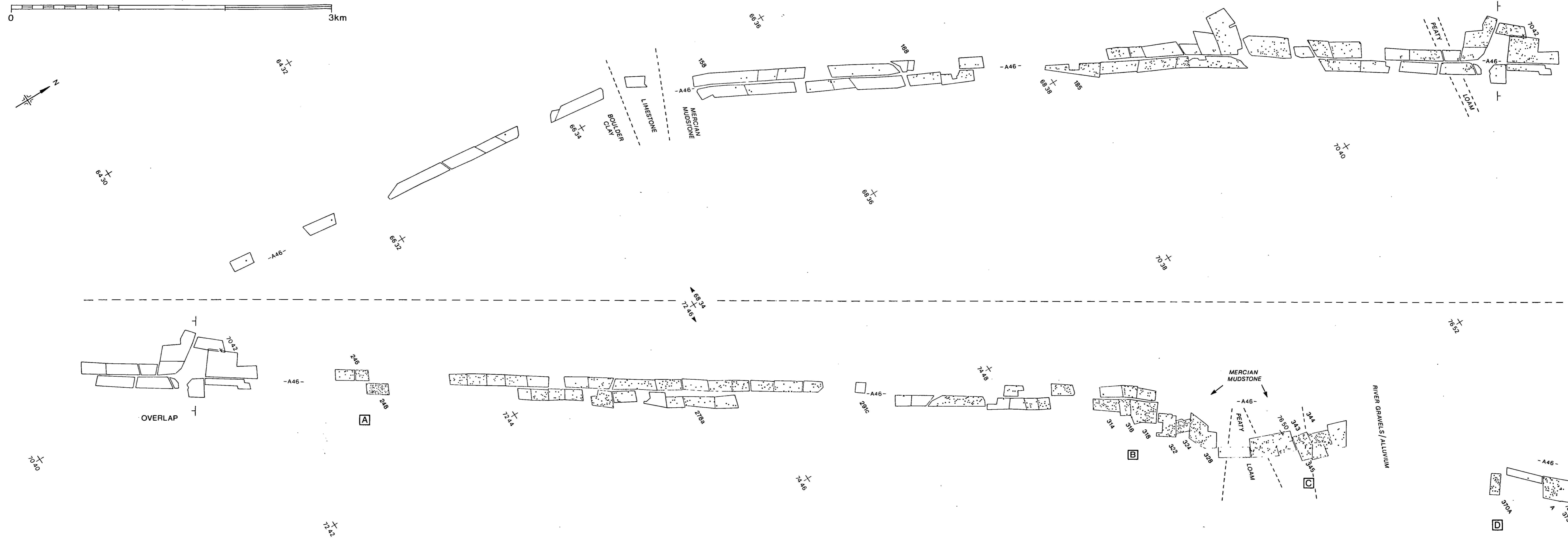


Figure 41. Distribution of medieval finds from fieldwalking.

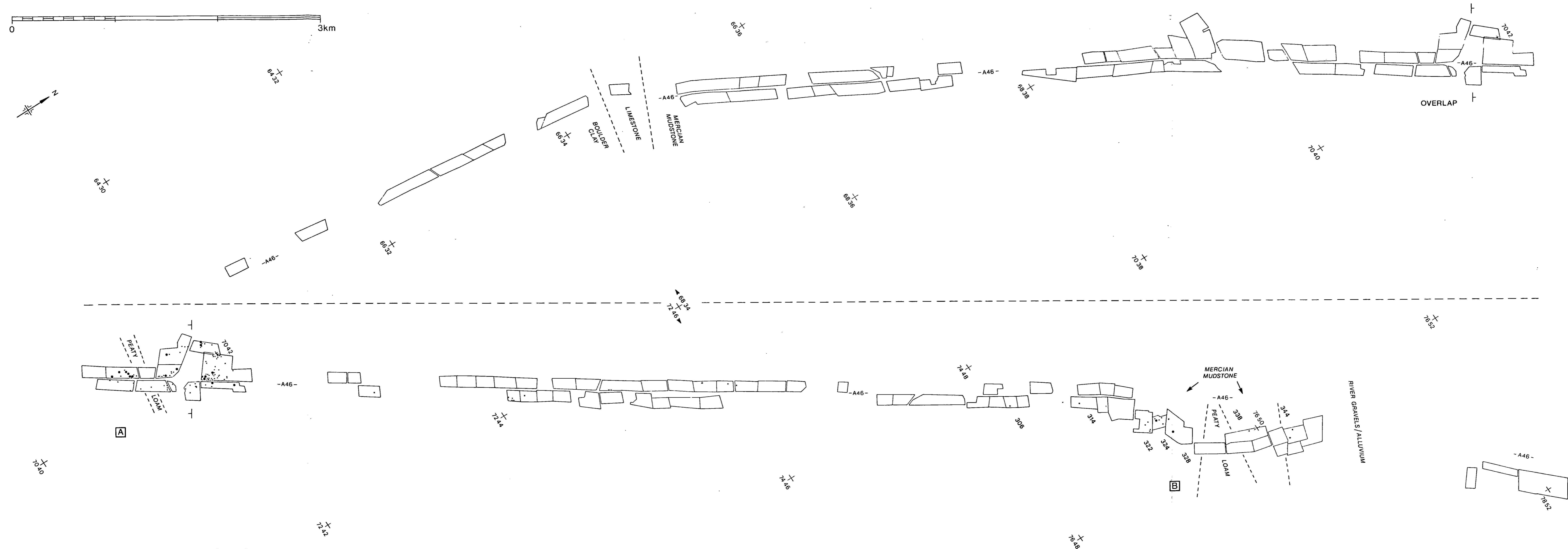


Figure 39. Distribution of Iron Age (large dots) and Iron Age/Anglo-Saxon pottery (small dots) from fieldwalking.

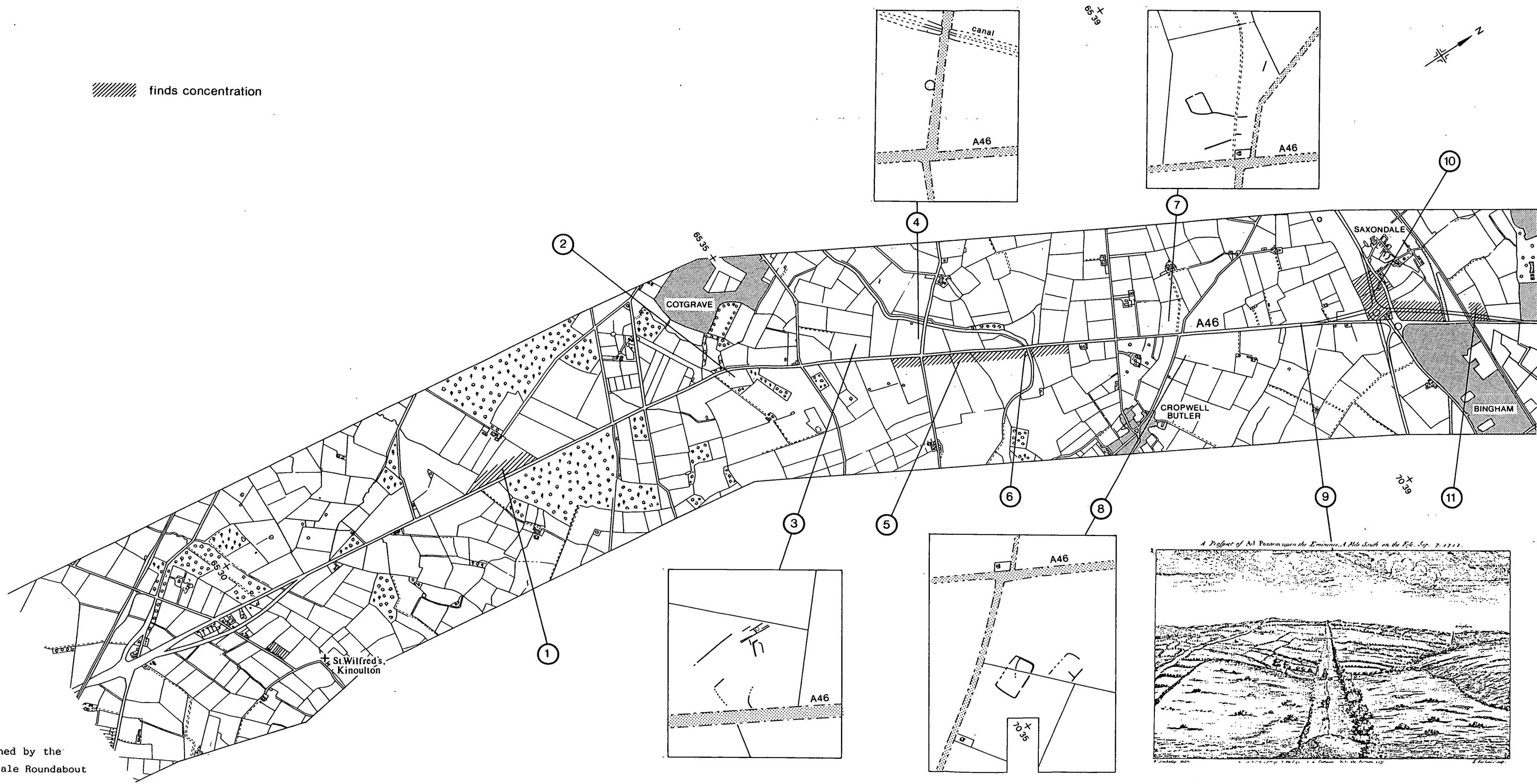
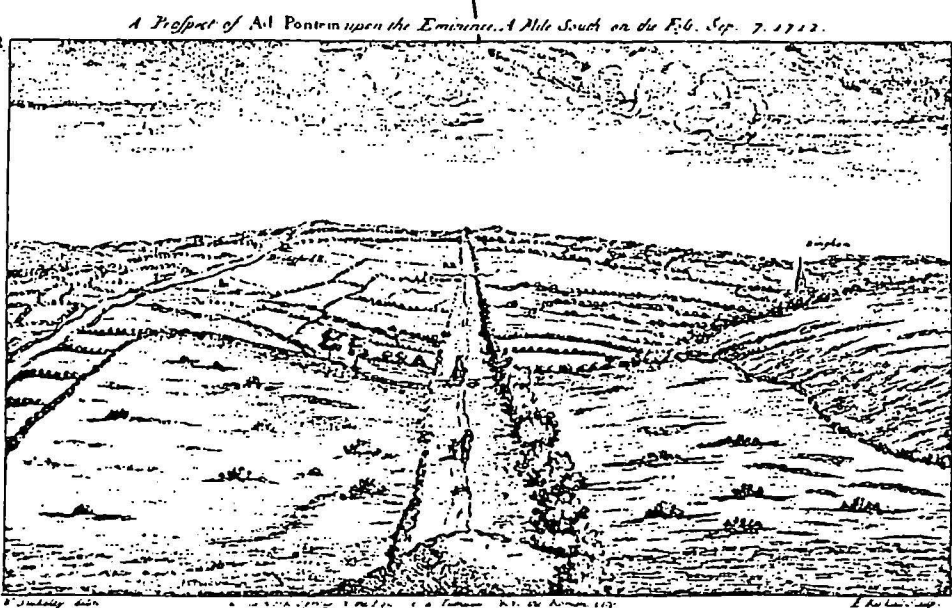
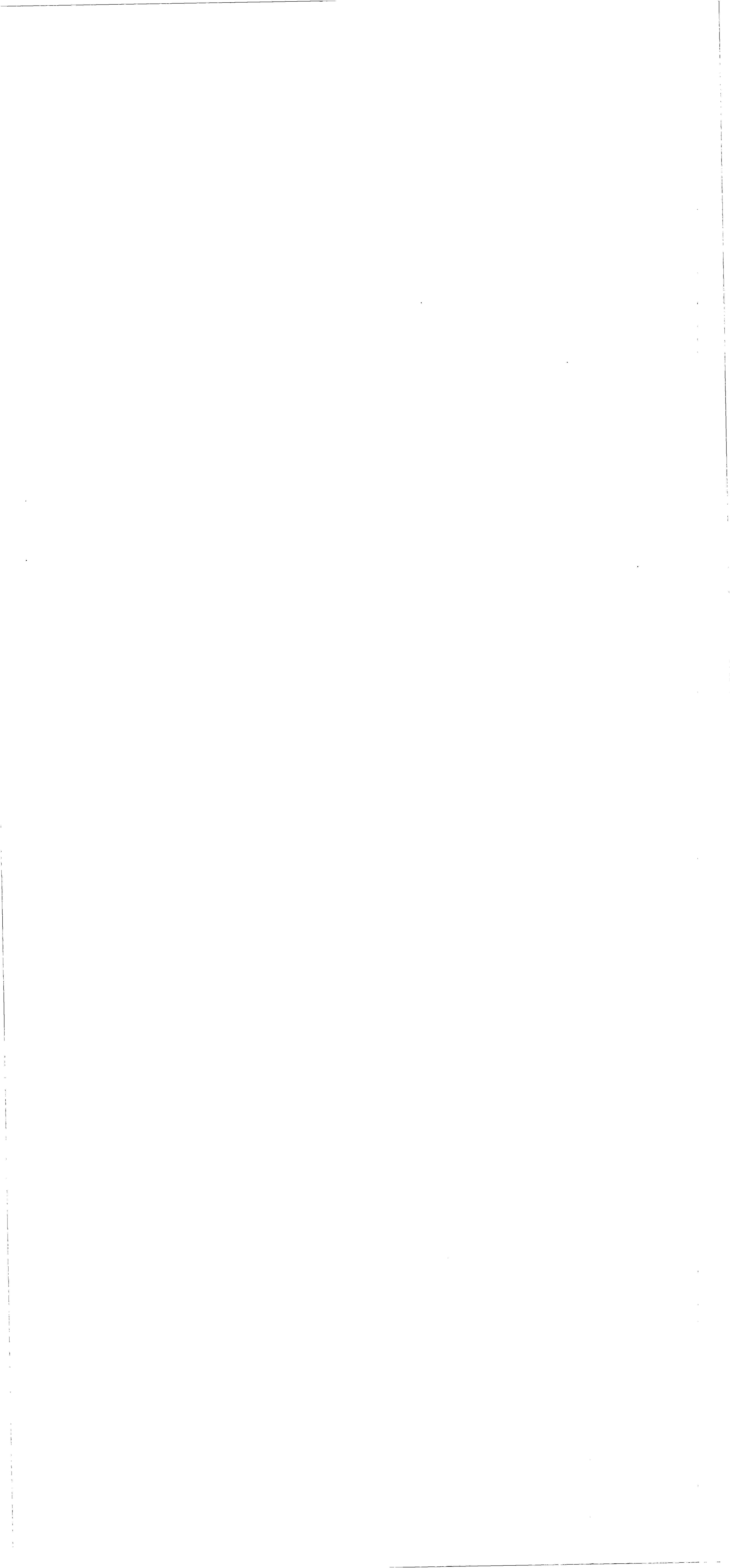


Figure 36. Principal sites threatened by the proposed road, Widmerpool to Saxondale Roundabout (sites 1-11).







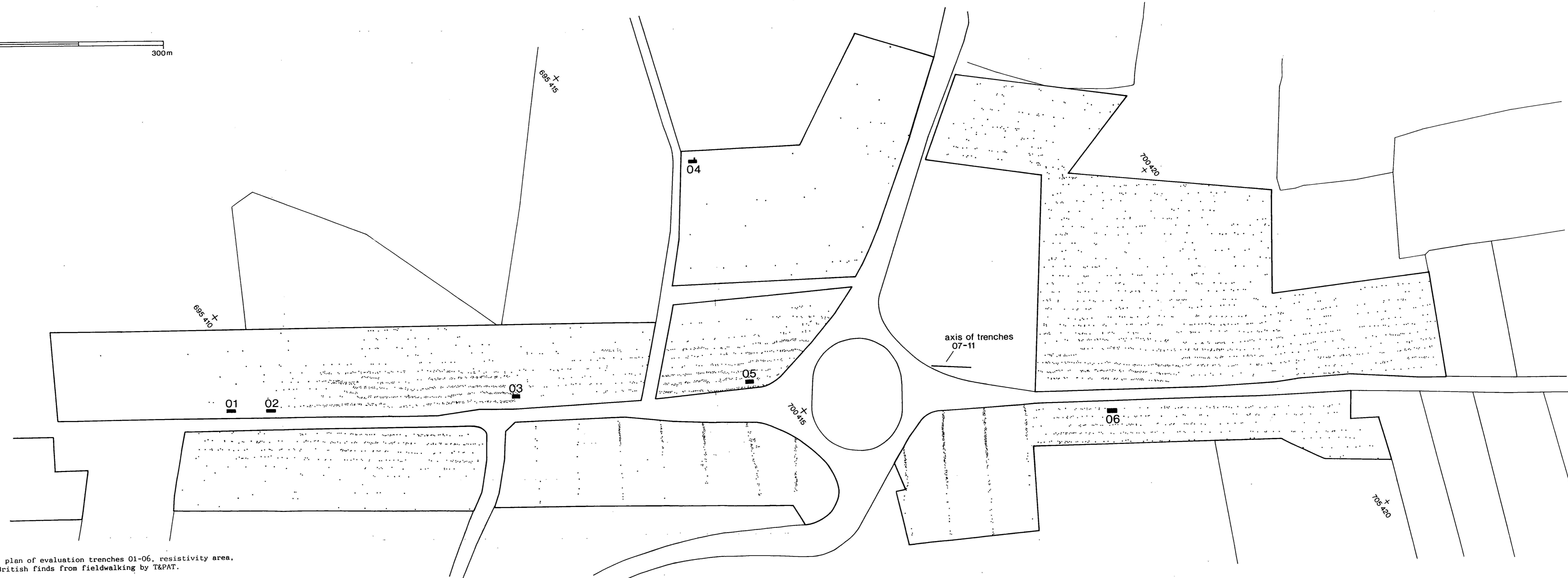
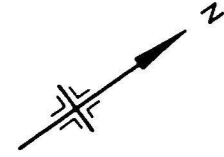
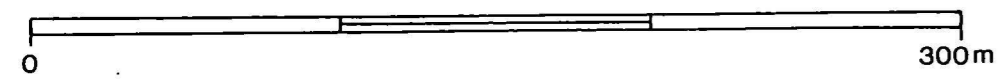


Figure 35. Margidunum: plan of evaluation trenches 01-06, resistivity area, and Romano-British finds from fieldwalking by T&PAT.
