

SUMMARY

A Level 1 standing building survey was carried out on 16 September 2014 at Slampton Park Steading (NMRS no NJ94SE 59). Several phases of building were recorded including fittings associated with the former horse mill. It is recommended that no further work is required during the current development.

1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The site (Illus 1) is located on the south side of the B9030 between Auchnagatt and Stuartfield. It is centred on NGR NJ 95343 42591, at 120-125m OD.
- 1.2 The work was commissioned by Anne Chalmers. Aberdeenshire Council planning application 2014/2510 for erection of a dwellinghouse (Illus 2) was passed on 22.08.14 with archaeology condition (condition 3) for Level 1 standing building survey.
- 1.3 All the archaeological work was carried out in the context of Scottish Planning Policy (SPP) Planning Advice Note (PAN 2/2011) and Scottish Historic Environment Policy (SHEP), which state that archaeological remains should be regarded as part of the environment to be protected and managed.




Illus 1 Location plan (Contains Ordnance Survey data © Crown copyright and database right 2014)


2 THE LEVEL 1 STANDING BUILDING SURVEY

The Level 1 standing building survey was carried out on 17 September 2014; the weather was clear and partly cloudy. Most of the building were accessible but some are very overgrown and some areas were inaccessible. A full photographic survey was carried out and architects plans (Robert J Brand) were annotated. The site consists of a large steading 7.2m wide and 12.55m long. There is a modern breeze block extension on the west end. The building is granite rubble construction with granite lintels, sills and quoins throughout most of the building and has been converted for animal use with concrete and whitewash walls internally. There are two doors in the south wall, one blocked with breeze blocks and these are probably original, Phase 1 doors. At the east end a horse mill was present on the north side of the building and a mortared stone wall attached to the external wall (F3; Illus 6) is where the horse mill attached to the main building. There are two square apertures (F4 and F5; Illus 4, 5) visible inside which would have taken the drive shaft through the wall to the millstones on the interior.


North of this building are three small buildings; Rooms 2/3 the cart shed and Room 5 the lean-to shed were constructed between the First and Second Ordnance Survey maps. Room 2 is the former cart shed and is 6.4m wide and 4.6m long with the cart doors on the west façade (Illus 7). Room 4 is a modern corrugated iron shed and Room 5 a stone lean-to shed 1.3m wide with the door in the east gable.




Illus 7 Cart shed west wall with Door D3 (left) and D4 (right)

3 CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Level 1 standing building survey was carried out on 17 September 2014 and the buildings were recorded. The building seen on the First Edition OS map is substantially longer than the current building and at least one third of the length was removed prior to the Second Edition. The horse mill is present on both maps and a small building (the cart shed) was added in the late 19th century prior to the Second Edition. Several structures to the SE and SW of the steading were present on the First Edition and they appear to have been completely removed by the Second Edition.

A full record of the structure has been recorded and it is therefore recommended that no further archaeological work is carried out during the current planning application.


