
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SUMMARY

A Level 1 standing building survey was carried out on 15 January 2015. A photographic survey was carried out and architects plans and sections were utilised. The earliest building on the site is a 1950s fish house and it is therefore recommended that no further work is required during the current development.

1 INTRODUCTION

The site is at NJ 94599 05258 in the parish of Aberdeen and at 10-15m OD. Aberdeen City Council Planning application P140762 for demolition of two existing commercial properties and erection of new extension has an archaeology condition (condition 2) requiring that a Level 1 standing building survey is carried out prior to demolition. The work was commissioned by Lynne Webster, Hurd Rolland Partnership on behalf of client Piper Seafoods.




Illus 1 Site location (Contains Ordnance Survey data © Crown copyright and database right 2015).

2 BACKGROUND


The site was adjacent to a Granite Works on the Second edition OS map and is part of Torry Foundry (Iron) on the Third Edition OS map (Illus 7). The current building appears to originally date to the 1950s when a concrete blockwork fish house was constructed. It was converted to a joinery business in the 1980s and is now vacant. Buildings 1 and 2 are to be demolished and new buildings constructed for Piper Seafoods.

3 STANDING BUILDING SURVEY

A Level 1 standing building survey was carried out on 15 January 2015. A photographic survey was carried out and architects plan and elevations checked. Building 1 was accessible on the exterior and interior but Building 2 was just accessible on the exterior. Building 1 has a concrete blockwork foundation (Illus 4) and all the structure dates to the mid 20th century or later. There were granite buildings on the site on the 2nd and 3rd Edition OS maps (Illus 7) but there is now no trace of these earlier structures and it is assumed that they were completely demolished in the mid 20th century.


4 RECOMMENDATIONS








Illus 6 Camera points used on this survey


