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
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SUMMARY

A Level 2 standing building survey was carried out on 26 January, 4 and 17 February 2015. Seven buildings were recorded during this survey. Acanthus Architects plans were utilised and annotated and a full photographic survey carried out on both external and internal aspects. Several phases of development of this 19th-century school were recorded and it is recommended that no further archaeological work is required during the current development.

1 INTRODUCTION

The site is located on the NE side of Causewayend and the SW side of Canal Place at NJ 93959 07144 in the parish of Aberdeen and at 15-20m OD. Aberdeen City Council Planning application P141095 for change of use and alterations to former school building and canteen block for student accommodation, demolition of former gymnasium and janitors house and erection of new build student accommodation, landscaping, access and other associated works has an archaeology condition (condition 1) requiring that a Level 1 standing building survey is carried out prior to demolition. Aberdeen City Council Listed Building Consent P141096 for internal and external alterations to the main school building and canteen block requires a Level 2 standing building survey of the gynmasium. The work was commissioned by Bruce Ritchie, Acanthus Architects on behalf of Unite Group Plc.




Illus 1 Site location (Contains Ordnance Survey data © Crown copyright and database right 2015).

2 BACKGROUND

Causewayend School (NJ90NW 1107) is Listed Category C was built in 1875-6 by William Smith, architect. It was part of a scheme of new school construction in heavily populated areas resulting in a shortage of 2500 school places in Aberdeen. It was constructed with Commerce Street, Skene Square, Ferryhill and Gallowgate all completed by 1877 (Wood 2000, 332). The school was enlarged in 1892 by Kelly and Nicol, architects; the City provided an additional 3415 school paces during this decade (*ibid*). It is in the Scots Baronial style of two and three storey construction.

3 STANDING BUILDING SURVEY

The standing building survey took place on 26 January 2015, which was bright, sunny and cold, when the exteriors were recorded and 3 February 2015 when the interiors were recorded.

3.1 Building 1 the former Janitor's House

Building 1 was constructed of granite blocks with concrete lintels probably during the 1930s or 50s (Illus 3). It is 13.7m long and 5.9m high. It has a granite pillar in the south corner forming the south end of an integrated porch. There was no access to the interior during this survey. The building is to be demolished during this work.





3.2 Building 2 former gym hall

The gym hall is a rectangular building constructed of granite blocks with an added boiler house at the SE corner and an added chimney. It is 19.2m long and 11.6m high. Internally there is a large gym hall at the NW end (Illus 6) and changing rooms on either side of the entrance door D11 on the SE façade. The changing rooms were heated from the boiler house via radiators (Illus 7). The SW and NE facades have a series of five windows on the first floor lighting the gym hall. This building is to be demolished during the development.

3.3 Building 3 open-sided covered shelter

This open sided shelter is formed using the granite rubble-built SE wall of the junior school playground with a concrete wall and metal pillars (Illus 4). There is graffiti on the granite and concrete walls. This shelter is to be demolished.

3.4 Building 4 former nursery building


This separate building in use most recently as a nursery was constructed at the same time as Building 6 SW façade and tower; identical doors are seen in both buildings (Illus 10). The building is constructed of quarried granite blocks and is 2-storeys with a large room on the ground and first floors and a stairwell on the SW. It is 11.94m N-S, 14.3m E-W and a maximum of 11.6m high.

3.5 Building 5 open-sided covered shelter

In the SE corner of the playground is a granite walled open sided shelter the poured concrete roof and pillars (Illus 12).





3.6 Building 6 former school building


Building 6 was the main school building and is a 2 and 3-storey building constructed in at least 2 phases, Phase 1 in 1875-6 and Phase 2 in 1892. The northern section of the school is Phase 1 with a tower with balustrade (F2) and turret stair (F3) and an '1876' date plaque over W13 on the SW façade (Illus 14). The block is 24m NW-SE, 14.94m NE-SW and 16.9m high). The turret stair NE façade (Illus 17) may originally have been intended as an external feature suggesting a freestanding tower in the first phase of the build. The NW block with gable on to Causewayend (11.5m NW-SE, 7.66m SW-NE and 13.52m high) has scrolled spike finials on top of the SW and NE gables and may be a Phase 2 extension. The SE wing 35.5m NE-SW, 9.38m NW-SE and a maximum of 17.75m high) is a Phase 2 extension.



The tower is three storeys with a flat roof and is 16.8m high and 6.58m wide; the internal ceilings are poured concrete (Illus 21). The turret stair is 1m diameter at the top (Illus 20) and rises to a maximum of 19.94m high and is topped with a granite cap (Illus 18).

There is an Aberdeen City Council plaque on the SW façade adjacent to Door D5 for Alberto Morocco (Illus 22), artist who attended the school.





3.7 Building 7 cast iron pillared shelter

An open shelter constructed of cast iron pillars with a slate roof is 8.26m long, 3.66m wide and 2.1m. The open panels have been infilled with wood to create a shed.













