
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SUMMARY

A Level 1 standing building survey was carried out on 28 July 2015. The original early 19th century L-shaped mill was extended prior to the 2nd Edition OS map (Illus 11) with an extension to the NW which was later demolished leaving a low walled enclosure (Room 4). An extension was also added to the SW and again this was demolished leaving tying in stones on the SW gable. A room added to the centre of the mill in the L between Rooms 1 and 2 was demolished prior to this survey. It is recommended that no further archaeological work is required during the current planning application.

1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The site (Illus 1) is located on the SW side of the Cortachy to Glenprosen Village Road north of Tulloch Hill. It is centred on NGR NO 35720 62970, at 240-250m OD (Illus 1) and in the parish of Cortachy and Clova.
- 1.2 The work was commissioned by John Boath. A planning application 15/00367/FULL was passed by Angus Council on 12 June 2015. Condition 1a is a requirement for a Level 1 standing building survey.
- 1.3 All the archaeological work was carried out in the context of Scottish Planning Policy (SPP) Planning Advice Note (PAN 2/2011) and Scottish Historic Environment Policy (SHEP), which state that archaeological remains should be regarded as part of the environment to be protected and managed.




Illus 1 Location plan (Contains Ordnance Survey data © Crown copyright and database right 2015)

2 BACKGROUND


The remains of a mill are depicted on historic OS maps (NO36SE0057; Illus 14-16). The 1st edition shows two L-plan structures, the western one with attached enclosures to the north. To the southeast is a dam and mill pond and an L-plan mill. By the time of the 2nd edition the mill building to the southeast has been altered and extended. The mill is now ruinous and the mill pond has been infilled (Aberdeenshire SMR online).

3 THE LEVEL 1 STANDING BUILDING SURVEY

A level 1 standing building survey was carried out on 28 July 2015; the weather was bright and sunny. Architects plans were checked and drawings of all the major elevations were made.

Phase 1

The Phase 1 mill is 13m NW-SE and 13.9m NE-SW and consisted of three rooms. The buildings are constructed of granite and sandstone rubble with granite lintels, quoins and jambs except Room 1 cart doors D3 and D4 which has red sandstone lintels (both cracked; Illus 9) on the SW façade. Room 2 is the main mill and Room 3 the wheelhouse (Illus 4, 5). Room 2 has doors in the NW and SE walls and the driveshaft mechanism for the wheel

survives in the SE wall (F2; Illus 7). The walls of the main building are 0.6m thick and Room 3 the wheelhouse has walls 0.55m thick. Roofs survive only on the wheelhouse which is in a poor condition.

The wheel pit (F1) is a maximum of 4.9m deep (from the wall-head) and is contained in a slate roofed building added on to the SE wall of Room 2. An aperture through the wall (F2) is $0.5 \times 0.5m$ in size houses the cast iron driveshaft for the mill wheel (Illus 7); the wheel has been removed.

Beam slots on the NW and SE walls of Room 2 and upper windows throughout indicate that the mill had a first floor throughout.





4 CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

A Level 1 standing building survey was carried out on 28 July 2015. An extension was also added to the SW and again this was demolished leaving tying in stones on the SW gable. 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


Illus 12 Pont map showing approximate area of Cally Mill (copyright National Library of Scotland)




Illus 13 Gordon map of 1636-52 with 'Glencaly' (copyright National Library of Scotland)



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
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
