Land at Chapelpark, Oldmeldrum, AB51 0PQ Report on Archaeological evaluation





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
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SUMMARY

The archaeological evaluation was carried out on 11-12 September 2015 and eight trenches were excavated. The field has been pasture for many years but has been intensively cultivated in the past. No significant archaeological remains were uncovered and it is recommended that no further archaeological work is required during the current planning application.

1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The site (Illus 1) is located on the N side of Oldmeldrum, on the E side of the A947, the SE side of the B9170 south of Chapel Park House. The area is an agricultural field. It is centred on NGR NJ 81187 28096, at 120-130m OD (Illus 1) and in the parish of Meldrum.
- 1.2 The work was commissioned by David Dalton, William Lippe Architects on behalf of Mr and Mrs Paterson. A planning application enquiry ENQ/2015/0299 for Residential Development, Transport Interchange and Road Widening (B9170) would require a 5-7% archaeological evaluation.
- 1.3 All the archaeological work was carried out in the context of Scottish Planning Policy (SPP) Planning Advice Note (PAN 2/2011) and Scottish Historic Environment Policy (SHEP), which state that archaeological remains should be regarded as part of the environment to be protected and managed.

2 ARCHAEOLOGICAL BACKGROUND

- 2.1 There are no Scheduled Ancient Monuments within 1km of the proposed development and no known archaeological sites within the boundary.
- 2.2 There are 92 sites of archaeological and historic significance within 1km of the proposed development. Immediately north of the B9170 is Meldrum House (NJ82NW 13; now a hotel) a 17th and 18th century baronial mansion (Shepherd 2006, 176-77). There is rig and furrow in the south area of Meldrum House grounds (NJ82NW 131, 133) and the house's South Lodge (NJ82NW 13.5).
- 2.3 Immediately south of the proposed development site is St Matthew's Episcopal Church (NJ82NW 61) built 1863 and still in use (Shepherd 2006, 178).
- 2.4 The proposed development site has been fields since the First Edition OS maps (Illus 3-5). Earlier maps reveal no further information about this site and no features can be detected on readily accessible aerial photographs (Illus 6).

3 THE ARCHAEOLOGICAL EVALUATION

The archaeological evaluation was carried out on 11-12 September 2015 and eight trenches were excavated totalling 5% of the 3.2 hectare site (Illus 2) with a 22 ton tracked machine with 2.2m ditching bucket.

The topsoil was 0.2m at the E of the site up to 0.5m at the W and the subsoil was sand and gravels on the E side and clays on the W. The field slopes down to the W and has been pasture for many years. At the W of the site deep plough scores were recorded on the natural subsoil and two rigs in Trench 5 ran WNW-ESE and two in Trench 4 ran NE-SW.

There was a concrete foundation at the E end of Trench 4 where there were numerous brick, tile and concrete fragments in the topsoil. No finds were recovered at the W end of the field.





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
