

SUMMARY

A Level 1 standing building survey was carried out on 2 February 2016. The structures are early 19th-century in date and are typical Aberdeenshire farmhouse (Building 1) and bothy (Building 2). Four phases of development of Building 1 were recorded and it is recommended that no further archaeological work is required during the current planning application.

1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The site (Illus 1) is located on the N side of the A93 North Deeside Road, SW of Drumoak. It is centred on NGR NO 7667 9774, at 80-85m OD (Illus 1) and in the parish of Drumoak.
- 1.2 The work was commissioned by Stephen Taylor, Upper Park East. A planning application APP/2015/2532 for demolition of dwellinghouse and outbuilding and erection of 2 No dwellinghouses was approved on 13.10.15 with a condition requiring a Level 1 standing building survey (condition 2).
- 1.3 All the archaeological work was carried out in the context of Scottish Planning Policy (SPP) Planning Advice Note (PAN 2/2011) and Scottish Historic Environment Policy (SHEP), which state that archaeological remains should be regarded as part of the environment to be protected and managed.

2 BACKGROUND

The buildings are not Listed and are not on CANMORE database. On the 1st Edition OS map the house has an extension added to the N and there is a small separate bothy to the W. The plan of buildings is retained on the 2nd and 3rd Edition OS maps but the small bothy does not appear on either map. It is a small stone building which appears to have been constructed in the 19th century and may therefore have just been omitted from the later maps. It may have been unroofed by the 2nd Edition OS map.

3 THE LEVEL 1 STANDING BUILDING SURVEY

A Level 1 Standing Building Survey was carried out on 2 February 2016. Two buildings were photographed, Building 1 the farmhouse and Building 2 the bothy. Architects plans were checked and annotated and interior plans of Building 1 were drawn. Most of the exterior surfaces are harled and most of the internal rooms have been at least partially modernized although there are original doors and wood surrounds, fireplaces, cornicing and external wooden shutters throughout the Phase 1 structure.

Building 1

Phase 1 (early 19th century)

Building 1 was built in at least four phases. The Phase 1 farmhouse is 12.5m W-E and 8.5m N-S. The walls are 0.55m thick and are constructed of granite blocks with cherry cocking. The roof is slate and the windows have all been replaced in the recent past. The building has two storeys high with a central door on the S façade (D1). There are four main rooms on the ground floor and stairs to a second floor (Illus 2). There is an alcove in the SW corner of Room 1 and a fireplace on the W wall of Room 3 (Illus 11); all the other fireplaces have been removed or covered. There are original door surrounds throughout, cornicing and exterior shutters (Illus 12) on the ground floor windows.

On the first floor (Illus 3) there are 4 main bedrooms and a small windowless box room on the S wall within the roof space (Room 10). There are fireplace settings in each of the four main bedrooms, all painted over and blocked (F8-11).

Phase 2 (early to mid 19th century)

In Phase 2 an extension is built onto the N side 6.2m N-S and 5.5m E-W. There are 2 windows on the E aspect and possible window (W16, W17) and fireplace/flue (F12) on the exterior of the N wall (Illus 7). Door D10 had been the Phase 2 back door. In Phase 2 an extra room was added on the first floor (Room 14) in the roof space above. A corridor between Rooms 5 and 6 leads to the Phase 2 and 3 rooms and Window 10 may have been added in this phase to allow a little natural light into this corridor (Illus 13). The crenelated rusticated granite detail harled porch (F13; see cover illus) may have been added in this phase.

Phase 3a (pre 1st Edition OS map)


In Phase 3 an extension is built in the NW corner of the building between the N wall of the Phase 1 farmhouse and the W wall of the Phase 2 extension (Illus 9-10). It is 4.8 x 3.2m in size and is of granite construction. In this phase D2 became the main back door of the building.

Phase 3b (pre 2nd Edition OS map)


Illus 17 shows Phase 3a and 3b; there is no evidence visible on the building of this smaller addition in Phase 3a and an extension in Phase 3b but the First Edition OS map (Illus 18) shows a small addition with the 3b addition by the Second Edition OS map (Illus 19).

Phase 4 (20th century)

A small extension was added on the W side of Room 8 (including Window W7); it is harled over 20th century red brick. A wooden shed has been added to the N of the building (Illus 7).



Illus 2 Building 1 ground floor plan annotated with numbers used in this survey (from copyright lan Duncan Architects)




Illus 3 Building 1 first floor plan annotated with numbers used in this survey (from copyright lan Duncan Architects)


Illus 5 Building 1 E elevation; facing W







Building 2

Building 2 is a small bothy to the W of Building 1 and is 4.2m W-E and 3.3m N-S (Illus 14). The walls are 1.9m high and 0.5m wide and are constructed of pink and grey granite blocks with cherry cocking (Illus 15). The E gable has a door (D3) and small window above (W14) and the W gable has a small upper window (W13). The interior is whitewashed with concrete floor and wooden shelves (Illus 16).



Illus 14 Building 2 plan and elevations annotated with numbers used in this survey (from copyright Ian Duncan Architects)






Illus 17 Phase plan (from copyright Ian Duncan Architects)










