
# URY HOUSE, URY ESTATE, STONEHAVEN, AB39 3ST LEVEL 2 STANDING BUILDING SURVEY

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## **SUMMARY**

A Level 2 standing building survey was carried out between October 2014 and June 2016 during the soft strip of Ury House. Architects plans and elevations were annotated and a photographic survey carried out of internal and external walls and features. No access to the upper floors was possible during the first visits but when replacement floors were added and most areas became accessible and were recorded.

Ury House is a country house built by John Baird of Glasgow in 1855 to replace an older house and a sketch exists of this earlier house. Baird closely modelled the plans for Ury on Burn's Carstairs with its big square entrance tower and porte cochere and mullioned and transomed windows. A wing was added 1884 by an unidentified architect and the building was abandoned after 1945 and was roofless at the first stages of the survey; new floors and roof were added part way through the survey. It is constructed from sandstone ashlar, a 'grotesquely affluent Tudor mansion'. Two phases of development of the main house were identified with several smaller modifications.

The walled garden and ice-house, which are due to be redeveloped during a later phase, still require completion of the Level 2 Standing Building Survey.

## 1 BACKGROUND

- 1.1 Ury House (Illus 1) is located on the N side of the A90 W of its junction with the B979 Netherley Road and N of the Cowie Water. It is centred on NGR NO 85922 87718, at 40-60m OD in the parish of Fetteresso.
- 1.2 The work was commissioned by Dougal Morgan, WCP Architects. Aberdeenshire Planning Application APP/2014/1714 for alterations and reinstatement of derelict mansion house for use as hotel with associated car parking, landscaping and engineering works, including refurbishment of ice house and refurbishment and alterations of walled garden was passed on 26.8.14 with a standard archaeology condition (condition 8). Aberdeenshire Archaeology Service would require a Level 2 Standing Building Survey of the house, ice house and walled garden and an archaeological watching brief over any proposed groundbreaking works. It is understood that the bridges are now not included in the application but remains of the Cowie Line should be recorded if there is to be any alterations made to the bridges or associated structures (Illus 2).
- 1.3 All the archaeological work was carried out in the context of Scottish Planning Policy (SPP) Planning Advice Note (PAN 2/2011) and Scottish Historic Environment Policy (SHEP), which state that archaeological remains should be regarded as part of the environment to be protected and managed.

## 2 ARCHAEOLOGICAL BACKGROUND

- 2.1 There is one Scheduled Ancient Monument within 1km of the proposed development. Cowie Line, pill boxes (NO88NE 88.01, 88.02) & anti-tank blocks (NO88NE 88.05) is 200m SW to 275m SE of Ury House. The monument comprises two Type-22 pill boxes, situated on high ground to the S of the Cowie Water, covering the bridge over the river SE of Ury House, and its approaches. The pill boxes are 6-sided, made of a mixture of granite, concrete and brick. The western pillbox has additional firing loops on two sides. There are also concrete tank blocks on both sides of the bridge and 6 fine examples to the NW of the western pill box on the S bank of the Cowie Water. To the W of the bridge the southern bank of the Cowie Water has been made vertical to provide a further obstacle. To the E of the bridge, in a wood, is a possible weapon pit. Three areas are to be scheduled. The westernmost contains one pill box and 6 concrete tank blocks. It measures a maximum of 100m WSW to ENE by 60m transversely. The middle area contains the second pill box, the artificially-altered section of the river bank, and one concrete tank block. It measures a maximum of 100m E to W by 40m transversely. The easternmost area contains two tank blocks and the possible weapon pit. It measures 40m NNE-SSW by 30m transversely. All three areas are bounded on their N sides by the river bank, and are as marked in red on the accompanying map. The monument is of national importance as a well-preserved element of the Cowie Line, one of the strategic stop-lines of the anti-invasion defences of the Second World War. The individual features of the monument are well preserved and provide a concrete expression of an important period in British history.
- 2.2 The proposed development is within the estate of Ury House (NO88NE0104), remains of a designed landscape possibly dating back to the 1700s. The house is B Listed Country house by John Baird of Glasgow, 1855, with a wing added in 1884 by an unidentified architect. The gardens have a buttressed, stepped, channeled and rock-faced terrace wall. The house had an ice-house (NO88NE 32.15; Buxbaum 1992, 7). Immediately N of the current site is a circular cropmark (NO88NE0113 possibly representing the site of a small roundel of planted trees which are shown on the 1st and 2nd edition OS map is visible on vertical aerial photographs taken in 1977 and 1988.

- 2.3 At Redcloak (NO 8579 8716), 700m WSW of the W edge of the current site is a field system of pits, possible roundhouses and an unenclosed settlement identified as a cropmark on aerial photographs.
- 2.3 At Glen Ury WNW of the proposed site is an area of hut circles and clearance cairns (NO88NE 73) identified from aerial reconnaissance. In 1861 two cists were found about 0.75m beneath the surface of the ground 200m NNW of Ury House; the cists were aligned from E to W and had pebble floors. In each there was an 'urn' containing a cremation; one of the urns, which was preserved in Ury House but is now lost, is illustrated in the Name Book and was probably a Beaker (NO88NE 13; Name Book 1865).
- 2.4 There is an earthwork or possible Roman camp (NO88NE 7) at Fetteresso Glebe. The evidence for the siting of this 'camp' seems to derive ultimately from Barclay's sketch-map of 1785 on which it is shown as a square with rounded corners, although it is mentioned as early as 1722 in Camden's Britannia. The Name Book authorities remember the site being called 'The Camp' about 1800 but the ground was already under cultivation and no remains were evident. Crawford thought the site too narrow for a Roman camp, or even a normal-sized Roman fort and suggested that it was probably a native fort (Barclay 1792, 566; Crawford 1949; Name Book 1865, 10,248; Jones 2011, 335). The area is now a housing estate.
- 2.5 A copper alloy ewer (NO88NE 11) was found at Glen Ury in 1857. A sketch by the surveyor shows this to be a medieval tripod ewer. It was found two feet below the surface and was broken by the finders but the pieces were preserved at Ury House (OS Name Book 10, 198).
- 2.6 St Ciaran's Well a chalybeate well (NO88NE 17) is near the distillery at the W end of Mineral Well Road, immediately below the Glenury railway viaduct. It is an elegant fountain of Peterhead granite into which once ran the water of chalybeate spring for many years famous for its health-giving properties. The fountain was built on the site of the old holy well of St Kieran which dried up when the supply was cut to build the fountain and it was impossible to find it again (Morris and Morris 1982, 122).
- 2.7 Industrial remains in the area include Glen Ury railway viaduct (NO88NE 60) 400m S of the current site (Hume 1977, 223) and Glen Ury Distillery founded c. 1836 by Captain Barclay. A much altered group of buildings, of which the oldest is probably a 3-storey, 10-bay range of malting floors survive. There are twin detached kilns linked to the malting floors by gangways (ibid: NO88NE 59).
- 2.8 The Aberdeen Western Peripheral route is due to terminate 200m E of the eastern side of the proposed development. Archaeological work has been carried out along the line of the route; AOC carried out a watching brief of trial pits in 2008 (NO89SE0089) but little of archaeological significance, CFA Archaeology have carried out an evaluation in 2013 of this section of the route and an excavation is ongoing at time of preparing this WSI (CFA forthcoming).
- 2.9 Ury or Urie appear on the 17<sup>th</sup>-century Blaeu and Gordon maps and Ury House on the 19<sup>th</sup>-century maps. The First Edition OS map (Appendix 2) shows the area as farmland divided into several fields with an old field boundary still marked with a line of trees. These persist into the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> OS maps and the track across the site from the road to the E was realigned between the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> OS maps. There was a band of trees running along the E edge of the site adjacent to the road.
- 2.10 Cameron Archaeology recently completed an archaeological evaluation of 8 hectares of land at E Lodge, Ury Estate in advance of proposed housing and uncovered a hearth but

no other archaeological features (Cameron forthcoming) and a further 40 hectares at Blue Lodge (Lenfert forthcoming) and at E Lodge (Lenfert forthcoming b).

## 3 STANDING BUILDING SURVEY

The standing building survey took place between October 2014 and June 2016. No access to the interior of the building was possible during the initial standing building survey and several areas of the exterior were difficult to access as there was building materials and felled trees piled around the property. After stabilisation, partial demolition, insertion of news floors and a roof and machine clearance within the building, a survey was carried out within the remaining interiors. New room and feature numbers are used in this survey but the existing floor numbering has been used. The lowest accessible floor is called 'basement' (Illus 5) although this is at ground level on the S side of the house due to the differing ground levels throughout the property (Illus 15). The upper levels are ground (Illus 6), first (Illus 7) and second floors (Illus 8). The exterior elevations produced by WCP Architects were checked and annotated (Illus 9-14).

## 3.1 URY HOUSE

Ury House and terrace walls are Listed Category B (ref 9364; Aberdeenshire SMR no NO88NE0050) and was listed on 27/03/1990. It is a country house built by John Baird of Glasgow in 1855 to replace an older house; a sketch exists of this house (Appendix 3). Baird closely modelled the plans for Ury on Burn's Carstairs with its big square entrance tower and porte cochere and mullioned and transomed windows (Sharples et al 2015, 61).

A wing was added 1884 by an unidentified architect; there are plans and elevations surviving (Illus 84-88). The building was abandoned after 1945 and was roofless until this renovation project.

It is constructed from sandstone ashlar, a 'grotesquely affluent Tudor mansion' (Geddes 2001, 22-23). The building is 64m long and 14-21m wide, three storeys with gable pediments on the dormers and a large mullion window beside the tower which would have illuminated the hall. The N wall has a portico or carriage porch (*porte-cochere*) and the S wall has a projecting tower with oriel window. The E wing, added in 1884 by Alexander Ross, has crowstepped gables (ibid, 23). The garden walls are stone built and buttressed creating a raised platform to the S (Illus 4).

The first known owners of the lands of Ury were the Frasers, but the estate later passed to Marischals, and in 1415 to Lord Errol. (Aberdeenshire SMR). Ury was taken over by the Barclay family in 1647. By 1845 Robert Barclay Allardice was head of the family, and Ury is described in the Statistical Account as a "mansion of moderate size" (Statistical Account 1845, 252). It continues "The park is very extensive and the adjoining fields are in the highest state of cultivation. ..... This is, perhaps, one of the finest seats in any part of the country" (ibid 252-3); and adds that there is "a particularly fine old terraced one (garden) at Ury" (ibid 263). Features within the landscape depicted on the OS 1st/2nd edition maps (Illus 80, 81) include a walled garden, aviaries, kennels and curling pond.

Because of the ground levels at Ury House the lower floor is referred to the basement, then the ground floor, first floor and second floor (attic). Only the basement level was fully accessible during the first stages of this survey and then upper floors inserted allowing access to the rest of the floors. Scaffolding allowed access to the exterior and a crane facilitated photographs of the roof levels.

The basement rooms 1-13 and 17 (Illus 5), ground floor Rooms 20-30 (Illus 6), first floor Rooms 34-44 and 62 (Illus 7) and second floor Rooms 48-57 (Illus 8) belong to the first phase

(1855) of the development of Ury House. The walls are constructed of granite rubble with ashlar sandstone facing throughout. These rooms are in fair condition with ducts under the floors for heating, flues with in the walls and fireplaces throughout.

Lower basement Rooms 66-68, basement Rooms 14-16 and 19 (Illus 5), ground floor Rooms 31-33 (Illus 6), first floor Rooms 45-47 and 63 (Illus 7) and second floor Rooms 59-61 and 64 (Illus 8) are part of the second phase of Ury House; some rooms in between the Phase 1 and 2 sections of the house have been lost due to their poor condition.

#### 3.1.1 PHASE 1

Phase 1 Rooms 1-6 form the W half of the 1855 house; these were the public rooms and bedrooms. The exteriors are ashlar sandstone and all ground and first floor rooms have large windows and most rooms have had fireplaces. Several of these rooms were in poor condition prior to this survey and walls had been removed to make the building safe after the fire and subsequent period of dereliction.

## **Basement Level (Illus 5)**

#### Room 1

Room 1 was approximately 7.8 x 6.8m in size and in the SW corner of the house with large bay windows on the S (W5) and W (W2) walls. There is a concreted brick and stone fireplace on the E wall, F1, which has grate *in situ* but no tiles or stone surround surviving. There is an adjacent lath and plastered alcove, A1, on the E wall. The N wall of the room had been demolished prior to this survey. Patches of lath and plaster survive particularly around the windows. The walls are of fieldstone and rubble and the windows and doors of tooled sandstone (Illus 19). On the 1882 Plan of Drains (Illus 84) this room is divided into three and labelled ?'Bathroom' on the W side, there is a small room in the SW corner and the main room is the 'House Keepers Room'.

## Room 2

Room 2 is to the E of Room 1, 6.1 x 8.3m in size and has a bay window on the S wall (W6). There is a concrete and brick fireplace (F6) and plastered stone alcove (A2) on the E wall and a door to the corridor on the N wall (D11; Illus 20, 21) which has sandstone jambs and sandstone arched lintel. Lath and plaster survives on several walls. This room is labelled 'Servants Hall' on 1882 plan (Illus 84).

## Room 3

Room 3 is 10.6 x 7m in size and to the E of Room 2. It has three large windows on the S wall (W7, W8, W9) and three doors (D13, D22, D23; Illus 18) on the N wall leading to the corridor. It is divided into two rooms on the 1882 plan (Illus 84) the smaller W room being a 'store' (the E room is not possible to identify). It has a large concrete tripartite fireplace on the E wall (F26; Illus 16). Room 3 was the Phase 1 kitchen with fireplace and flues under the floor. The roof is brick vaulted (Illus 17, 18) with cast iron roof joists. The floor of this room was lowered in a later phase and was used as a Billiard Room. There is lath and off-white plaster on the walls.

# Room 4

Rooms 4, 5 and 6 are in the NW corner of the Phase 1 house and were all bedrooms on the 1882 plan (Illus 84). Room 4 is 6.3 x 5.5m, Room 5 5.2 x c 6m and Room 6 5 x c 6m. Their S wall had been demolished and all have concrete and brick fireplaces F21, F20 and F17 and remains of lath and off-white plaster survive in patches. Room 4 has a window on the W wall (W1) but no window on the N wall in the basement level; there are windows in the upper levels on the N wall (W32 and 32A).

Rooms 5 is 5m wide and c 5m long (although the S wall has been demolished pre-survey). It has a window on the N wall, W31, rectangular with sandstone facings and mullions and a sandstone fireplace F20 on the W wall. There are remains of lath and off-white plaster on the walls. There are no surviving ceilings but cast-iron beams are present.

#### Room 6

Rooms 6 is 4.5m wide c 5m long (although the S wall has been demolished pre-survey). It has a window on the N wall, W30, rectangular with sandstone facings and mullions and a sandstone fireplace F17 on the E wall. There are remains of lath and off-white plaster on the walls. There are no surviving ceilings, but cast-iron beams are present.

## Room 7

This forms the basement corridor running W-E along the length of the Phase 1 1855 house from Door 1. It is a maximum of 4.5m wide and ran the full length of the Phase 1 house. It had held Stair 1.

## Room 8

Room 8 is a brick-walled enclosure on the S side of Room 7 probably created during the construction of Stair 1 to allow access to the S rooms from the corridor and under the stair. It was c4 x 2m in size and had been mostly demolished by the survey date. It appears on the 1882 plan (Illus 84) but is unlabeled as are several other small rooms off this central corridor.

## Room 9

Rooms 9 and 10 are under the main N entrance were fitted out for cold storage. Room 9 is 5 x 3.7m in size and the walls are plastered and both rooms are lined on their W and E walls with stone shelves supported by brick uprights (Illus 22, 23). The alcoves on the W wall are larger (c1 x 1m) and those on the E wall c 0.5 x 0.6m in size. These rooms were for cold storage, including wine, dairy, meat and game products. The rooms on the ground floor above are labelled 'wine store' and '.... store' on the 1882 plan (Illus 84).

#### Room 10

Room 10 is 5 x 5m in size and the walls are plastered and lined with shelves. As with Room 9, this room is lined on their W and E walls with stone shelves supported by brick uprights (Illus 24). The alcoves on the W wall are larger (c1 x 1m) and those on the E wall c  $0.5 \times 0.6$ m in size. These rooms were for cold storage, including wine, dairy, meat and game products. The rooms on the ground floor above are labelled 'wine store' and '.... store' on the 1882 plan (Illus 84).

## Room 11

This room is in the centre of the Phase 1 house. It is 6.4 x 5.4m in size and has large windows on exterior walls. There are concrete and brick fireplaces on the E wall (F27). There are no ceilings present but cast-iron beams survive and there is lath and off-white plaster surviving on the walls of the upper rooms. Room 11 was divided into two on the 1882 plan (Illus 84).

#### Room 12

This room is in the centre of the Phase 1 house. It is 7 x c5m in size and the room has large windows (W10 and w11) on exterior S wall and sandstone and brick fireplace F11 in the basement with alcove A3 on ground floor. Room 12 had a stair in the NE corner and on the N wall on the 1882 plan (Illus 84). No trace of this survives as this stair and wall had been removed prior to this survey.

## Room 13

The basement room 13 was the kitchen of the Phase 2 house and was 8.6 x 6.2m in size (with public rooms above). It has 2 large windows on the S wall (W12, 13) and concrete and brick fireplaces on the W and E walls (F24 and F23). There is a door in the NE corner of the room

(blocked) leading to Room 12 and two doors in the N wall (D26 and D27) leading to the main corridor Room 17. Lath and plaster survive on all walls. The exterior E façade of this wall (later built into the Phase 2 house) is ashlar sandstone and was originally the E exterior wall of the Phase 1 house.

#### Room 17

Room 17 is the room at the E end of corridor Room 7 on the E end of the Phase 1 house and was 10 x 6.5m although the S wall of this room had been removed prior to this survey. The door to the storerooms (Rooms 18A and B, below) is on the N wall of this room. There was a small lift in the NE corner of this room (removed prior to this survey) and it would have allowed access to the upper floors for transport of coal, wood and other goods and access to the kitchens (Room 13). The exterior E façade of this wall (later built into the Phase 2 house) is ashlar sandstone and was originally the E exterior wall of the Phase 1 house (Illus 25).

## **Ground floor (Illus 6)**

#### Room 20

Above Rooms 9 and 10 is the main entrance in to the house on the N façade (Room 20), a sandstone porte-cochere (D68, Illus 26-27). There is a shield on the N façade (P3, Illus 28), rectangular date stone (1855, P7, Illus 29-30) on the W façade and initials (AB, P6, Illus 31) on the E façade above the arched cart entrances. The NW and NE corners of this structure are sandstone octagonal turrets with ogee top (Illus 32). There is an oriel window in the tower above this door which is not accessible and was photographed from the ground and from the crane only.

#### Room 21

Room 21 is  $5 \times 7.5 \text{m}$  in size and is the main the entrance hall on the N facade; it has portecochere Room 20 on the N wall, W48 on the W wall and doors D52 on the W wall to access Room 22, D51 (Illus 35) on the S wall to access Room 27 and fireplace F52 on the E wall.

#### Room 22

Room 22 is  $5 \times 3.75 \text{m}$  in size with W30A on the N wall; the S wall has been partially demolished.

## Room 23

Room 23 is now one room but was Room 23A 6.3 x 5.5m in size with W32 on N wall and W1A on W wall and Room 23B 5.2 x c4m with W31A on N wall. The S and part of the centre walls of these rooms have been demolished.

## Room 24

Room 24 is on the SW corner of the house. It is 7.8 x 6.8m in size with large bay window W2A on the W wall and W5A on the S wall. There is a fireplace F2 on the E wall and a door D5 to Room 25 (Illus 36).

## Room 25

Room 25 is 8.6 x 6.1m in size with W6A on the S wall, D5 on the W wall to Room 24, D10 on the N wall to corridor Room 27 and D15 on the E wall to Room 26. There is a fireplace F7 on the E wall.

#### Room 26

Room 26 is 10.6 x 7m in size with three windows W7A, W8A and W9A on the S wall, door D15 on the W wall (Illus 38) with fireplace F58, D14, D20 and fireplace F57 on the N wall (Illus 37).

#### Room 27

Room 27 is the central corridor at least 20m long and 4.8m wide.

Room 28 is on the N side of the house and is 6.4 x 5.4m in size. It has large window W29A on the N wall and door D60 on the W wall.

## Room 29

Room 29 is on the N side of the house and is 10 x 6.5m in size with W26A, W27, W28A on the N wall: the other walls have been demolished.

## Room 29A

Room 29A was c 7 x 5m in size but the N half of the room has been demolished. There are windows W10A and W11a on the s wall and an alcove on the W wall.

#### Room 30

Room 30 is on the S side of the house. It is 8.6 x 6.2m in size with windows W12A and W13A on the S wall and D32 on the N wall.

Floors were inserted into the shell of the building part way through this survey and the First Floor rooms were then accessible. Most of the walls were stone rubble as the soft strip had been completed at date of survey.

## First floor (Illus 7)

## Room 34

Room 34 is  $5 \times 7.5 \text{m}$  in size and is above the entrance hall; it has windows W33B on the N wall, W49 on the W wall and doors D64 on the W wall to access Room 35, D59 on the S wall to access Room 41 and fireplace F73 on the E wall. This is one of the Phase 1 first floor bedrooms.

#### Room 35

The W, S and part of the E walls of Room 35 have been demolished but the room was 5m wide and probably around 6m long with a large window W30B on the N wall. This is one of the Phase 1 first floor bedrooms.

## Room 36

The W, S and part of the E walls of Room 36 have been demolished but the room was 5m wide and probably around 6m long with a large window W31A on the N wall. This is one of the Phase 1 first floor bedrooms.

## Room 37

Room 37 was  $5.5 \times 6.3$ m wide with a large window W32A on the N wall, W1B on the W wall; the SE corner of the room has been removed and no doors now visible on the S or E walls. This is one of the Phase 1 first floor bedrooms.

#### Room 38

Room 38 was a bedroom in the SW corner of the house approximately 7.8 x 6.8m in size; the N and part of the E wall had been removed prior to this survey. The room has large window W5B on the S wall and W23B on the W wall with fireplace F3 on the E wall.

#### Room 39

Room 39 was a bedroom 6.1 x 8.6m in size with large bay window W6B (Illus 41) on the S wall, fireplaces F8 and F76 on the E wall (Illus 39) as the room had been subdivided but only one door D12 to the corridor on the N wall.

#### Room 40

Room 40 was probably a large bedroom 10.6 x 7m in size with three windows on the S wall W7B, W8B, W9B, fireplace F74 on the E wall, fireplace F75 on the W wall and door to corridor on the N wall D16.

## Room 41

Room 41 is the corridor from which all the bedrooms are accessed. It was around 20m long and 4.8m wide.

## Room 42

Room 42 was probably a bedroom at the E end of the Phase 1 first floor, 6.4 x 5.4m in size. It has W29B on the N wall and door D48 on the S wall. There is a fireplace F101 on the E wall.

#### Room 43

Room 43 is on the SE side of the Phase 1 house. It is c 5 x 7m in size with windows W10B and W11B on the S wall and fireplace F13 on the E wall. There is a blocked door D62 on the N end of the E wall.

## Room 44

Room 44 is on the N side of the house with 3 windows on the N wall W26B, 27B and 28B. there is a door, D44, between this room and Room 42, inserted presumably when the Phase 2 house was added. Room 44 is around 10 x 6.5m in size but several walls have been demolished.

## Room 62

Room 62 on the S side of the Phase 2 house is 8.6 x 6.2m in size with W12B and W13B on the S wall (Illus 54) and doors D62 on the W wall and D29 on the N wall.

Floors were inserted into the shell of the building part way through this survey and the Second Floor rooms were then accessible. Most of the walls were stone rubble as the soft strip had been completed at date of survey.

## Second Floor (Illus 8)

## Room 48

Room 48 was a bedroom  $5.5 \times 6.3 \text{m}$  wide with a small window W32B (Illus 42) on the N wall, W1C on the W wall; the SE corner of the room has been removed and no doors now visible on the S or E walls.

## Room 49

The W, S and part of the E walls of Room 49 have been demolished but the room was 5m wide and probably around 6m long with no windows.

#### Room 50

Room 50 was a bedroom in the SW corner of the house approximately 7.8 x 6.8m in size; the N and part of the E wall had been removed prior to this survey. There is one window on the W wall W2C and fireplace on the E wall, F4.

## Room 51

Room 51 a small bedroom on the N side of the house was 5m wide and up to 6m long with no windows.

## Room 52

Room 52 is above the entrance and is  $5 \times 7.5 \text{m}$  in size with window W33B on the N wall, fireplace F81 on the E wall and doors to the corridor D65 on the S wall and to Room 51, D53, on the W wall.

Room 53 is 6.4 x 5.4m in size with small window W29C on the N wall and door to the corridor D56 on the S wall.

## Room 54

Room 54 is the second floor corridor from which all the bedrooms are accessed. It was at least 20m long and around 4.8m wide.

## Room 55

Room 55 is on the S side of the building and is 6.1m wide. The N wall of the room has been replaced and there is a small window W6C on the S wall.

#### Room 56

Room 56 on the S side of the house is 10.6 x 7m in size with no windows and replacement N wall. There is a blocked door, D66, between this room and Room 55.

## Room 57

Room 57 on the E end of the Phase 1 second floor is 5m wide and around 7m long with no windows and no internal features surviving. The walls of this room show the Phase 1 roof lines (Illus 46, 47) and above the W wall is chimney stack and sandstone pots F72 with Phase 1 roof raggle (Illus 48).

The roof of the Phase 1 tower was observed from the second floor (Illus 45) and also the crane. Architectural details include decorative arrow slits on the W elevation (F46; Illus 43) and E elevation (F50). There are decorative octagonal turret chimneys on each corner F34 (Illus 44) and F35 on the N elevation and F47 and F48 on the S elevation.

#### Room 58

Room 58 on the N side of the house is c 10 x 6.5m in size with windows W26C, W27C and W28C on the N wall; the remaining walls have been partially demolished and rebuilt and no other features survive.

## 3.1.2 PHASE 2

## **Basement Level (Illus 5)**

## Rooms 14

Room 14 is the SW room of the Phase 2 house extension; it is 6.4 x 4.4m in size and has lath and plaster surviving. It has a window on the S wall (W14) with brick relieving arch and a concrete and brick fireplace (F25) on the E wall. The W wall formed the exterior of the Phase 1 house and so there is a blocked window on the W wall (W44) which would have been an E facing window on the exterior of the phase 1 house. The W wall of Room 14 is ashlar sandstone which was the original facing of the exterior of the Phase 1 house (Illus 25). There are beam slots on this ashlar wall which were added when the Phase 2 extension was built as well as the holes and wood batons for counter lath to allow the lath and plaster to adhere to the smooth ashlar surface. The other walls of this room are sandstone and granite rubble and lath and off-white plaster survives on the upper floors. This room is labelled 'bedroom' on the 1882 plan (Illus 82).

#### Room 15

Room 15 is a large Phase 2 room 7.4 x 13.4m in size with no window opening on the S wall as it is the base of oriel window W15 (Illus 49) and large windows on the E wall (W19, 21). There is an arched sandstone fireplace on the E wall (F25) and there is off-white plaster surviving on several walls. There are cast iron beams surviving but no ceilings present. The internal door D30 is stone with an arched brick lintel. There is a series of sleeper walls under the floor

creating a 1m deep semi-basement but the room is only partially accessible due to the rubble on the floor and in the under floor void. It is labelled 'Servants Hall' on the 1882 plans.

## Rooms 16 and 19

The E wing consists of Rooms 16 and 19. Room 16 is 8 x 7m in size and Room 19 8 x c4m. These rooms were divided by a narrow brick dividing wall which was removed before this survey but the scars were identified and recorded. This wing is of ashlar sandstone with crowstep gables on the N elevation with large windows on the N, E and S elevations. The windows on the N and W walls have ashlar sandstone facings. The windows on the E and S walls (W24 and W17A) are bay windows. W17A is built into the crowstepped gabled wall and W24 into the E wall of the E wing. Both windows have corbels supporting the base of the window with decorative machicolation and cusped decorative arches in between the corbels. There is a small square plaque above W17A and a shield shaped plaque adjacent to W24 on the first floor but there is no access to these features which appear worn with no evident decoration but may have contained dates, initials or coat of arms.

There is a large sandstone, cast iron and brick kitchen fireplace on the N wall (F15). The basement window (W24; Illus 50) on the E wall has a wood lintel which had been propped up with decorative cast iron props during the lifetime of the building and are recorded on the 1882 plan of the house (Illus 84). The other windows in the room also have wood interior lintels and doors with brick arched lintels.

## Rooms 18A and B

Two rooms on the N side of the basement (under the N courtyard; Illus 51) were constructed for storage of coal and wood. They could be accessed from the courtyard through hatches and also accessed from the interior of the basement Room 17. They were filled with soil and not completely accessible during this survey but their exterior walls are rustic granite finish. These may date to Phase 1 or more likely Phase 2 as they obstruct some of the Phase 1 basement windows.

Floors were inserted into the shell of the building part way through this survey and the First Floor rooms were then accessible. Most of the walls were stone rubble as the soft strip had been completed at date of survey.

# **Ground floor (Illus 6)**

#### Room 31

Room 31 is on the S side of the house and is 6.4 x 4.4m in size with window W14A on the S wall.

# Room 32

W32 is in the SE corner of the house. It is 13.4 x 7.4m in size with W38 on the W wall, W15 on the S wall and W21A on the E wall. D33 is on the N wall. Plaque P2 is on the exterior face of the E wall of this room.

## Room 33

Room 33 is in the NE corner of the house and is 11 x 8m in size with W37 on the W wall, W17A (Illus 52) on the S wall and W18 on the E wall. The pair of decorative windows on the first floor N wall (F33) were later blocked and a fireplace (F16) constructed of sandstone arched surround with green ceramic tiles was inserted into the blocked window (Illus 53). There is a sandstone plague P1 is on the exterior of the E wall of this room (Illus 67, 68).

The First Floor rooms were also accessible after floors were inserted.

## First floor (Illus 7)

Room 45 was a small room on the S side of the house 6.4 x 4.4m in size. The W, E and N walls have been demolished leaving the S wall with window W14B (Illus 54).

## Room 46

Room 46 is 13.4 x 7.4m in size on the S side of the house. It has a large window W15A on the W wall and W21B on the E wall. There is a fireplace F62 on the E wall with chimney stack F91 above and there is a sandstone plaque P2 is on the exterior of the E wall of this room.

#### Room 47

Room 47 is 8 x 11m in size on the NE corner of the Phase 2 house. There is a windows W37 on the W wall, the upper portion of W18 on the E wall and W17A on the S wall with plaque P4 (Illus 70) on the exterior gable above this window.

#### Room 63

Most of the walls of Room 63 have been removed except the E gable with fireplace F63 (Illus 56).

Floors were inserted into the shell of the building part way through this survey and the Second Floor rooms were then accessible.

## Second Floor (Illus 8)

## Room 59

Room 59 on the S side of the house is 13m long and 6.2m wide with partially rebuilt walls and windows demolished from the S wall apart from small window W14C. This room may be originally Phase 1 but rebuilt in Phase 2 as a larger room and there was so little of it left at the date of survey that this was not possible to determine.

#### Room 60

Room 60 in the SE corner of the house is 13.4 x 7.4m in size with fireplace F61 (Illus 55) built into the S wall (above W15) and chimney breast F92 on the E wall. There is a sandstone plaque P5 is on the exterior of the W wall of this room.

#### Room 61

Room 61 in the NE corner of the building is not accessible but based on the room below it is 8 x 11m in size.

## Room 64

Most of the walls of Room 64 on the N side of the house have been demolished but there is a fireplace surviving on the E wall, F14.

## Rooms 66, 67, 68 (Illus 5)

Rooms 66, 67 and 68 are accessed by doors D2, D3, D4 (Illus 57) on the E lower basement wall (Illus 9). They are brick-vaulted (Illus 58, 59). Rooms 66 is below Room 19 and Rooms 67 and 68 are below Room 16. Rooms 66 is 3.75 x 5.7m and 3.05m high, Room 67 2.06 x 7.5m and 2.89m high and Room 68 3.75 x 7.5m and 3.15m high; they are constructed of mixed fieldstone, mainly granite. Their doors have pointed arched stone lintels and rusticated sandstone facings (Illus 60) on the exterior face and entrance 'corridor' with a shlar sandstone finishing on the interior facing of the doorways. These rooms are brick vaulted. Windows with brick facings have been added between the rooms and Room 66 has housed a boiler. These rooms may have been for cold storage in the first phase of this wing of the house but were later converted to house heating apparatus.

## 3.1.3 Other features from both phases (Illus 5-8)

## Flues

There are flues through several of the Phase 1 1855 house walls and under several floors. They consist of a stone channel constructed within the stone rubble walls. Channels under the basement floors (Illus 61) are interpreted as heating channels to allow flow of warm air around the Phase 1 building.

## Stairs 1 and 2

Stair 1 (Illus 62) was probably added after the 1884 conversion; there is no sign of it on the 1882 plans. It was constructed of large sandstone flags which were numbered on the face to be inserted into the wall (Nelse Stewart, Pert Bruce pers comm) allowing easy installation. This staircase had been removed prior to this survey to allow access to the interior. On the 1882 plans the staircase is shown in Room 17. This sandstone slab stair (Stair 2) survives as a scar on the N wall of Room 17 (Illus 63). Probably after Stair 1 was constructed, Stair 2 was used as a back stair and a small lift was added on the E side of Room 17.

## Chimneys

The Phase 1 house has several decorative turret chimneys including F30 (Illus 64, 65, 66), F34, F35, F43, F44, F69, F88, F89 and F95. Concrete chimney caps were photographed and one which was accessible was recorded in detail, F30 (Illus 64, 65, 66). It was octagonal, 1.6m wide and made from sandstone. The sandstone was 0.16m thick and there is a concrete cap 0.6m wide in the centre of the chimney (Illus 66).

## Plagues P1, P2, P4 and P5

Four sandstone plaques were recorded on the exterior of the Phase 2 building (Illus 67). P1 is a shield 0.5m wide and 0.84m high (Illus 68) in a rectangular sandstone surround. It has vertical pecking marks over the surface. P2 is 0.64m wide and 0.9m high (Illus 69) set in a rectangular sandstone surround. It has corner to corner diagonal pecking. P4 is 0.6m high and 0.4m wide (Illus 70) and P5 is a shield 0.9m high and 0.64m wide (Illus 71) within a rectangular sandstone surround. No decorative detail survives on any of these plaques.

# The Garden

Ury House was built on a constructed terrace and this small private garden is surrounded by a substantial granite wall (Illus 72, 73, 74, 75). The terrace wall around the W and S sides of the garden stands 2m tall with 1 x 1m tapered buttresses. On the S side in the centre is a semi-circular extension on which a four-petal flower shaped fountain stood on the First Edition OS map (Illus 3).

# 3.2 THE WALLED GARDEN AND ICE-HOUSE

The standing buildings surveys of the Walled garden and Ice-House are incomplete and will be completed in the next phase of the development

## 3.3 THE WATCHING BRIEF

A watching brief was carried out during the clearance of areas on the S and W side of Ury House. Nothing of archaeological interest was recorded but any further ground clearance must be monitored.

## 4 CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

A Level 2 standing building survey was carried out between October 2014 and June 2016 during the soft strip of Ury House. Architects plans and elevations were annotated and a photographic survey carried out of internal and external walls and features. No access to the upper floors was possible during the first visits but when replacement floors were added and most areas became accessible and were recorded.

Ury House is a country house built by John Baird of Glasgow in 1855 to replace an older house and a sketch exists of this earlier house. Baird closely modelled the plans for Ury on Burn's Carstairs with its big square entrance tower and porte cochere and mullioned and transomed windows. A wing was added 1884 by an unidentified architect and the building was abandoned after 1945 and was roofless at the first stages of the survey; new floors and roof were added part way through the survey. It is constructed from sandstone ashlar, a 'grotesquely affluent Tudor mansion'. At least two phases of development of the main house were identified (Illus 75) with several smaller modifications.

The walled garden and ice-house, which are due to be redeveloped during a later phase, still require completion of the Level 2 Standing Building Survey.

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
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




Illus 1 Location plan (Contains Ordnance Survey data © Crown copyright and database right 2018)



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
Illus 2 Site plan showing proposed development site (copyright WCP Architects)




Illus 3 First (top) Second (middle) and Third (bottom) OS maps (copyright National Library of Scotland)




Illus 4 Ury House from WSW showing derelict house and raised platform with terrace walls. (copyright Aberdeenshire Council)




Illus 5 Plan of Ury House basement annotated with feature numbers used in this survey (copyright WCP Architects)




Illus 6 Plan of Ury House ground floor annotated with feature numbers used in this survey (copyright WCP Architects)




Illus 7 Plan of Ury House first floor annotated with feature numbers used in this survey (copyright WCP Architects)




Illus 8 Plan of Ury House second floor annotated with feature numbers used in this survey (copyright WCP Architects)




Illus 9 East elevation of Ury House annotated with numbers used in this survey (copyright WCP Architects)




Illus 10 North elevation of Ury House annotated with numbers used in this survey (copyright WCP Architects)




Illus 11 West elevation of Ury House annotated with numbers used in this survey (copyright WCP Architects)


























Illus 76 Pont map of Lower Deeside 1583-96 showing 'Kowy' (centre) but no reference to Ury (copyright National Library of Scotland).
















Illus 85 1882 Second floor showing addition (on right in red) consisting mainly of bedrooms (copyright RCAHMS)




Illus 90 1983 photograph of Ury House, facing SE


Urie, a mansion in Fetteresso parish, Kincardineshire, on the left bank of Cowie Water, 2 miles NNW of Stonehaven. It is an Elizabethan edifice of 1855, and the addition of a wing in 1883-84 at a cost of over £10,000 has made it the largest mansion in the county. The grounds are very extensive, including 700 acres within the walls in permanent pasture and 5 miles of picturesque drives within the gates. On the principal approach there is a high-level bridge over the Cowie, which cost upwards of £2000. The first known possessors of the estate were the Frasers, a family of renown in early Scottish history, whose chief was designated Thane of Cowie. Through the marriage of Margaret Fraser with Sir William Keith, it passed to the Marischal family. The barony of Urie, which then included the lands of Elsick and Muchalls, was sold in 1415, along with other possessions, to William de Hay, Lord of Errol. It remained in the possession of the Hay family till 1647, when the estate of Urie was purchased by William, Earl Marischal, Elsick and Muchalls having in the interval passed into other hands. In 1648 it was sold to Col. David Barclay, third son of Barclay of Mathers, the representative of the ancient De Berkeleys. Col. Barclay, 'having religiously abdicated the world in 1666 and joined the Quakers,' at his death in 1686 was succeeded by his son, Robert Barclay (1648-90), the famous Quaker His great-grandson and namesake (1751-97) apologist. in 1777 married the heiress of Allardice (see Arbuth-NOTT), and improved the estate, granting feus, from which the New Town of Stonehaven has arisen. son, Capt. Rt. Barclay-Allardice (1779-1854), was famous as an agriculturist, and still more for his pedestrian feats, having in 1809 walked 1000 miles in 1000 consecutive hours. At his death the estate was purchased by the late Alex. Baird, Esq., ironmaster at Gartsherrie, who was succeeded in 1862 by his brother, John Baird, the father of the present laird, Alex. Baird, Esq. (b. 1849; suc. 1870). With the adjacent estate of RICKAR-TON, purchased in 1875, the lands extend to about 10,000 acres.—Ord. Sur., sh. 67, 1871. See the Rev. D. G. Barron's Court Book of Urie (Scot. Hist. Soc. 1892).




Illus 92 Plan showing camera points use in this survey – exterior (copyright WCP Architects)




Illus 93 Plan showing camera points use in this survey – interior basement (*copyright WCP Architects*)




Illus 94 Plan showing camera points use in this survey – interior ground floor (*copyright WCP Architects*)
