
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SUMMARY

A Level 1 standing building survey was carried out on 28 March 2019. The survey covers the SE half of the former steading and several of the structures have been demolished. The standing structure appear to have been built in one phase. Many of the apertures have been blocked when the building was altered. It is recommended that no further archaeological work is required during the current planning application.

1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The site (Illus 1) is located on the on the SE side of the A90 opposite Fordoun. It is centred on NGR NO 76630 73146, at 140-145m OD (Illus 1) and in the parish of Garvock.
- 1.2 The work was commissioned by Caroline McBain, Albyn Architects for Finlay Brock. An Aberdeenshire Council planning application APP/2018/1968 was approved on 2.11.18 and there is a requirement for a Level 1 standing building survey.
- 1.3 All the archaeological work was carried out in the context of Scottish Planning Policy (SPP) Planning Advice Note (PAN 2/2011) and Scottish Historic Environment Scotland's Policy Statement (HESPS), which state that archaeological remains should be regarded as part of the environment to be protected and managed.



Illus 1 Location plan (Contains Ordnance Survey data © Crown copyright and database right 2019)


2 BACKGROUND

The building is on the Aberdeenshire SMR no NO77SE0071 (HES NO77SE 42). It is on the 1st, 2nd and 3rd Edition Ordnance Survey maps (Illus 15-17). There is an 1858 date stone over a cart door (see cover illus) in an area outwith the current survey. The building covered by this survey appears to have been built in one phase with some areas demolished since the 1st Edition OS map.

3 THE LEVEL 1 STANDING BUILDING SURVEY

A level 1 standing building survey was carried out on 28 March 2019. Architects plans and elevations were checked and additional elevations and plans drawn. A full photographic survey was carried out; only the NW room of the farmhouse (Room 6) was inaccessible.


The buildings are all constructed in sandstone with sandstone quoins, lintels, jambs and sills throughout, with a small number of concrete replacements detailed below.




Illus 2 Plan showing numbering used in this survey

The NE wing is a former farmhouse (Rooms 1-6; Illus 2). Room 1 is the corridor on the NE side of the building, Room 2 is a former reception room with windows W1 and W9, fireplace F12 on the SE wall and cupboard (F13). Rooms 3 and 4 were bedrooms with corner cupboards F14 and F15 and windows on the SW façade (W11 and W12). Room 5 is the former kitchen with fireplace F17 and alcove F18 on the NW wall with door to Room 6 (locked and no access to Room 6). A steading building has been removed from the N of Room 6 and the scars can be seen on the NW wall of this building (Illus 6,7).

A small lean-to building has been removed between Rooms 6 and 7 leaving a scar on the NE wall of Room 7 (F10) and the SW wall of Room 6 (F9) (Illus 4, 8).

Room 7 is a small room with windows and door on the SE wall W7 (knocked through to create a door), D6, W8 and D7 (Illus 3, 9). Over D6 is the remains of an arched lintel of a cart door D14 (Illus 10). It is attached to the SW wing Rooms 8, 9 and 10 (Illus 2). These rooms have large cart doors on the SE façade; Room 10 SE wall door D4 is an arched sandstone cart door and Room 8 has the large tractor door D5 with cast iron lintel but this may have originally been a similar cartdoor to D4 when originally constructed (Illus 3, 11). Room 8 NE wall had a large arched cart door D9 which has been infilled with stone (Illus 4, 12).

Rooms 8 and 9 have doors in the NW wall but these have concrete lintels and have been inserted into the wall at a later date. There is an original upper storey door (D23) with sandstone lintel, sill and jambs (Illus 13). Room 9 now has an open SW wall with recent cast iron pillars, door between Rooms 9 and 10 (D12), modern door between Rooms 8 and 9 (D11) and between Rooms 8 and 10 (D10). There is a small blocked window (W14) in the SW wall of Room 10 which is not visible on the exterior face of this wall.



There are two ventilation blocks remaining within this section of the building F1 on the SW wall stub F4 and F2 on the link wall between Rooms 6 and 7 (Illus 2).

4 CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

A Level 1 standing building survey was carried out on 28 March 2019. The survey covers the SE half of the former steading and several of the structures have been demolished (Illus 14). The standing structure appear to have been built in one phase. Many of the apertures have been blocked when the building was altered. It is recommended that no further archaeological work is required during the current planning application.












