

SUMMARY

A Level 1 standing building survey was carried out on 14 May 2019. The cottage (Building 1) and the garage (Building 2) were photographed and architects plans and elevations were annotated. All areas were accessible and the weather was hot and sunny.

There were three phases in Building 1 (Illus 14), all constructed before the date of the First Edition OS map (1865; Illus 15). The Phase 1 cottage consisted of Rooms 1-4; the Phase 2 building was probably originally part of the farm and later incorporated into the house to create Rooms 5 and 6. Room 7 is a small animal byre with cobbled floors and cobbled runnel or grepe.

It is recommended that no further archaeological work is required during the current planning application.

1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The site (Illus 1) is located on the N of Banchory on the E side of A980. It is centred on NGR NO 70310 97296, at 70-75m OD (Illus 1) and in the parish of Banchory-ternan.
- 1.2 The work was commissioned by Iain Alexander, AJC. A planning application APP/2018/1978 was approved on 12 November 2018 with a condition for this Level 1 standing building survey.
- 1.3 All the archaeological work was carried out in the context of Scottish Planning Policy (SPP) Planning Advice Note (PAN 2/2011) and Scottish Historic Environment Scotland's Policy Statement (HESPS), which state that archaeological remains should be regarded as part of the environment to be protected and managed.

2 BACKGROUND

This cottage is the W cottage at Lochton of Leys (HER NO79NW0111). By the First Edition OS map the three sections of Building 1 are complete; the garage is added in the late 20th century.

3 THE LEVEL 1 STANDING BUILDING SURVEY


A Level 1 standing building survey was carried out on 14 May 2019. The cottage (Building 1) and the garage (Building 2) were photographed and architects plans and elevations were annotated. All areas were accessible, and the weather was hot and sunny.

3.1 BUILDING 1

Building 1 (Illus 2-11) is a rectangular one-storey stone cottage with grey slate roof, harled exterior walls and concrete window sills. Phase 1 to the west is 12m long and 6.15m wide with central door D1 on the S façade with flanking windows W1 and W2 (Illus 2-5). There are two windows W9 and W10 on the N wall. This section of the cottage consists of living room at the W end with window W1 on the S wall and fireplace on the W wall, kitchen Room 2 with window W10 on N wall, bathroom Room 3,

In Phase 2 two bedrooms were added by incorporating a former agricultural building 6.4m long and 6.15m wide. It added bedrooms Room 5 with window W8 on N wall and bedroom Room 6 at E end with window W4 on the S wall. This building also has grey slates on the roof, concrete window sills and is harled on all walls.

The Phase 3 Room 7 is 9.2m long and 5.2m wide which is butted (Illus 10) onto the Phase 2 building. It is one storey and is constructed of fieldstone and granite blocks (Illus 6-9). There are tin sheds attached to the S façade. It has two doors in the S wall D2 and D3 (later converted to window W5) and two windows on the N wall W6 and W7 both later blocked with stone. Lintels, jambs and sills are all granite blocks. The building interior has rounded and angular medium cobbles at the W end (F4), rounded cobbles F5 in the centre of the room and rounded cobbled surface F7 at the E end with a channel or grepe in between (F6; Illus 11) which is 0.75m wide. Here is a small aperture in the E gable (F1; Illus 8). There is a large boulder in the NW corner of the room which is part of the foundations (F2) and the foundations visible on the exterior of the N wall (F3).





4 CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

A Level 1 standing building survey was carried out on 14 May 2019. The cottage (Building 1) and the garage (Building 2) were photographed and architects plans and elevations were annotated. All areas were accessible and the weather was hot and sunny.

There were three phases in Building 1 (Illus 14), all constructed before the date of the First Edition OS map (1865; Illus 15). The Phase 1 cottage consisted of Rooms 1-4; the Phase 2 building was probably originally part of the farm and later incorporated into the house to create Rooms 5 and 6. Room 7 is a small animal byre with cobbled floors and runnel or grepe.

It is recommended that no further archaeological work is required during the current planning application.




Illus 14 Phase plan Building 1 (from copyright AJC)









Illus 18 Camera points external Building 2 used in this survey (copyright AJC)





Illus 19 Camera points Building 1 used in this survey (copyright AJC)


