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1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 Between the 21st February 2007 and 28th February 2007 a further archaeological watching brief was conducted by Pre-Construct Archaeology Ltd. at Ropemaker Street, Islington, London EC2 complementing the work undertaken during September and October 2006¹ (RMZ 06).
- 1.2 The watching brief was to monitor works undertaken at the corner of Finsbury Street and Ropemaker Street, the south-eastern corner of the site, where a cellar was reduced to the same basement formation level as already reached elsewhere on the site.
- 1.3 This watching brief has the site code RMZ 06.

2 ARCHAEOLOGICAL METHODOLOGY

- 2.1 The archaeological watching brief was conducted on a roughly triangular area of former cellar covering approximately 210 square metres (Fig. 1). This area was defined on its eastern and southern sides by the pile probing works in the southeast corner of the site undertaken in 2006. The area was first reduced to the top of the cellar's concrete slab at a depth of 3.20m, and then that slab was broken out to reveal London Clay.
- 2.2 All obstructions, consisting the remnants of an interior cellar wall and some concrete overspill from the piling probe operations in 2006, were also removed. Once London Clay was reached no further ground reduction occurred. All ground reduction work was carried out by machine under archaeological supervision.
- 2.3 Archaeological recording was again limited to observation from the top of the trench edges, and consisted of drawing a plan of the revealed deposits at 1:50 and recording all deposits on pro-forma context sheets.


3 ARCHAEOLOGICAL DESCRIPTION

- 3.1 The earliest deposit seen was natural London Clay [11] a fairly compact, orange/brown clay with no discernible inclusions. This was encountered across the base of the excavated area at a maximum height of 9.85m OD
- 3.2 Layer [11] was sealed by a concrete slab, which varied between 0.50m and 1.00m thick. This slab had formed the floor of a cellar in a modern building previously occupying the site.
- Overlying the concrete slab was a thick layer of modern made ground [10]. A fairly loose, mid greyish brown sandy silt with moderate concrete and brick fragment and rebar inclusions. This layer covered the entire reduced area and was approximately 3.15m 3.65m thick. The made ground was encountered at a maximum height of 14.00m OD.
- 3.4 No archaeological deposits were found within the excavated area.

4 CONCLUSION

4.1 It can be concluded that any potential archaeological deposits within the excavated area had been truncated by the concrete slab, which formed part of the cellar of the previous building. This accorded with the conclusions which resulted from the 2006 watching brief².
