INVENTORY OF JEWELS AND PLATE AT ALL SOULS' COLLEGE, OXFORD, 1448. Communicated by W. H. ST. JOHN HOPE, M.A.

I am indebted to Sir William Anson, Bart., warden of All Souls', for an opportunity of transcribing the following interesting inventory of the goods and jewels of the College in 1448. The first twelve items refer to pieces of secular plate not in ordinary use. The remainder are such ecclesiastical ornaments and jewels as were not daily occupied in chapel.
