THE ONE HUNDREDTH REPORT OF THE COUNCIL

FOR THE YEAR 1941

The Council has the honour to present its report for the year 1941.

During the year the Institute has lost eleven members by death and seventeen subscribing members by resignation. Five subscribing members have been elected and three libraries. Five libraries in enemy and enemy-occupied countries have ceased to subscribe. Among its losses the Council records with especial regret the deaths of Sir Arthur Evans, M.A., D.Litt., LL.D., F.R.S., F.B.A., F.S.A., and Mr. V. B. Crowther-Beynon, M.B.E., M.A., F.S.A.

The total membership at the end of December was as follows :—

No Summer Meeting and no visits to places of interest were organized during the year, but the usual programme of afternoon meetings in London was arranged and the following papers were read :—

Volume XCVII of the *Journal* was published in August.

The accounts for the year 1941, which have been prepared by Messrs. Whinney, Smith & Whinney, Chartered Accountants, are attached to the Report. The Council is indebted to Mr. H. A. A. Cruso, Honorary Auditor, for his services.

No grants in aid of excavations were made during the year, and the income from the Bunnell Lewis Trust Fund and the Hilton Bequest is being allowed to accumulate.

Under Rule 16, as revised in 1939, the President's term of office is limited to three years and he is not immediately eligible for re-election. In view of the valuable services being rendered to the Institute by Professor Hamilton Thompson and of the exceptional circumstances of the present time, the Council recommends that the revised Rule 16 be suspended and that Professor Hamilton Thompson be invited to serve the Institute for a further term of three years.

The Senior Vice-President, Mr. J. Holland Walker, M.B.E., F.S.A., retires, and the Council recommends that he be appointed an Honorary Vice-President and that Mr. J. Allan, F.B.A., F.S.A. be appointed a Vice-President in his place.

The members of the Council who retire in rotation are : Mr. A. W. G. Lowther, F.S.A., A.R.I.B.A. ; Mrs. Stuart Piggott ; Mr. E. J. Rudsdale ; Mr. E. M. M. Alexander ; Professor Tancred Borenius, Ph.D., D.Lit., F.S.A. ; and Mr. A. W. Clapham, C.B.E., F.B.A., P.S.A. The Council recommends the following to fill the vacant places : Mr. R. T. Beck, F.S.A., F.R.I.B.A. ; Mr. J. Ralph Edwards, A.R.W.A., F.R.I.B.A. ; Mr. G. B. Grundy, M.A., D.Litt. ; Miss Kathleen Kenyon, M.A., F.S.A. ; Mr. J. N. L. Myres, M.A., F.S.A., and Mr. C. E. Stevens, M.A., F.S.A.

The Council also recommends that Mr. H. A. A. Cruso be re-appointed Honorary Auditor.
