Finally, it should be noted that the apparent evidence of Iron Age/Roman settlement continuity at Sites 2/3 and 5/6 is now known to be common throughout much of the region. At Clay Farm, only the Site 4 Romano-British settlement is seemingly without a later prehistoric predecessor. However, in that instance too little of it was available for investigation to pronounce upon this with any degree of certainty and, south or westwards, an early settlement may still well lie adjacent to it.

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
