

## **Acle High School Community Excavation, Springfield, Acle 50513**

### **The Finds (2007)**

**by NAU Archaeology (April 2008)**

#### **Pottery**

The site produced 204 fragments of Roman, Saxon, medieval and post medieval pottery, weighing (1.931kg).

#### Methodology

The assemblage was quantified (counted and weighed) by form and fabric (see Appendix 3). Identification of the fabrics was based on the typology of Norwich ceramics established by Jennings (Jennings 1981).

#### Roman

The majority of the assemblage is of Roman date (1st to 4th century) consisting of 103 sherds, weighing (1.480kg). Pottery types recovered include coarse Grey wares, shell tempered wares and finer table wares including Nene Valley Colour Coat.

#### Saxon

A single sherd of Gritty Ipswich ware dating from mid-seventh to mid-ninth century was also recovered, weighing (0.002kg).

#### Medieval

Sixteen sherds of eleventh to fourteenth century, local medieval unglazed ware were collected from several contexts, weighing (0.079kg).

#### Post medieval

This group consists of eighty-four sherds of 16th to twentieth century pottery, weighing (0.307kg). The assemblage includes examples of Late Medieval and transitional wares, Glazed Red Earthenware, Staffordshire Slipware, Stoneware and later domestic china wares.

#### **Ceramic Building Material**

The site produced thirty-five examples of Roman, post-medieval and modern ceramic building material weighing 1.005kg.

#### Methodology

The assemblage was quantified (counted and weighed) by form and fabric (see Appendix 4). The fabrics were identified by eye and the main inclusions noted. Fabric descriptions and dates are based on the provisional type series established by Sue Anderson formerly of the Suffolk Unit.

#### Roman

The Ceramic Building Material of Roman date is represented by eight examples of Tegula, bonding tile and a possible piece of Imbrex, weighing (0.654kg).

### Post medieval

Twenty-nine fragments of eighteenth to twentieth century post-medieval and modern Ceramic Building Material was collected, weighing (0.366kg). The assemblage consists of pieces of medium sandy brick and pan tile.

### Metal artefacts

Fifteen objects of copper alloy, iron and lead from eleven contexts were recovered from the site (see Appendix 8).

### Medieval

A single medieval strap fastening was collected from the spoil of trench C. The artefact is similar to one of early fifteenth century date from a site in Norwich (Margeson 1993, fig 21, no. 252).

### Post medieval and modern

The majority of the metal objects recovered from the site (eleven) are of post medieval date.

The assemblage consists of a single blunt oval mount with rivet hole, a decorative openwork monogram, three sheet fragments, a button and an undiagnostic late post medieval fitting.

Objects made of iron include an angled rod fragment, a building fitting with a looped terminal and a staple.

Also recovered from the site was a cylindrical lead weight, weighing 23g and a modern lead decorative fitting from a water feature in the form of a frogs head.

### Undiagnostic

Two fragments of lead waste were recovered and are of uncertain date.

### Other Finds

Other finds recovered from the site consisting of three pieces of fired clay, weighing (0.049kg), five clay tobacco pipe stem fragments of post medieval date, weighing (0.006kg), two fragments of modern mortar (0.136kg), two pieces of non-local, un-worked stone (0,004kg), five undiagnostic iron nails and five fragments of post medieval and modern bottle and window glass. Also recovered were five prehistoric worked flints including a broken early Bronze Age barbed and tanged arrowhead (identified by S Bates).
