Page 1

West 19'11". South 4'10". Depth 4'1"

Green glazed pottery, on floor level (?[C:7060]).

West 21'6". South 9'5". Depth 3'2". In broken slate level (?[C:7059] south of E - W wall (this is one of the E-W walls discussed by Radford in Site/GLA/2/5: either N boundary wall of Abbot's Hall courtyard or earlier Abbot's Hall).

Bits of burnt wood – region of 21' west, 9'3" depth, south 9'6". More wood further South.

20'6" west. 8'4" south, depth 4ft (Note inside front cover: RR said 12thC or pre-conquest. On yellow plaster (?[C:7060] just south of wall under rubble & mortar layer (?[7058]. Later otherwise identified by expert on pottery).

Thursday 13th

South 8'2". West 28'3". Depth 4'8"

Piece of pot – darkish green glaze on outer side, plain pot on inside. On lower plaster floor level (?[C:7060], just south of wall N boundary wall of Abbot's Hall courtyard or earlier Abbot's Hall).

Page 1 back

Thursday afternoon. Pieces of pot in cist (possibly later grave) at NW corner of north face (discussed also by Radford in Site/GLA/2/5).

Monday 17th (1). Many bones in trench going west from main block. All above plaster floor level and below a thin black level.

2. 1 piece of ridge tile plain on one side, yellowish green with traces of glaze on other, traces of black, possibly burning. About 8ft West of edge of main block of excavation, in same trench as 1.

3. 1 piece red pot, small patch and dark green glaze in one place. In westward extension trench above plaster floor level. 6ft west.

Page 2

4. same as 2, slightly more north.

Tuesday 18th. Unsealed.

2 pieces of curved tile (?), 3 layers on each piece – red, black, brown glaze. In disturbed piece on SW corner of westward extension, in clay layer 4ft South. Depth 3ft 11ins. West 5ft 6ins.

1 piece of pot – probably bit of bottom 2 edge and red on outside, orange on inside. Underneath floor level and in westward extension trench 4ft South. Depth 5ft 11ins, west 5ft 6ins.

1 piece of pot – red pot with green and yellow glaze. Same area as 2.

1 large piece ridge tile, red tile with green on outside. South 3'9. West 5ft 6. Depth 4ft.

Page 2 back

same as 2. 1 to 5 in disturbed SW corners - possibly scaffold pole hole. Sealed.

1 piece of tile, red, black, other glaze. Under plaster floor level and lias chips. South 2ft 3ins, west 2ft 2ins. Depth 3ft 9ins in westward extension.

1 piece red pot with green and red glaze, south 2ft 3. West 2ft2. Depth 3ft11. Under plaster floor and lias chips in westward extension trench.

1 piece glazed red tile under plaster floor in west extension trench south 1'5", west 2'2", depth 3'8".

Page 3

South 1'3", west 3'6", depth 3'6".

3 pieces of pot just under floor level in westward extension trench. One piece black with green glaze and brown stripes. 1 piece red with green and yellow rough glaze. 1 piece red with brownish glaze.

1 piece of yellow with mottled green glaze near 9.

1 piece red & black tile. South 1'2", west 3', depth 3'6". Below plaster floor.

1 piece of red tile (?) with greenish glaze. South 1'2", west 2'2", depth 3'8" below plaster floor in west extension trench.

Page 3 back

Wednesday 19th.

1) 2 pieces of pot 1 red with brown glaze. One orange-yellow pot with green glaze. Just above the wall under the rubbish pit at east end of trench starting 50' and wide to 34' south – about 3'-3'6" west.

2) 1 piece thin pot, layer red then black, then red. Near 1 – lost.
