In NE corner at depth of 3'1" in dirty clay level, 2 large stones – foundation stones [C:2055] of the E wall of Dunstan's wall which surrounded ancient cemetery.

Foundation trench of wall followed to S side of trench, at a width varying from 1' to 1'6".

In foundation trench [C:2042]...

....in clay at depth of 3'9", from N side of trench 4' ? from S end 7'6" and adjacent to E wall, a large post-hole [C:2057] [C:2058]. Diameter 14".
