
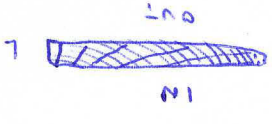
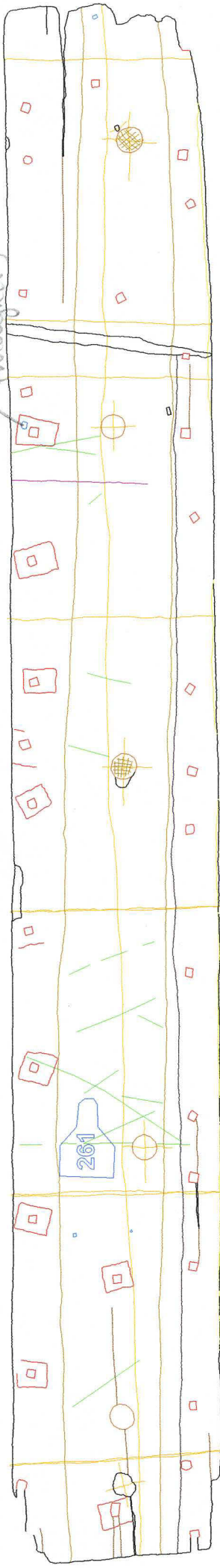

Brief Description: [timber element, p/s, condition, fragments]		
Notable Features: [tool marks, scribed lines, decoration, repairs] POINTS TO LOOK OUT FOR WHEN RECORDING ufos FORWARD EDGE CUT OFF IN ANTIQUITY WHEN STEP CUT OUT. LB: INSCRIBED LINES: VAGUE NEAR COW TAG AUGER HOLE THAT THE NAIL'S MISSED. - overall: small nail holes - inboard: sapwood? (or just softwood.) - inboard: forward end, big dip next to first row (3rd time I've seen this) - inboard: aft end: limit next to last tree nail = animal bore hole - inboard: aft end: near bevel: rectangular hole <input type="checkbox"/> - outboard: sharp type 1 line on scarf		
Wood Science: [rings, ARW, knots, sapwood, conversion] <u>Tangential</u> Pith beyond lower edge (checked by computer microscope!) see plot c80H. No ARW - too angled.
