
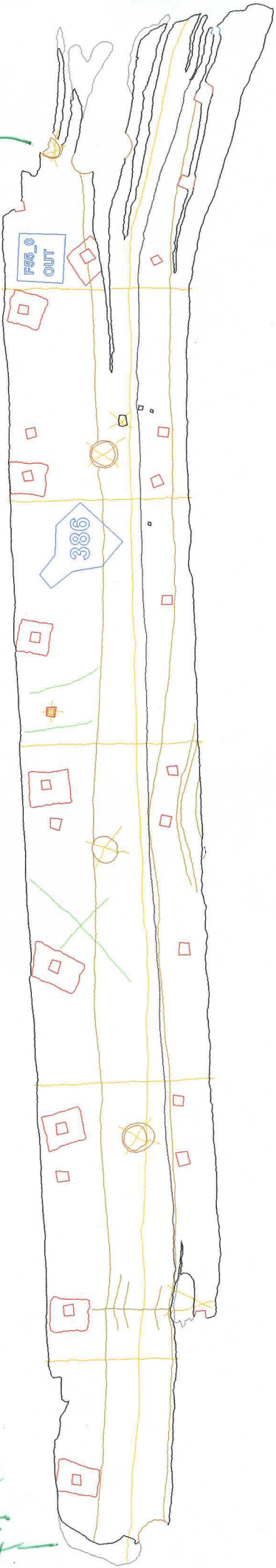

Brief Description: [timber element, p/s, condition, fragments] <b>short fragment, damaged on both ends.</b>		
Notable Features: [tool marks, scribed lines, decoration, repairs] POINTS TO LOOK OUT FOR WHEN RECORDING ufos <b>Inboard: inscribed line, centre of plank; possibly second line crossing the first one.</b> <b>Outboard: possible inscribed lines off end.</b> Wooden fastener on top inboard side, second from cow tag towards off end. This was drawn as a cluster nail hole with a wooden peg repair - ✓		
Wood Science: [rings, ARW, knots, sapwood, conversion] <b>C100A Radial Pith beyond lower edge. ARW = 1.98mm. Rather very grain.</b>
