



Cow Tag **57** Type **Possible stringer**

Description Dried timber possible stringer or plank. 67cm in length 15cm wide and 3.5cm thick. Two complete treenail holes and two partial treenail holes. Treenails no longer in situ. Diameter of treenails is 2.5cm. One metal fastener - no longer in situ. Shaft measured 1cm x 1cm. No head or clench plate impression visible due to damage. End B (see drawing) has a deliberate cut - appears to be a **Rebate** for another piece. It is 2cm deep. The base of the rebate has evidence of caulking - animal hair. Surface B has toolmarks covering entire surface - possibly caused during the splitting of the timber from the tree. Second fastener in the centre of the plank appears to have had its point hammered down. (impression remains)
 See 46 - same timber as 57. Rebate continues onto 46
