
Cow Tag **59** Type Timber fragment

Description 85cm in length. 9.5cm wide at widest. 4cm thick - tapering to 0.3cm at 'end B'. Surface is cracking and has suffered modern damage. No treenails or iron nail evidence. No visible tool marks. The function of this piece is unclear however it is unlikely to be a plank fragment due to the lack of fasteners.

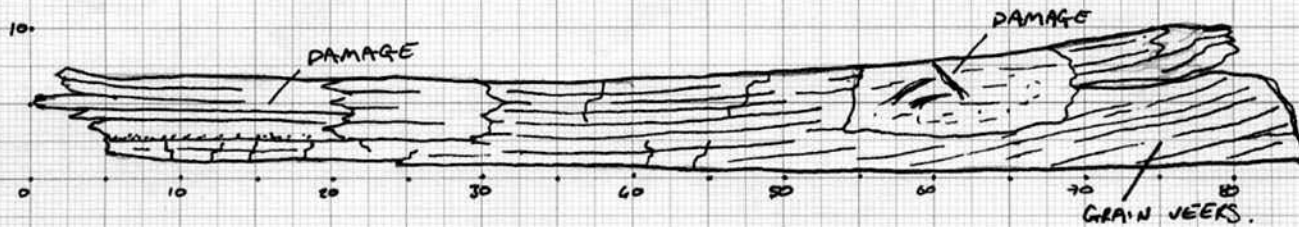

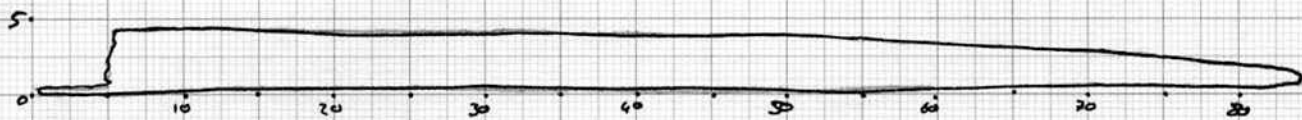

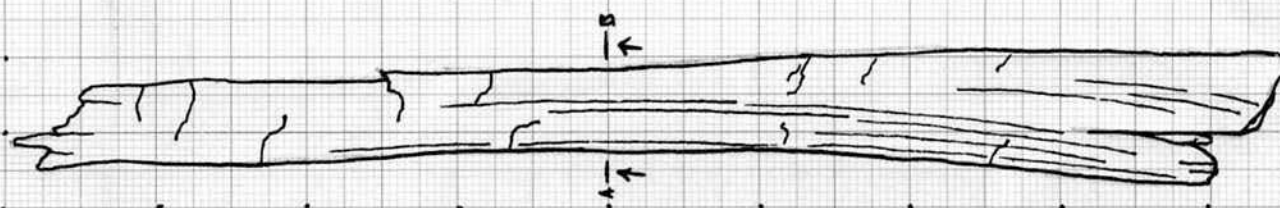
SURFACE A



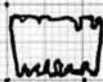
PROFILE
