stone steps to the west side of the museum F1002 (Film 1.4) revealed they were embedded into a sandy layer which sat on a firm pinky dense brown clay 1013 (Film 1.32) – see Photograph 2.This had stone and pebble inclusions, was sticky and strong in consistency and was the fill of the whole of the front terrace of the museum.

The artefacts were mainly willow pattern china, some creamware from Leeds ,clay pipe stems, glass and kitchen pancheon ware. All these finds were of a compatible date with the building of the Rotunda Museum. This clay layer was 40mm below the black loamy garden soil which covered the base stones of the museum (Film 1.10).

The west wing was built in 1860-61. Below the stone ashlar there are brick foundations F1007 (Film 1.15) which are 75mm deep (Film 3 22a) - See photograph 3. It was terminated with a brick rubble base (Film 3.9). This had been built off a sandy base with layering of boulder clay 1008 (Film 3.3a) – see Photograph 4. This seemed to be a natural form, with no inclusions. The underpinning structure of the whole of the brick build wall is shown in Film 4.16a.

The east wing was also built in 1860-61 although the foundation detail is different and better quality and gives the impression of a different build from the west wing. Here the depth of brick underpinning is 1.75m before the base of heavy dense dark brown boulder clay 1009 (Film 1.35) – see Photograph 5. This same boulder clay had been re-deposited against the finished build of the underpinning (Film 1.34), entirely different to the sandy deposit on the west side (Film 3.33a).

The drum was built in 1827. Unlike the two wings the drum has a cellar and as reported above the floor of this is built off natural clay. The cellar floor is at the same level as the footpath south of the front garden. Externally the ground stripping revealed that the cellar walls consisted of good quality coursed rubble, well pointed and this seems to indicate that the walls were exposed when built, rather than cut into the clay and that the clay against these walls had been re-deposited later. There was no foundation cut for this feature. The cellar walls had three arched openings, the arches being brick, the central arch being blocked by brickwork. These arched openings must have been top provide light to the cellars and had a metal grille at surface level – remnants are to be seen.

Two culvert drains F1012 was found to be running around each side the central drum of the museum in a curve (Film 3.9) -see Photograph 6. This was from the first stage of the build to drain away any water from the higher ground around the base of the museum and away following the natural slope of the land to the front. The drains were clearly a response to the poor ground and drainage conditions which were encountered at the time of building the drum. The drains had brick walls (Film 3.18a) and a heavy stone capping to the top. The east side had a gravel and stone mix base on clay and the west side had a clay tile bottom.

The museum was built on a 'plateau' of land which had been cut from the natural form of the sloping land and into the boulder clay from which the cellar was built this decision being an after thought following land slippage. The front terrace was then filled with a mix of clay and garden soil to landscape the front. The whole of this area was supported to the south with a curved stone wall F1014, Film 3 29a. Natural undisturbed clay lies at the same level as that within the cellar and at path level - see Photograph 8.

There was no evidence of any archaeological remains dating from before the erection of the museum on this site at the depths examined.

With the exception of one fragment of medieval Scarborough Ware, the pottery found in all these locations was either post medieval or 19th century (97%) and this is consistent with the deposits being made during the construction of the museum.

Interpretation

It is recorded that during the building of the drum poor ground conditions were encountered and there was a slippage. The decision was therefore taken at the time to incorporate a cellar into the design – ie the cellar was an after thought. The archaeological monitoring has shown that this was carried out by taking the ground down to the same level as the current cellar floor, building the drum and then backfilling against it to put the ground level back to approximately its original height

Conclusion

The archaeological monitoring has provided important information about the way in which the museum was constructed in the 19th century.

The archaeological monitoring has shown that any earlier archaeology which may have existed was destroyed during the erection of the museum in the 1820's and its wings in the 1860's and that no important archaeological survival has been affected by the current works
