**PARK LANE, MIDDLEHAM**

This is to confirm that, on instructions from Mr and Mrs P Brannon, I have carried out a watching brief during site preparation works and excavation of foundations in advance of the construction of a new dwelling on the south side of Park Lane, Middleham. I attach a location plan at 1:2,500.

The entire site proved to be covered in a thick, black deposit of dirty silty soil, containing rubbish of the early part of the present century. This deposit exceeded 1.6 metres in depth, and at no point did contractors' operations penetrate through it. No find of any archaeological significance was encountered.
