APPENDIX 3

Howardian Hills AONB Woodland Archaeology Survey Scheme of Works for Archaeological Field Survey and Assessment

Aim and Methodology

- 1 The aim of the survey is to provide an assessment, to be used for land management purposes, of the upstanding historic landscape features within woodland blocks. The survey will be undertaken within the general conception framework of historic landscape characterisation, and assessment will be carried out by comparison of existing recorded information with field observations using based analysis.
- 2 The survey will involve five tasks including 1) the review of existing recorded information, 2) production of record sheets, base, and working maps on which to record information, 3) field inspection and recording, 4) compilation of summery and overlay maps showing the recorded features, and 5) production of a summary assessment report.
- 3 Field inspection will be carried out by a team of two on a parcel - or compartment- by-compartment basis for each woodland block. Both recorded and unrecorded features will be identified and located, their extent plotted, and observations made about them. All reasonable directions of the landowners or their agents will be complied with, and any areas which cannot be accessed or inspected will be plotted on maps.

Access and Liaison

- 4 Access to the survey areas should be arranged through Mr. Paul Jackson of the Heritage Unit, County Hall, Northallerton, Tel (01609) 780780, ext. 2911.
- 5 Archaeological matters as well as any project monitoring and liaison arrangement should be discussed with Mr. Neil Campling of the Heritage Unit on Extension 2330.

Scheme of works:

Review of SMR and AONB Historic Environment Study Data

- 6 Maps and documents in the Heritage Unit should be examined to identify and locate recorded upstanding features within the survey areas. Information on the extent and condition of features recorded in the archive of the Howardian Hills Historic Environment study archive should be incorporated as baseline records for the survey. The location and extent of features on 2nd edition 25" OS maps should be compared with features surveyed in the Historic Environment study.

Working Maps and Records

- 7 A field record form, as well as base maps and working maps of the four woodland blocks will be produced. Working maps should incorporate numbered woodland compartments where available from landowners or their land agents. Maps should be produced using map info or a compatible GIS to an appropriate scale i.e. 1:2500 or 1:10,000. The record form should allow for the recording of woodland management features such as pollards and standards, as well as built features. The form should record SMR number, survey number, identification or name of feature, brief description, grid reference and dimensions for non-extensive features, parish tree species, shape, class or form period where determinable, condition any complication date, and surveyor. The form should also provide space to make a sketch plot

Field Inspection

- 8 A field team of two should walk over the survey areas compartment in a systematic and uniform way to locate, plot the extent of, and make other observations about the circumstances of the recorded features. In the process of carrying out this walkover, any unrecorded features which come to light should also be recorded to the same level as known features. All features will be plotted either by on-site digital data capture or by transcription on to record forms or maps and subsequent digital plotting. The circumstances of any large stones or group of stones should be examined, and recorded if potentially of anthropogenic origin. All boundary banks and wood banks should be plotted as fully as possible. Large coppice stools, pollards or veteran standards should be identified as to their species and likely woodland management origin.

Summary Maps and Assessment Report

- 9 All features, including those recorded on working maps or record forms, should be digitally plotted into mapinfo tables or compatible GIS data files. Summary maps should be produced to show the compartments surveyed, and the number, extent, distribution, and associations of the Historic landscape features within the woodland survey areas. Summary maps to show the distribution of current or potential threats to features should also be produced, as well as maps to show any features lost, damaged or reduced in extent. Where suitable, overlay maps on acetate film should be produced to graphically demonstrate associates or landscape processes.
- 10 An assessment report should be prepared following NYCC guidelines on reporting. The report should include background details about the survey, a summary of works carried out, a gazetteer of all features recorded, copies of appropriate summary maps, and a short analysis of the Historic landscape character of the woodland blocks in respect of their origin or time depth, potential for archaeology, and Historic landscape processes evident from the survey.

- 11 Four copies of the assessment report should be produced for the use of the County Heritage Unit and the landowners. A copy of the summary maps produced for the assessment should be provided in digital format for display in MapInfo.

Terms and conditions

- 12 The survey will be the subject of a temporary contract for services(not a contract for employment).No contract will be signed without a project risk assessment having been lodged with the county Heritage Unit by the contractor
- 13 Copyright in reports prepared by the contractor shall be the subject of a non-exclusive license in favour of the County Council to use such reports for their statutory functions and provide copies to third parties as an incidental to such function.
- 14 County SMR and OS digital map information provide to the contractor shall be used solely for the purposes of the survey and not for any other purpose whatsoever. Neither the contractor nor his agents or servants shall by any means copy or part with possession of the whole or any part of the information.
- 15 No variations to work will be undertaken without consultation with the County Heritage Unit and further agreement in Writing.

APPENDIX 4

Scheduling Criteria

Period: All types of monument that characterise a category or period should be considered for preservation, in order that a representative sample may be preserved for posterity.

Rarity: There are some monument categories which in certain periods are so scarce that all surviving examples which still retain some archaeological potential should be preserved. In general, however, a selection must be made which portrays the typical and commonplace as well as the rare. This process should take account of all aspects of the distribution of a particular class of monument, both in a national and a regional context.

Documentation: The significance of a monument may be enhanced by the existence of records of previous investigations or, in the case of more recent monuments, by the supporting evidence of contemporary written records.

Group Value: The value of a single monument (such as a field system) may be greatly enhanced by its association with related contemporary monuments (such as a settlement and cemetery) or with monuments of different periods. In some cases, it is preferable to protect the complete group of monuments, including associated and adjacent land, rather than protect isolated monuments within the group.

Survival/Condition: The survival of a monument's archaeological potential both above and below ground is a particularly important consideration, and should be assessed in relation to its present condition and surviving features.

Fragility/Vulnerability: Highly important archaeological evidence from some field monuments can be destroyed by a single ploughing or by other unsympathetic treatment, and such monuments would particularly benefit from the protection which scheduling confers.

Diversity: Some monuments may be selected for scheduling because they possess a combination of high quality features, rather than a single important attribute: for example, a Roman town with associated field systems.

Potential: The nature of evidence cannot always be specified precisely, but it may be possible to demonstrate the potential value of a monument as a result of evaluation work.
