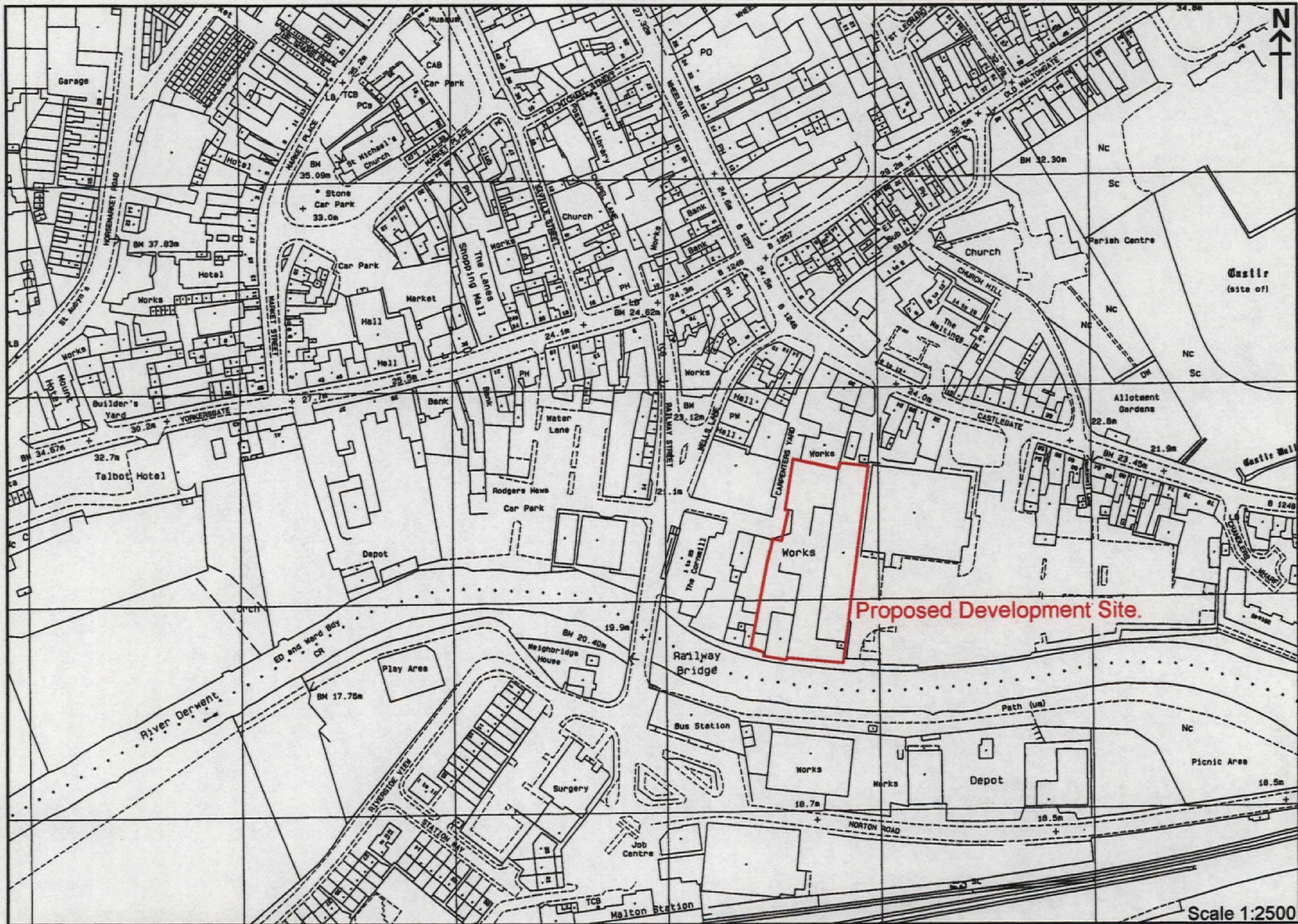


Figure 3. Present Site Layout.

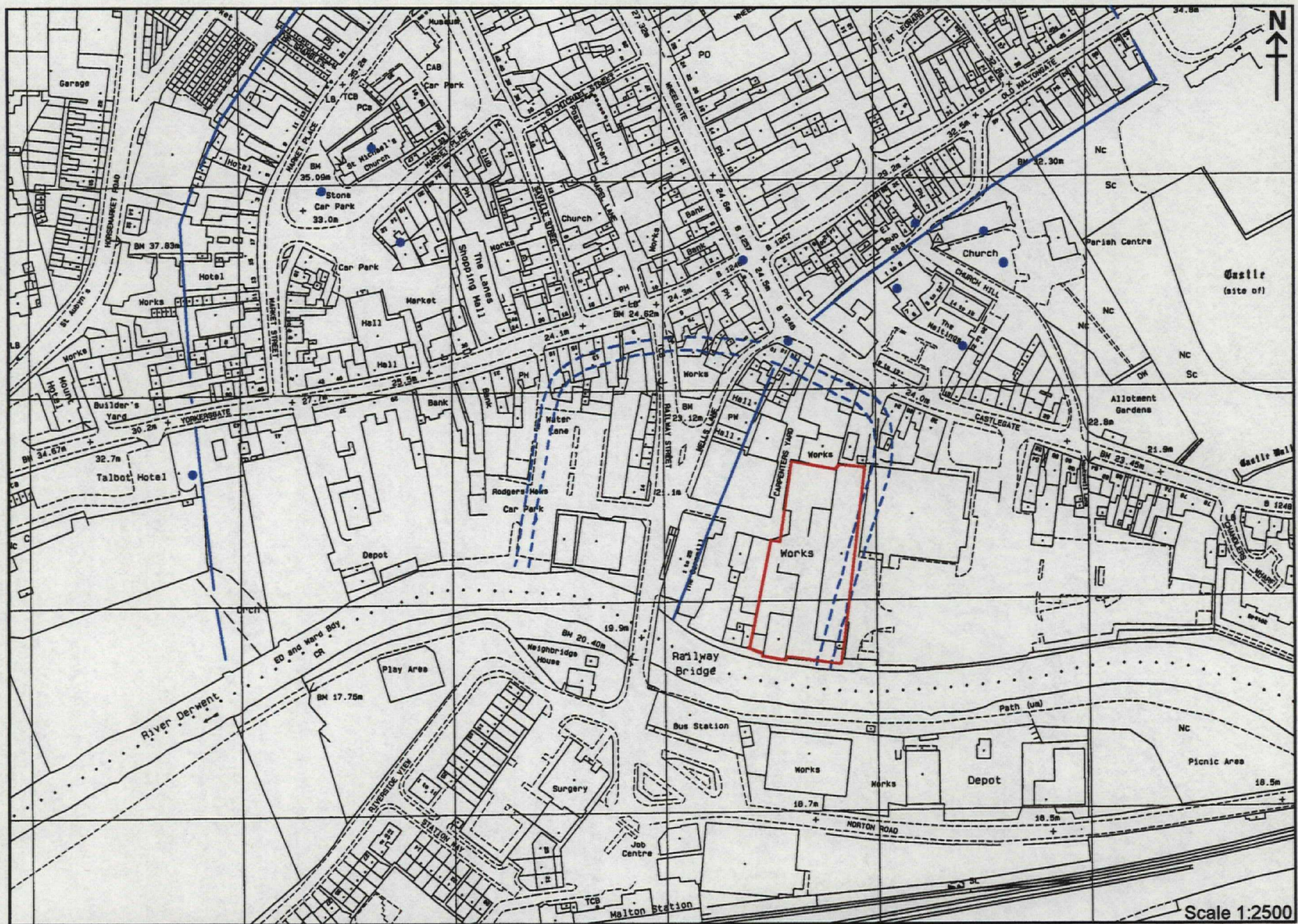


Figure 4. Location of Town Wall and Ditched Enclosure.

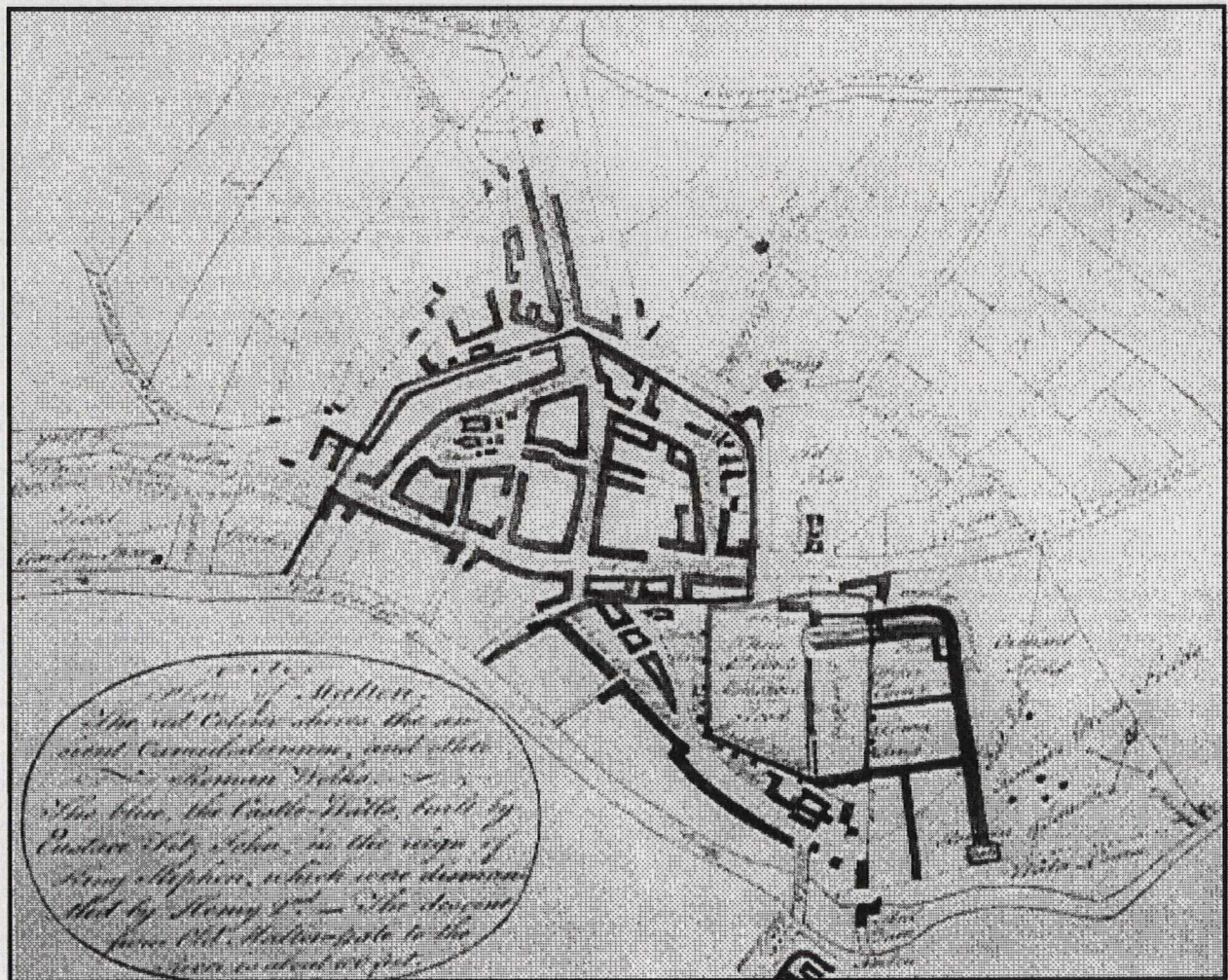


Figure 5. Hinderwell's Map of Malton, c. 1825.

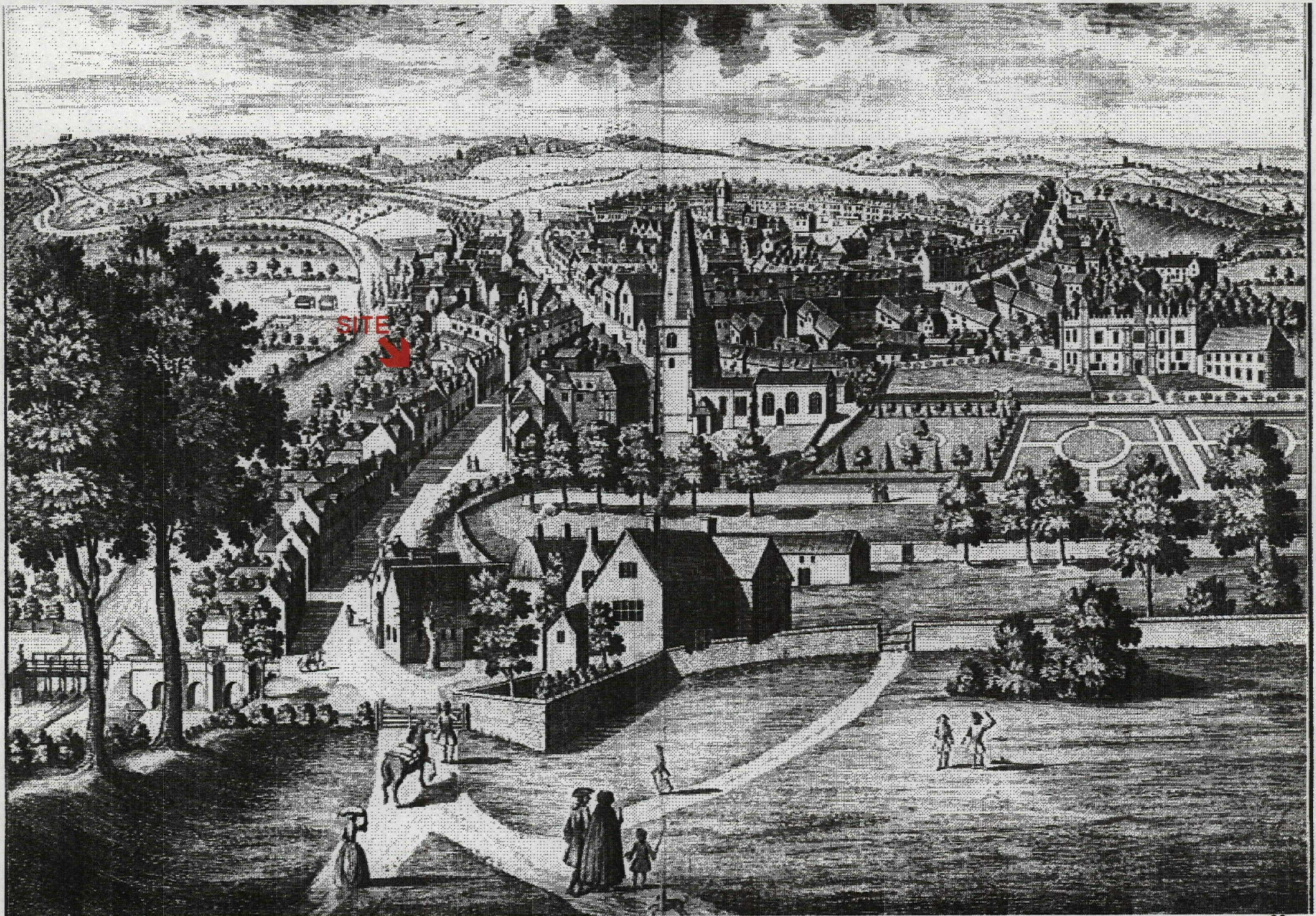


Figure 6. John Settrington's View of Malton, c. 1728.

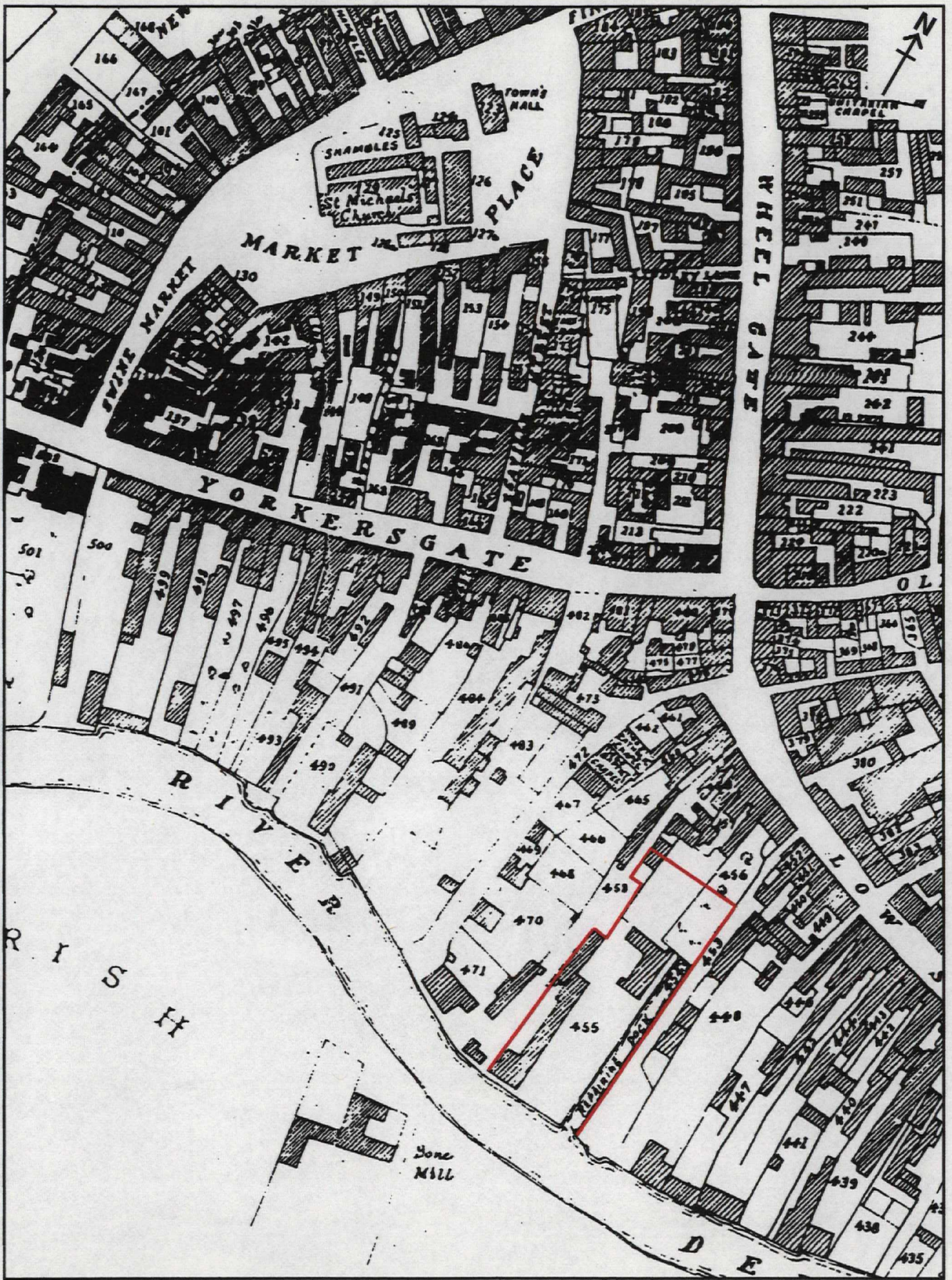


Figure 8. Robert Wise's Map of Malton, c. 1840.

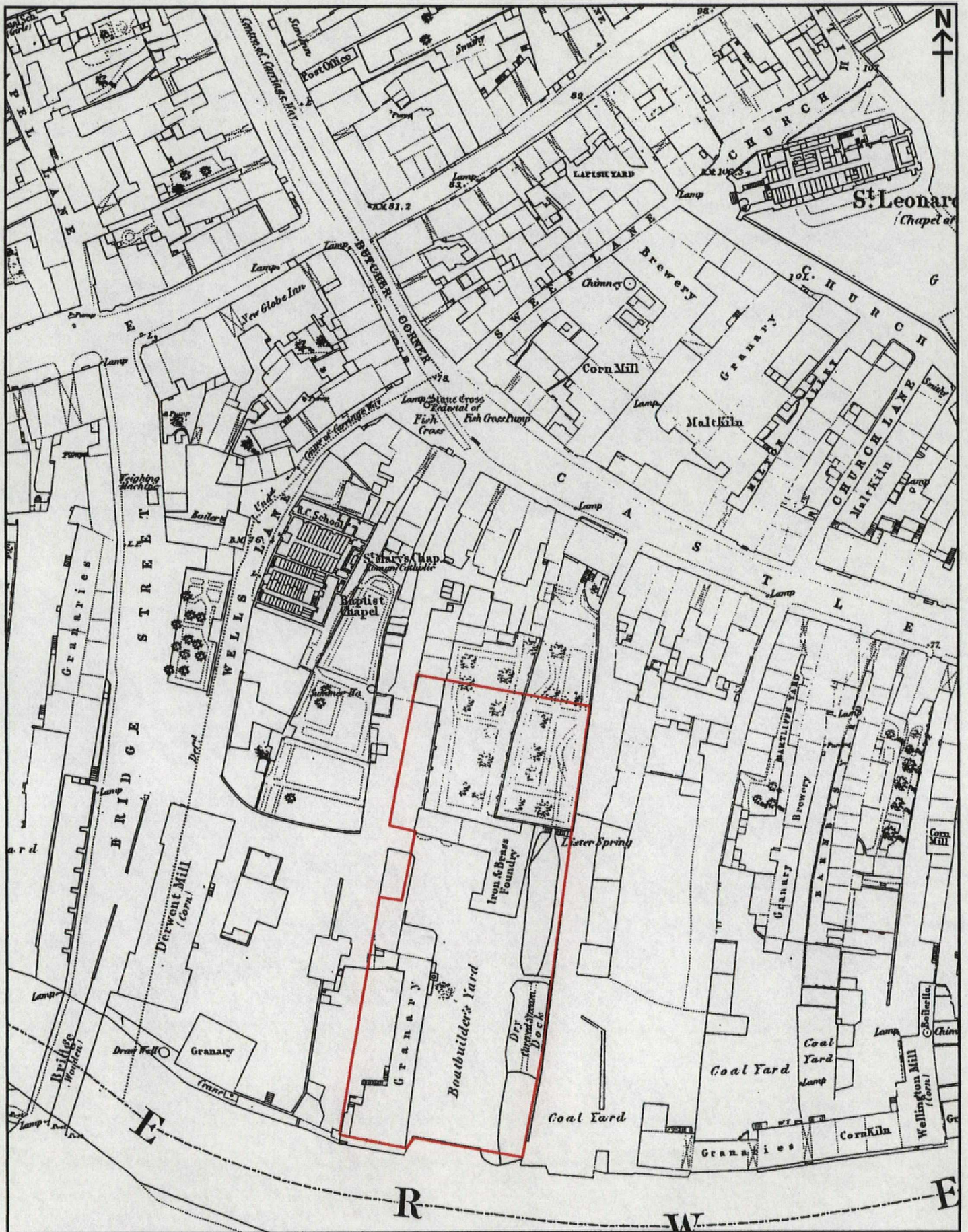


Figure 9. Ordnance Survey First Edition Map of Malton, c. 1850. Scale 5 foot to 1 mile.

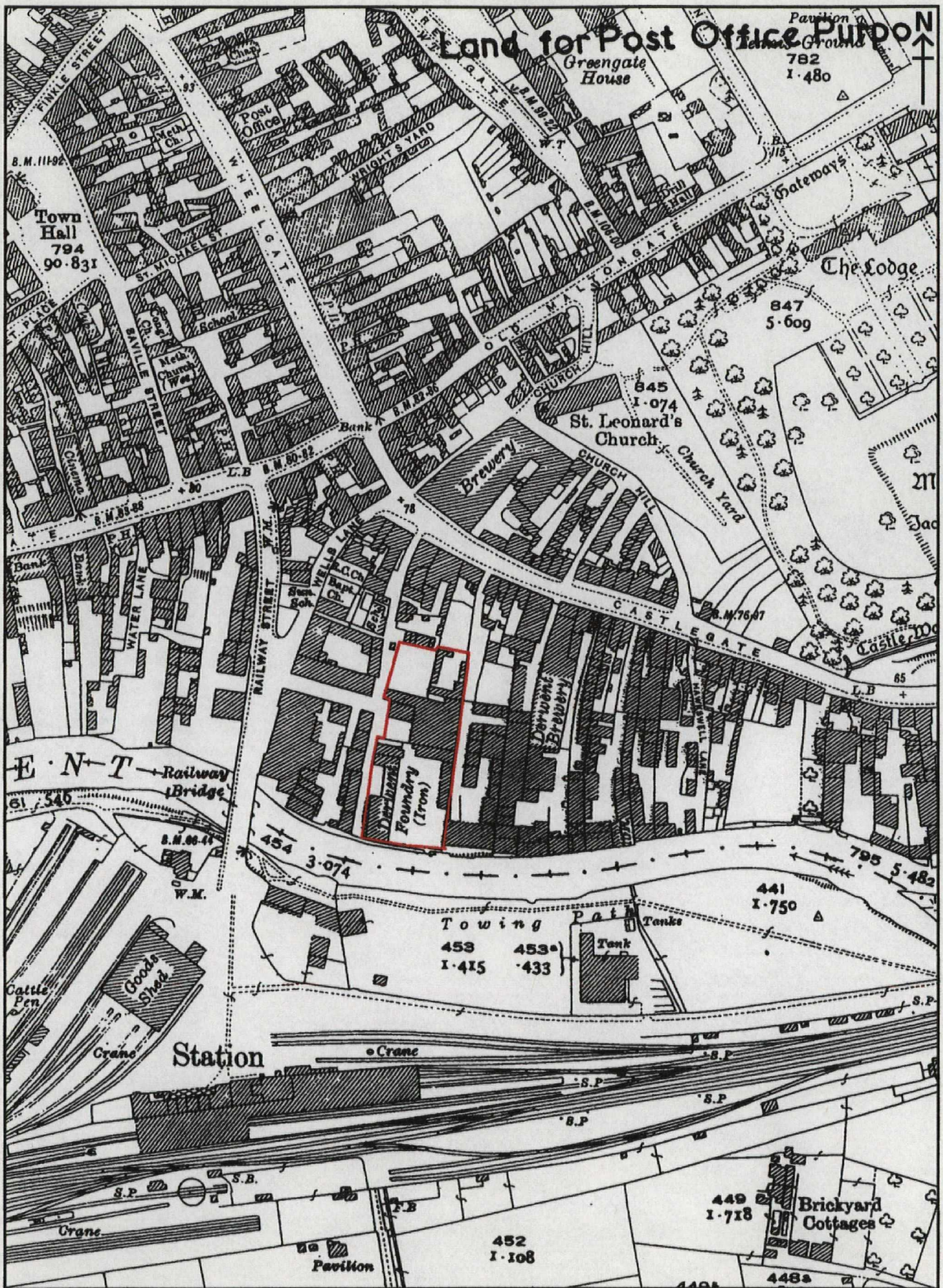


Figure 10. Ordnance Survey County Series Map of Malton, c. 1911. Scale 25" to 1 mile.

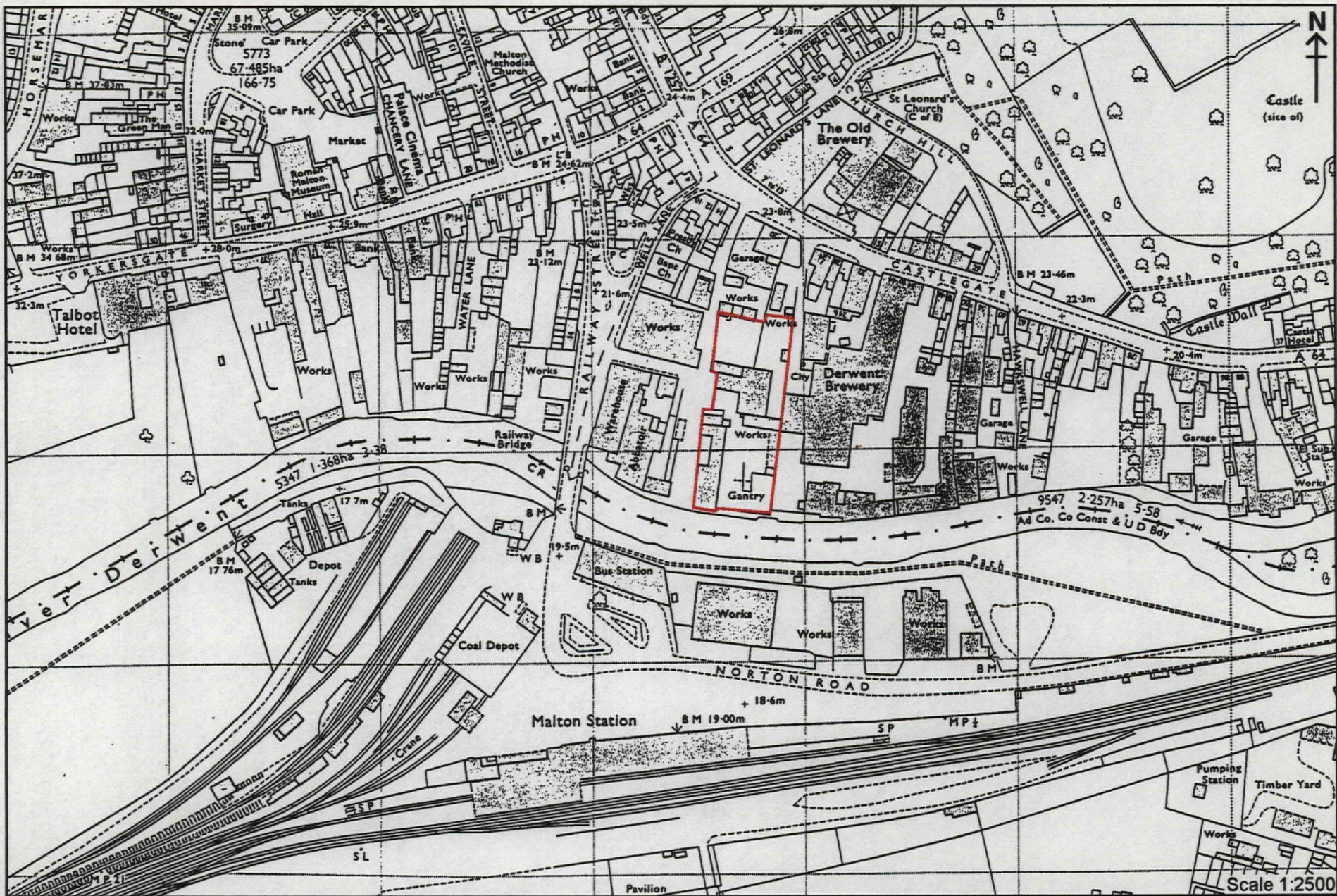


Figure 11. Ordnance Survey Map of Malton, c. 1985.

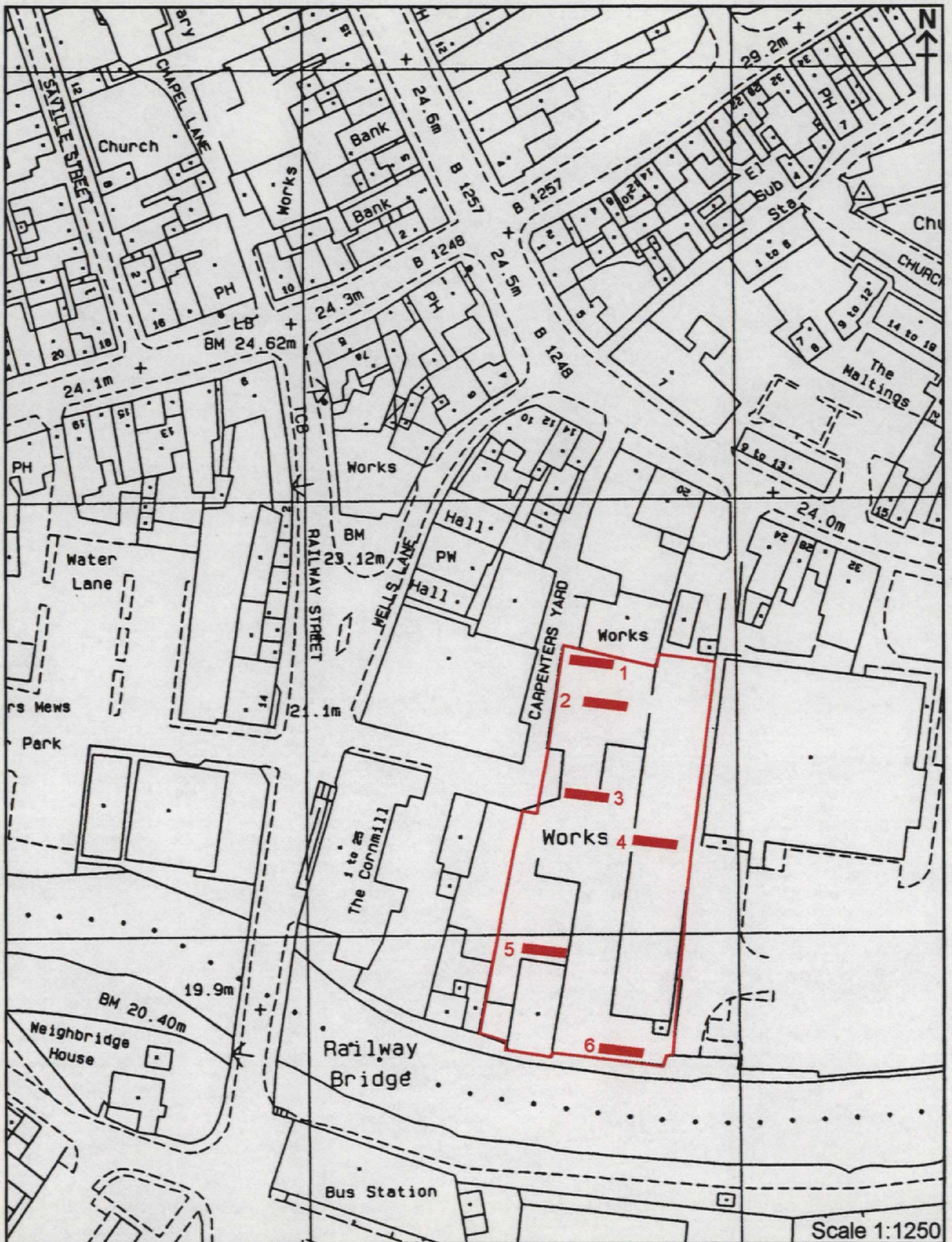


Figure 12. Trench Locations..

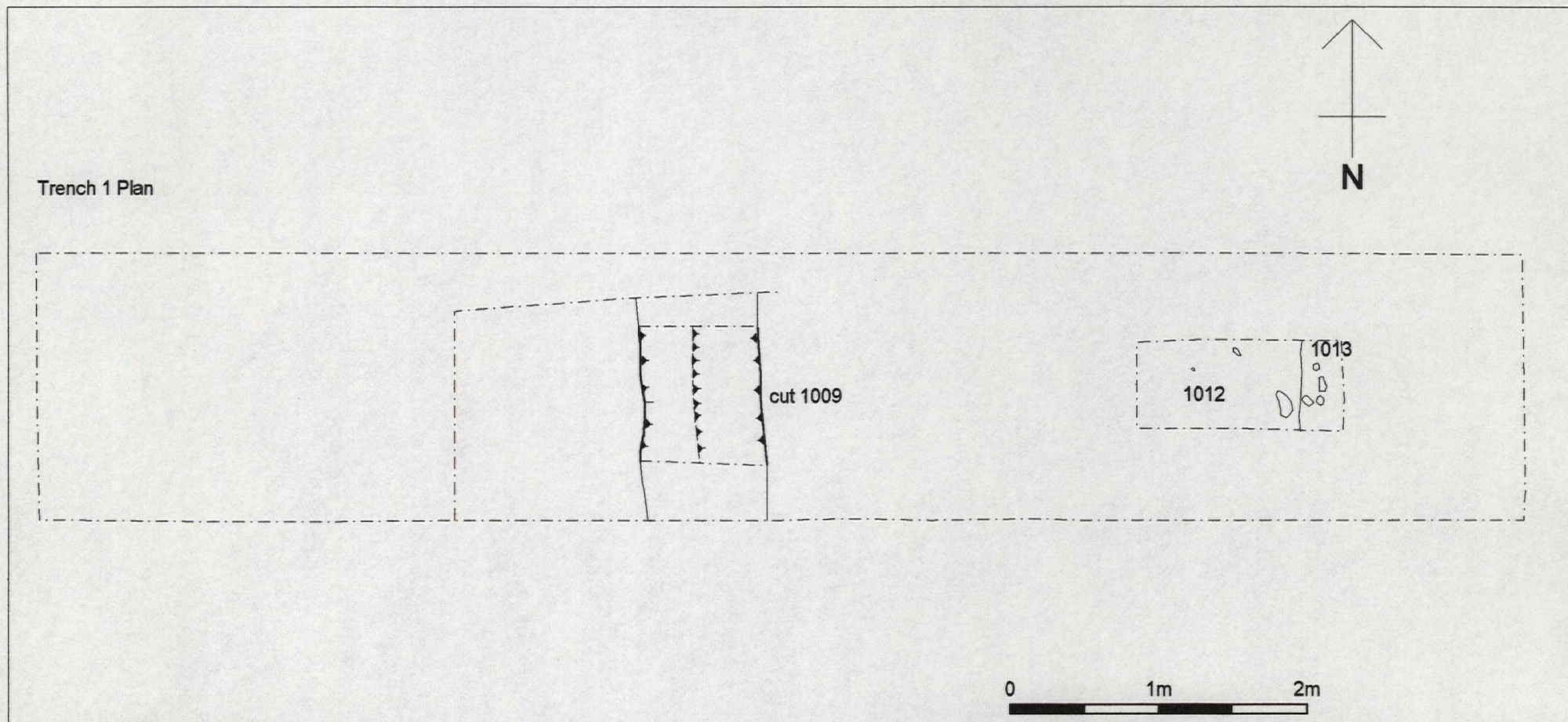


Figure 13. Trench 1 Plan.

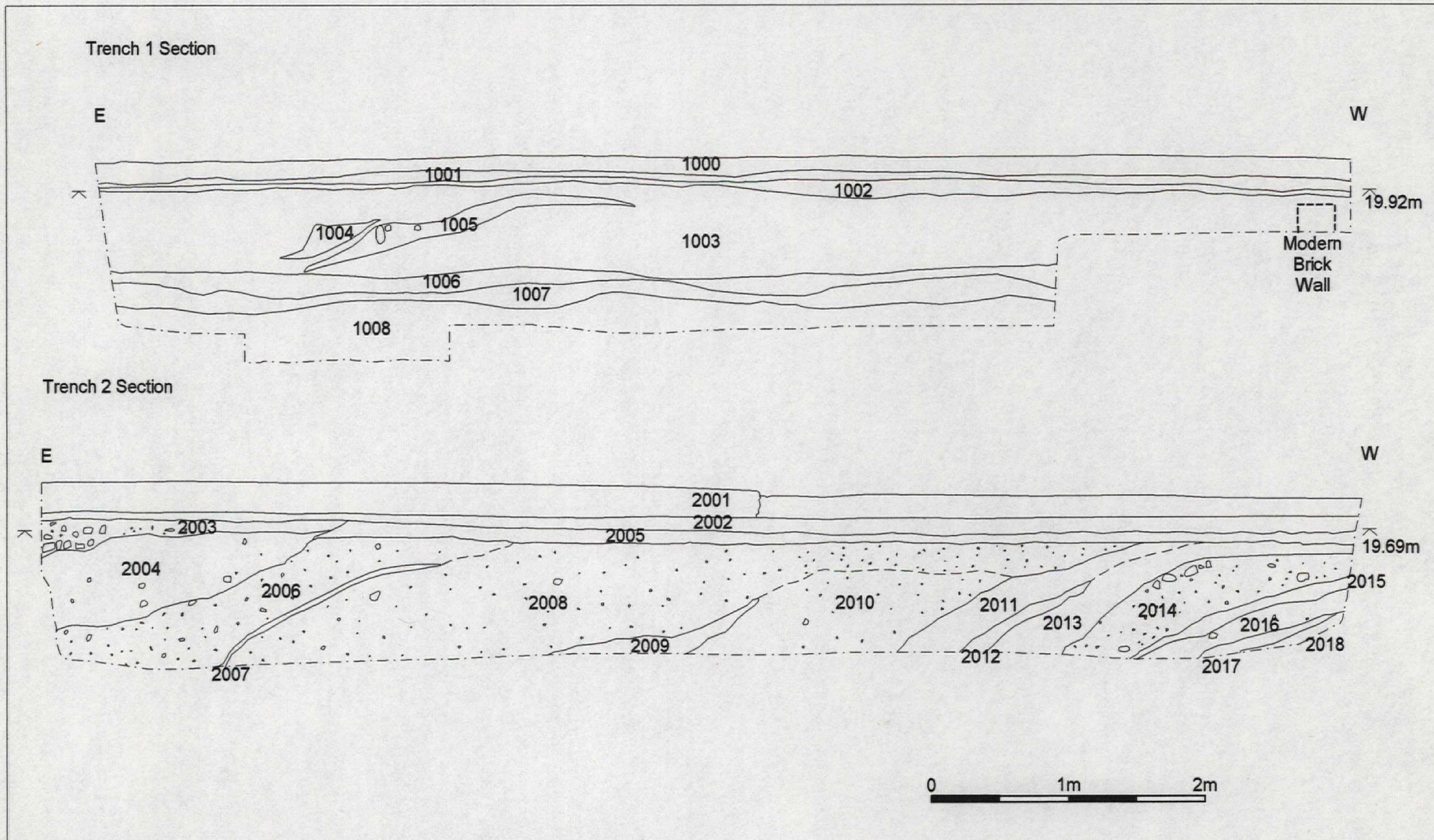


Figure 14. Trenches 1 and 2 Sections.

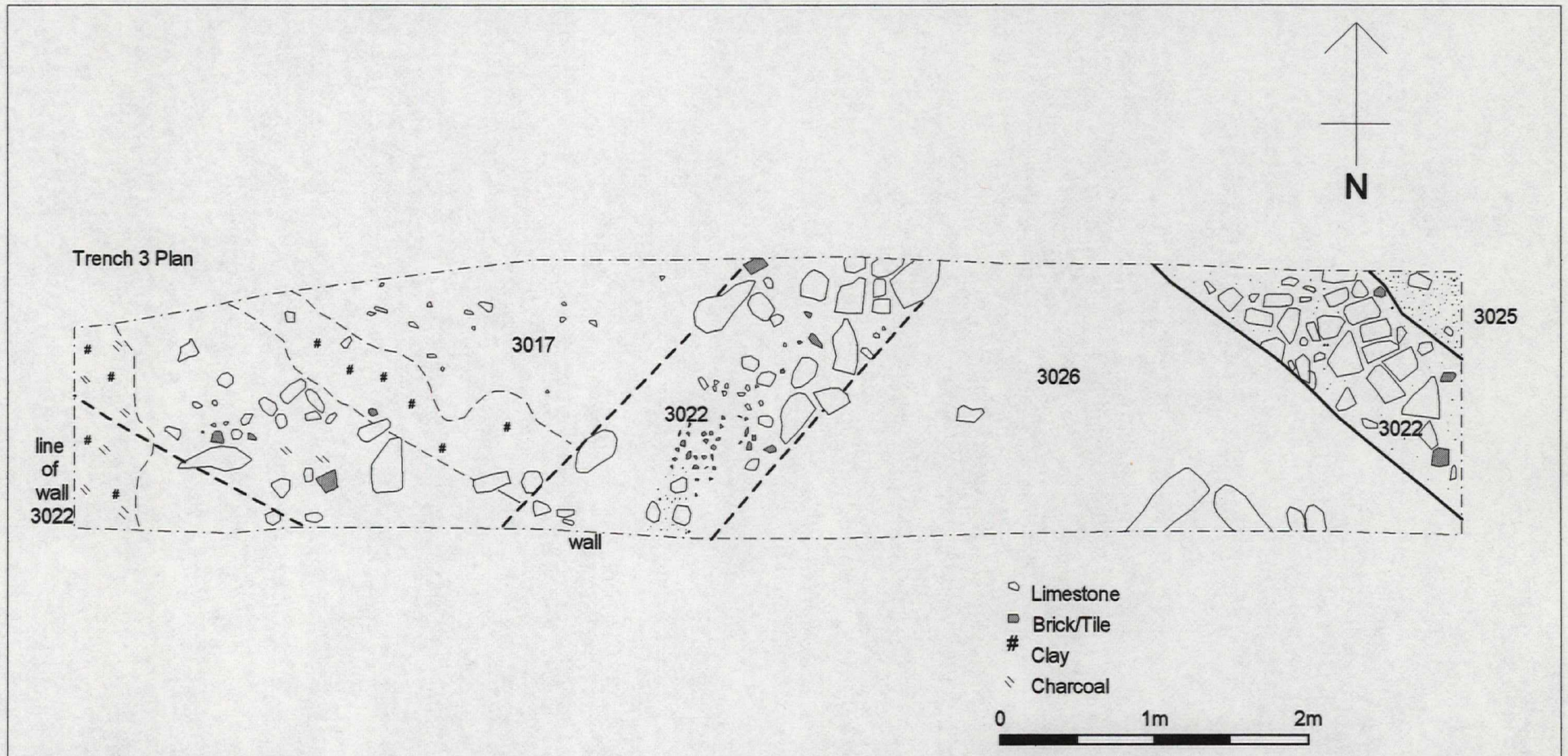


Figure 15. Trench 3 Plan.

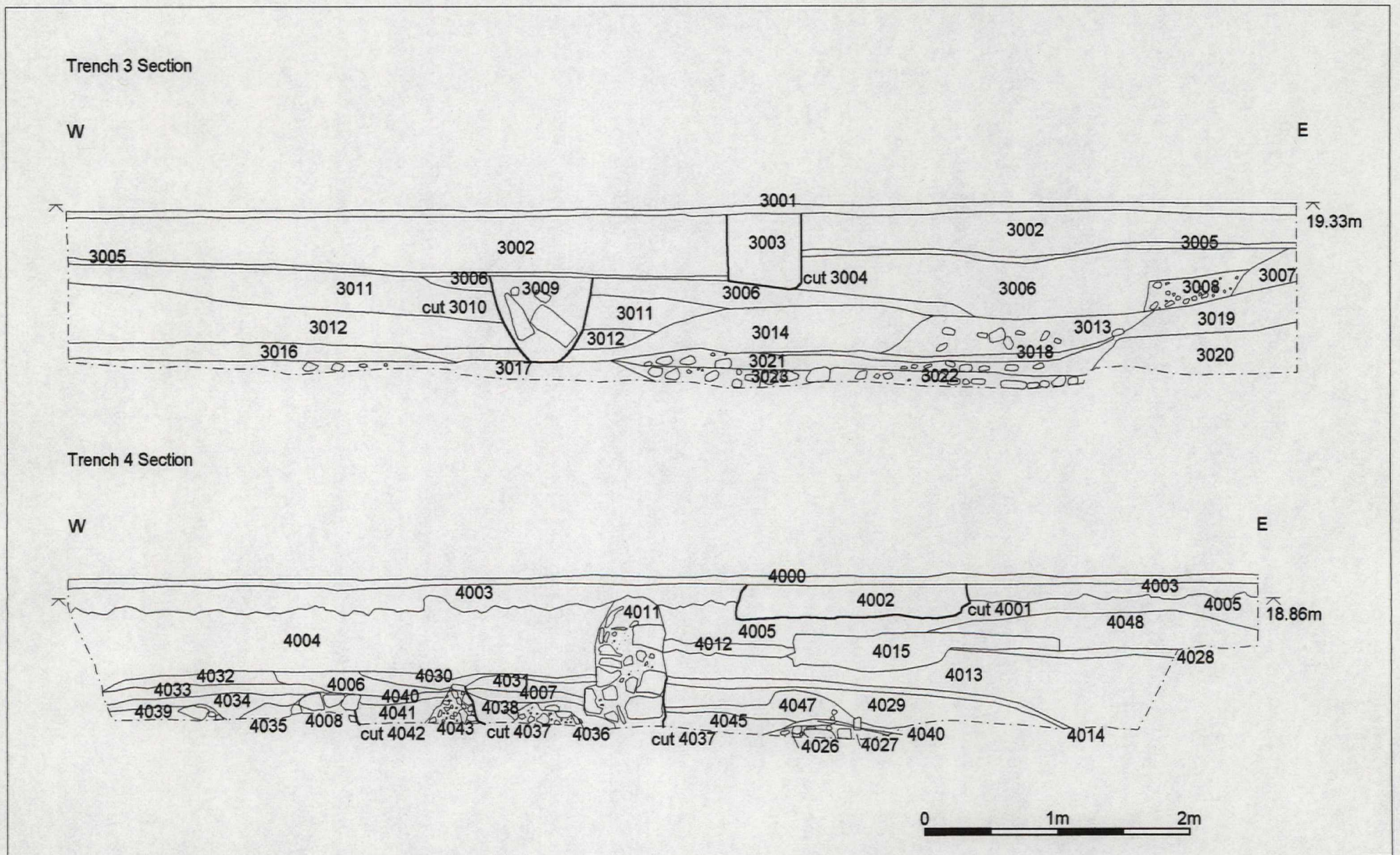


Figure 16. Trenches 3 and 4 Sections.

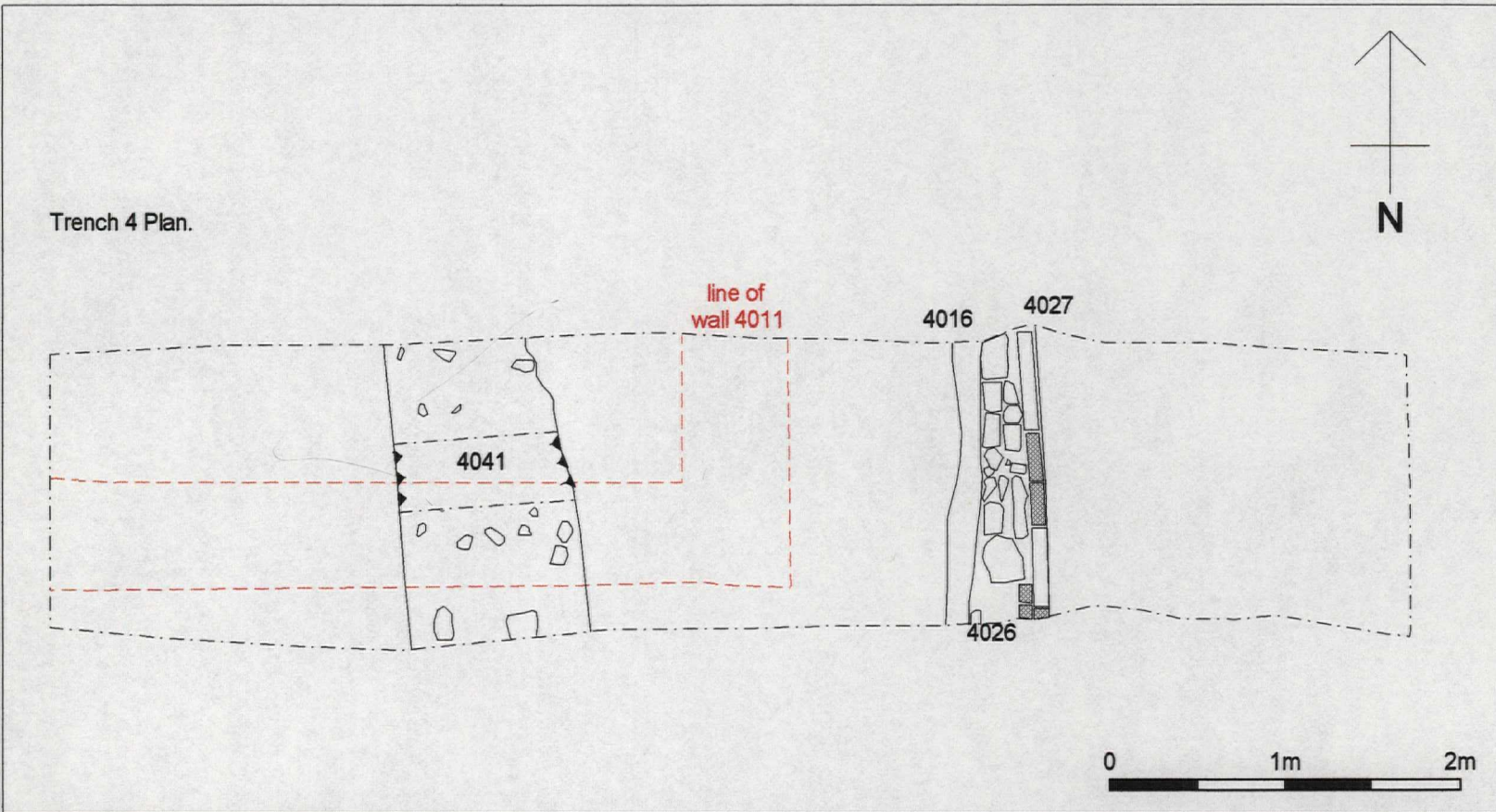


Figure 17. Trench 4 Plan.

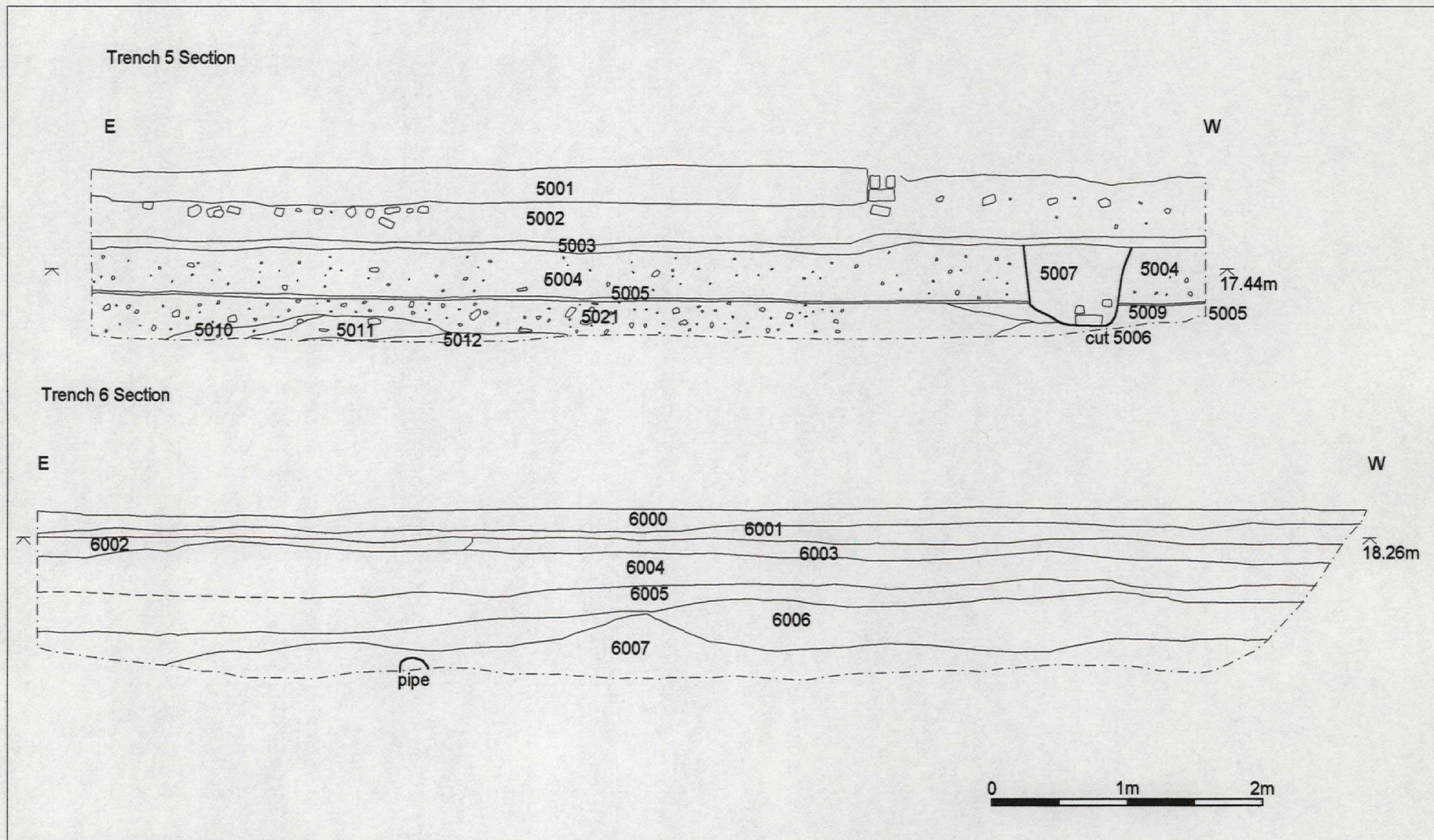


Figure 18. Trenches 5 and 6 Sections.

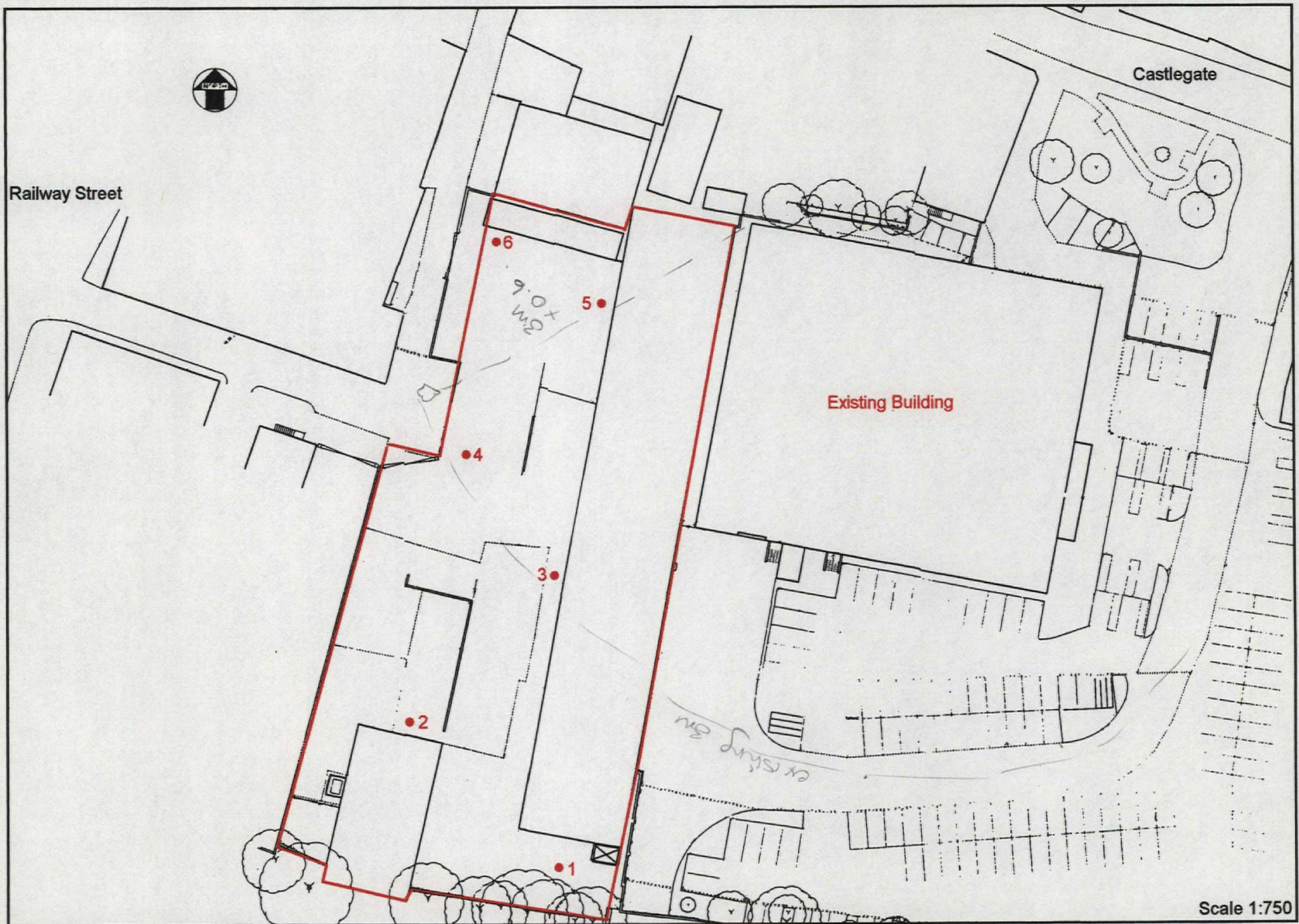


Figure 20. Location of Boreholes.

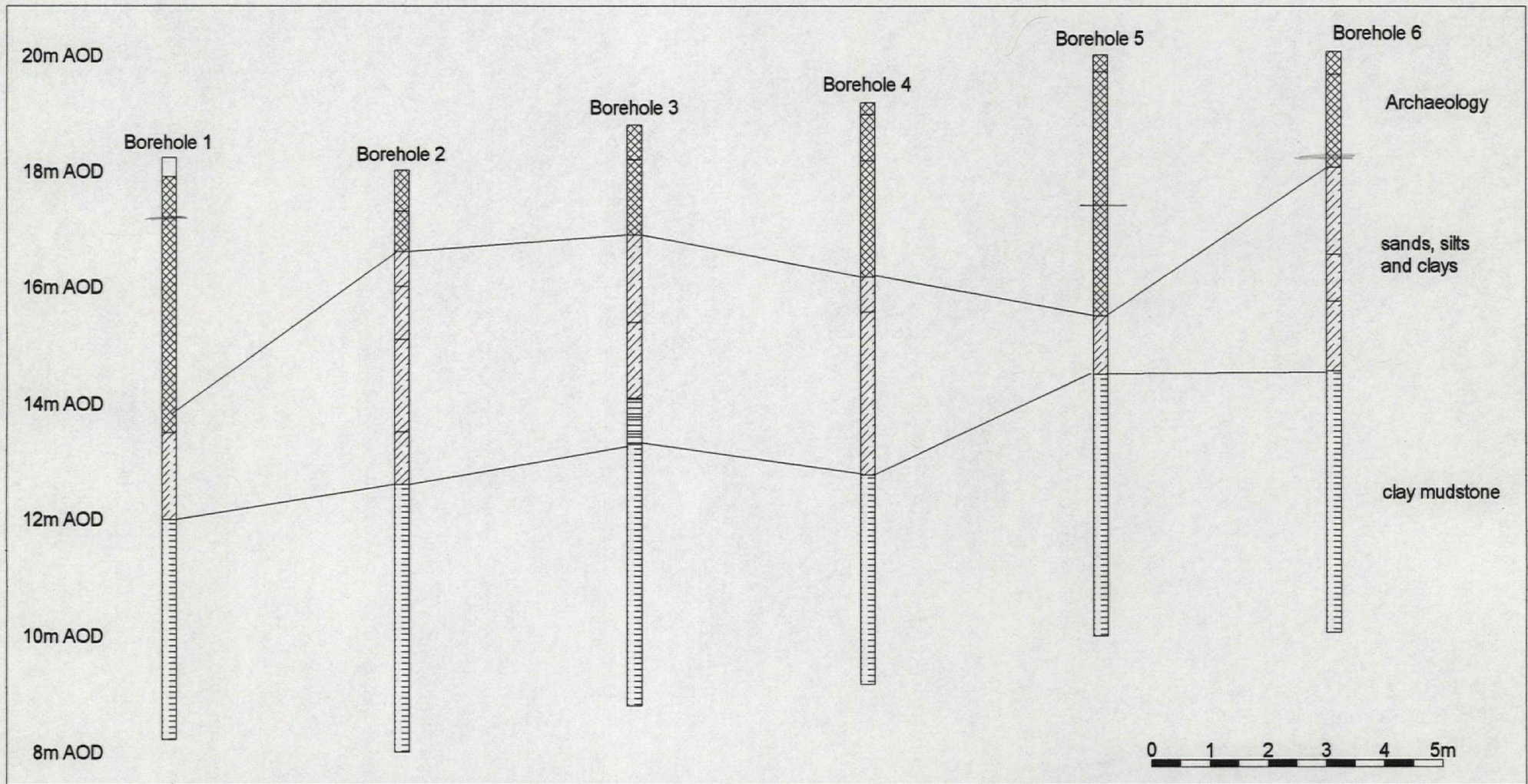


Figure 21. Bore Hole Soil Descriptions (after Hymas).
