




**Fig. 2:** Willows A Trench locations superimposed over geophysical survey results. 1:2,500.




**Fig. 3:** Plan and sections from Trench 1. These are both natural features.  
Plan at 1:100, section at 1:20




**Fig. 4:** Plan and section from Trench 2. Both of these were natural features.  
Plan at 1:100, sections at 1:20.




**Fig. 5:** Plan and sections from Trench 3. Both features shown are natural.  
Plan at 1:100, sections at 1:20.





**Fig. 6:** Plan and sections from Trench 4. Each of these is a natural feature. Plan at 1:100, sections at 1:20.





**Fig. 7:** Willows B Trench location superimposed over geophysical survey results. 1:2500.

Plan at 1:50, sections at 1:20


