

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#### 1 INTRODUCTION

Under the terms of the call off contract Kirkdale Archaeology were asked to monitor the removal of a diseased laburnum tree and excavation of a small hole to take a replacement at Dryburgh Abbey. The affected tree was situated just to the W of the Abbey Church, on the W side of a path around this side of the site. The tree was directly against the N boundary wall of the site, some 3 m W of where the path and wall meet at the NW corner of the Church. The replacement holes NE corner was 2.4 m W and 2.4 m S of this same junction.

#### 2 EXCAVATIONS

The new hole was excavated manually by the Historic Scotland gardeners, and measured some 700 mm N-S by 650 mm E-W. Topsoil **F001** was 100 mm thickness of dark brown clayey silt, below which 350 mm of **F002** was excavated without bottoming it. This was reddish brown clayey silt rich in sandstone fragments and containing some concrete fragments throughout its depth. One piece of slag and 4 probable animal bones from **F002** were photographed and reburied. C 100 mm extra of the base of the wall.

The existing tree was removed in a larger, more irregular hole. It measured 1.7 m E- W by 1.4 m N- S and reached a maximum depth of 300 mm. The entire area was too full of roots to reveal more than c 100 mm extra of the base of the wall.

#### 3 CONCLUSIONS

In spite of the proximity of the Abbey Church, and the post-reformation graveyard just to its N, the results of this exercise were not revealing. The concrete noted in **F002** indicates recent disturbance of this area. The small size of the excavation inhibits understanding of the extent or purpose behind this.
