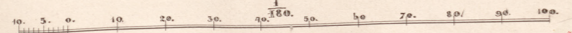

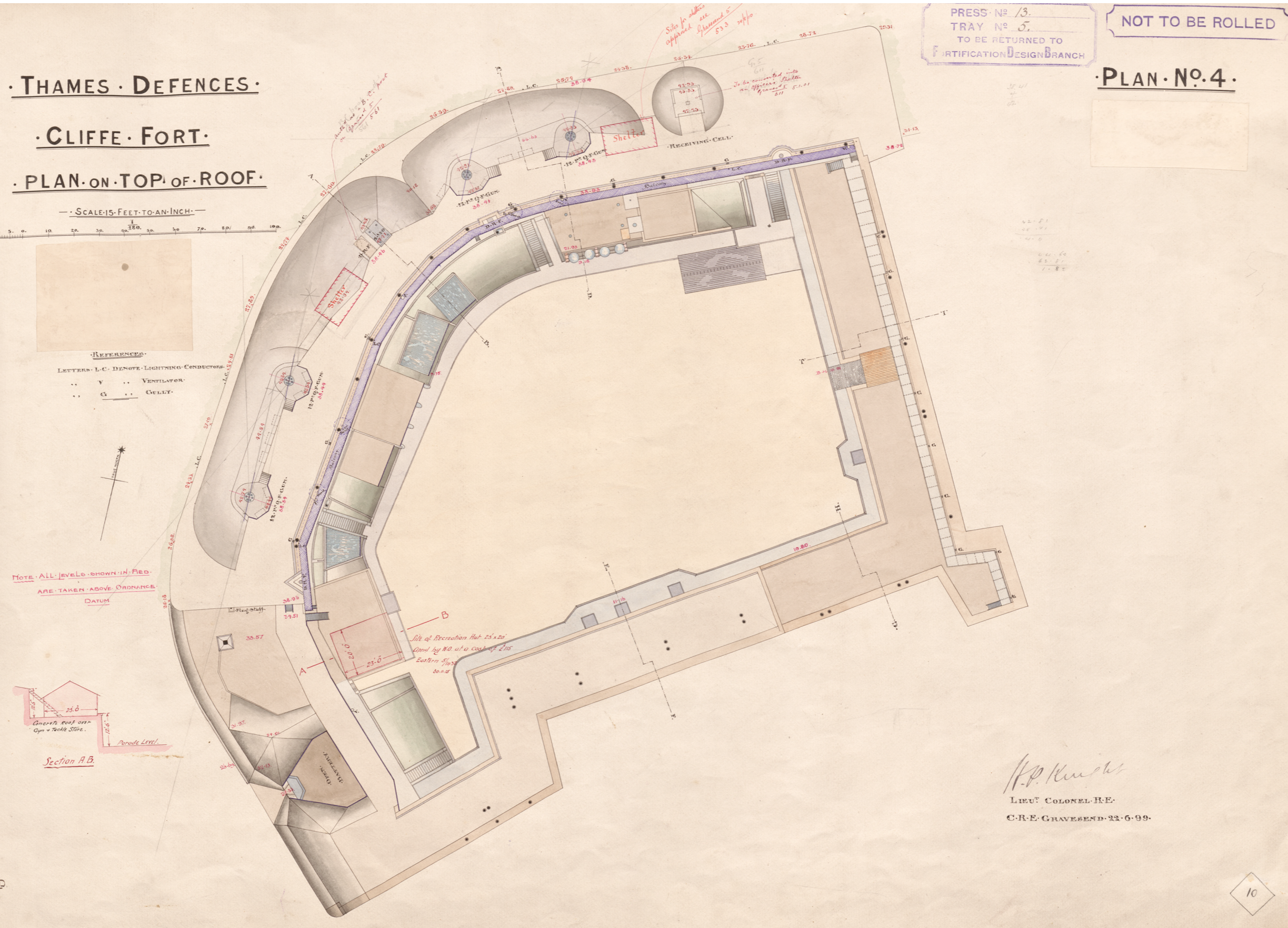
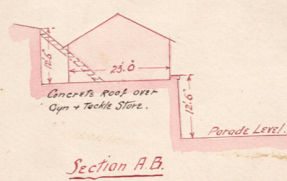

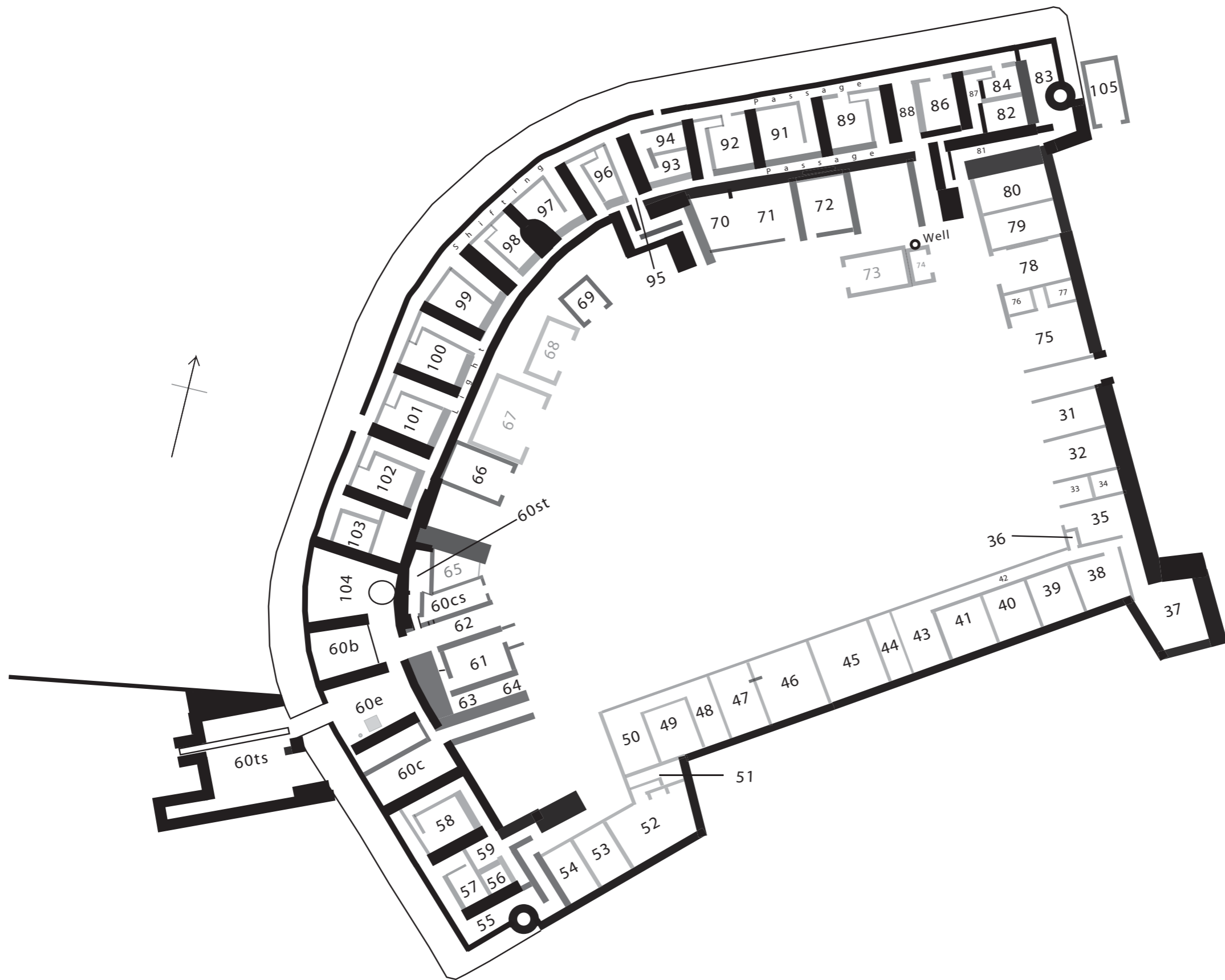

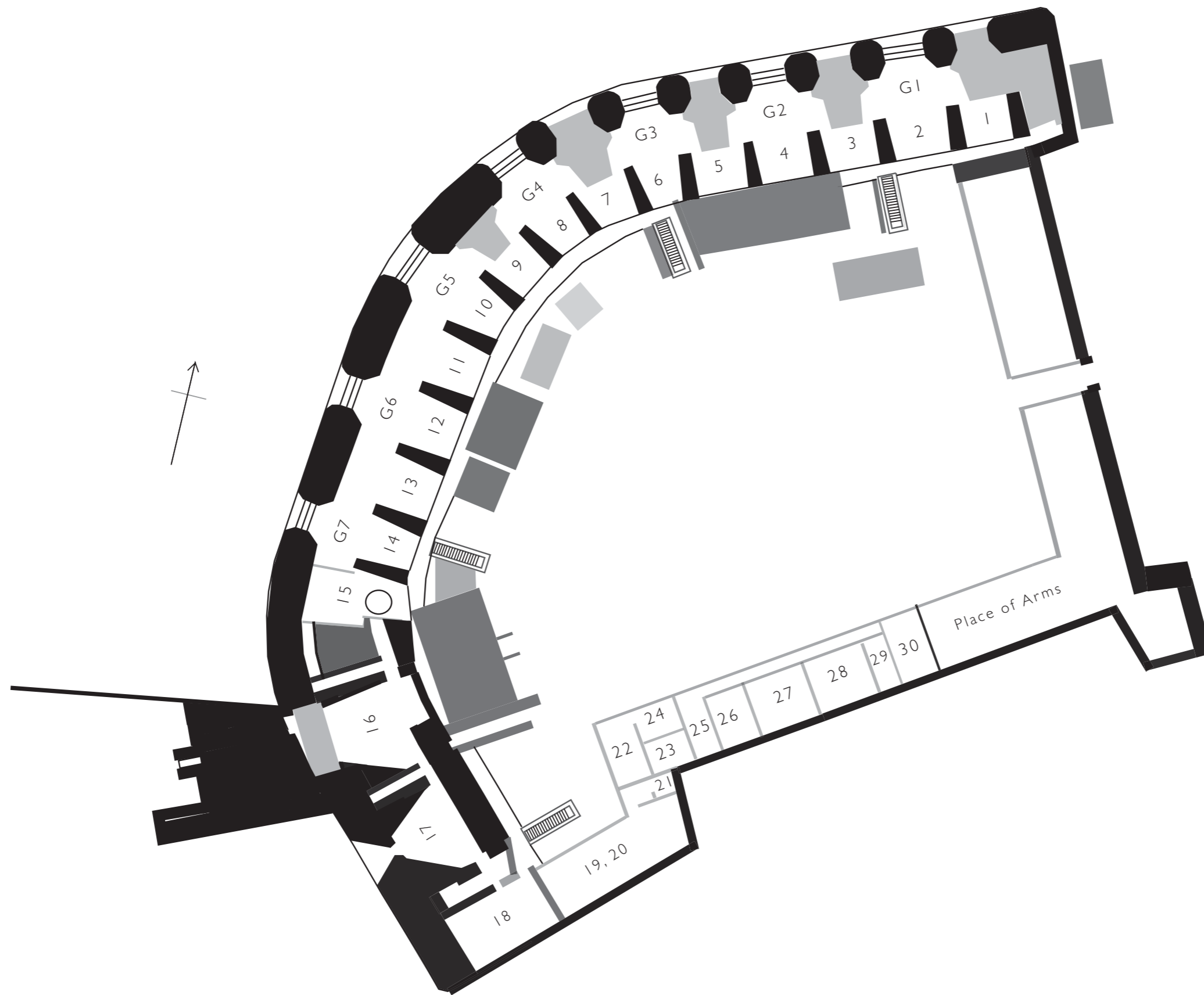

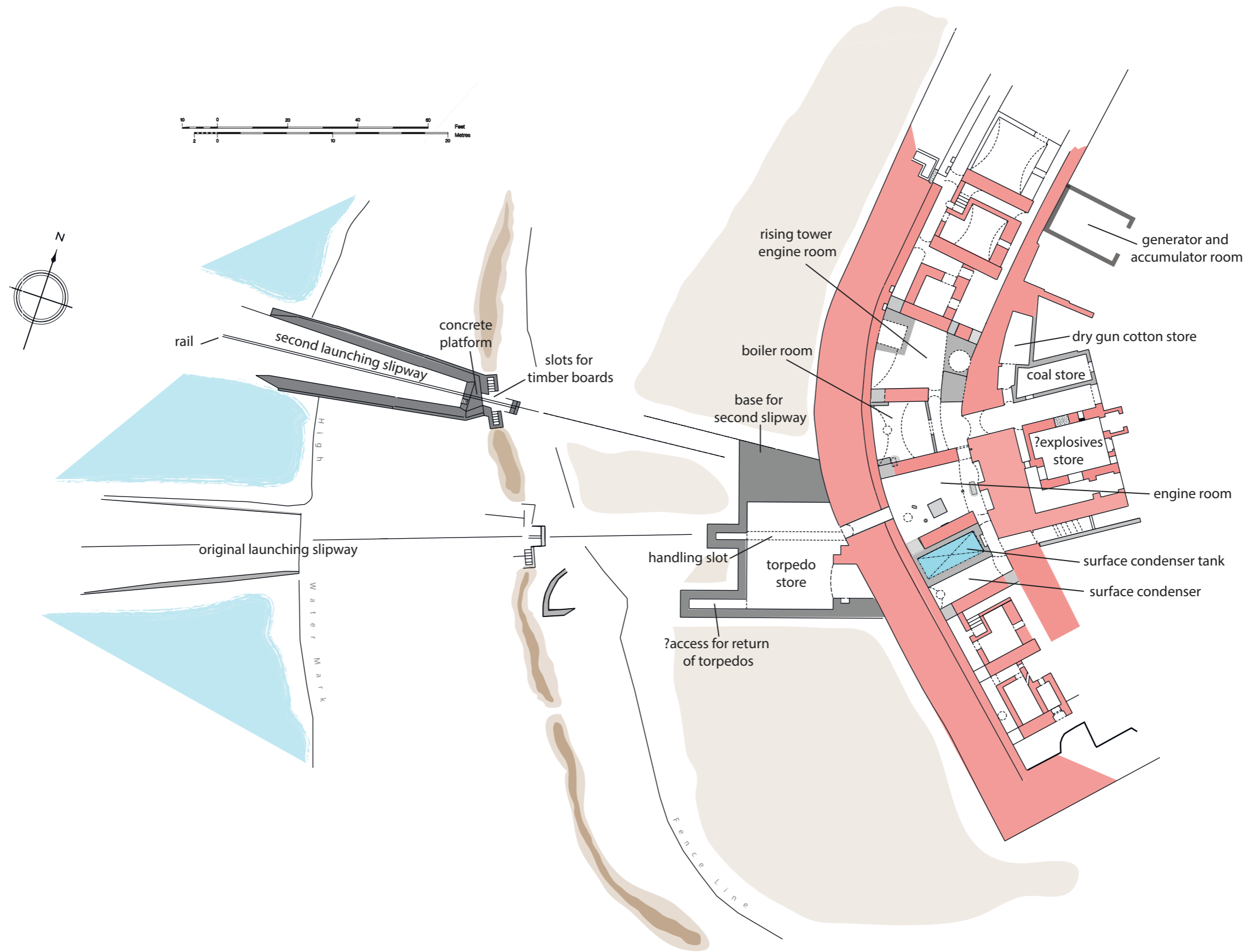
Appendix Figure 3: Thames Defences: Cliffe Fort: Plan on Top of Roof 1899 ©The National Archives: WO78/4963



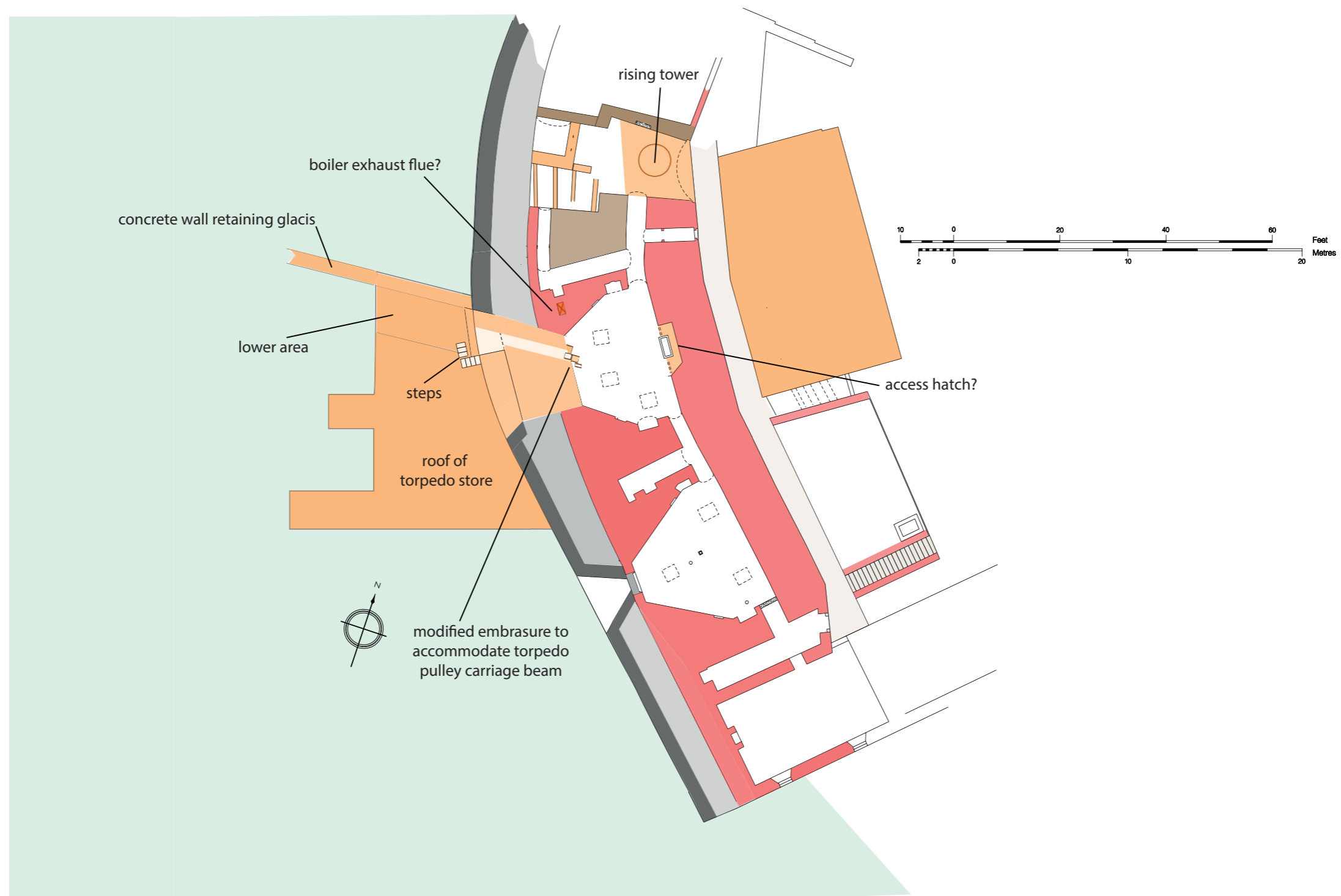

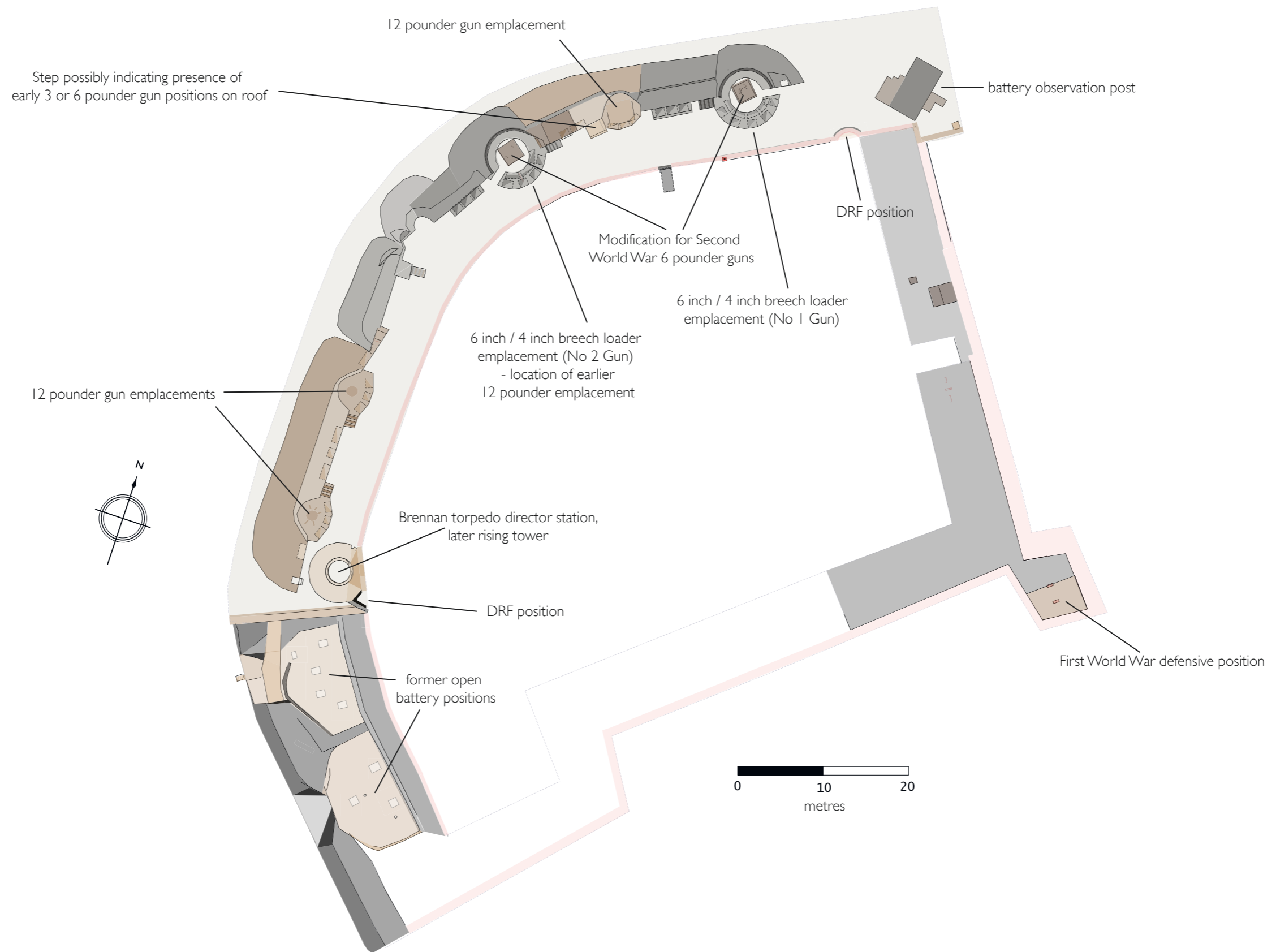
