Recording of South Refectory Wall

Birmingham University Field Archaeology Unit was commissioned, by the Historic Buildings and Monuments Commission, to record the north and south faces of the southern refectory wall of Halesowen Abbey.

Recording was carried out in December 1988 and January 1989. The methods employed were rectified photography and stone for stone recording, the latter being employed where rectified photography proved unfeasible. The wall was recorded at a scale of 1:20.

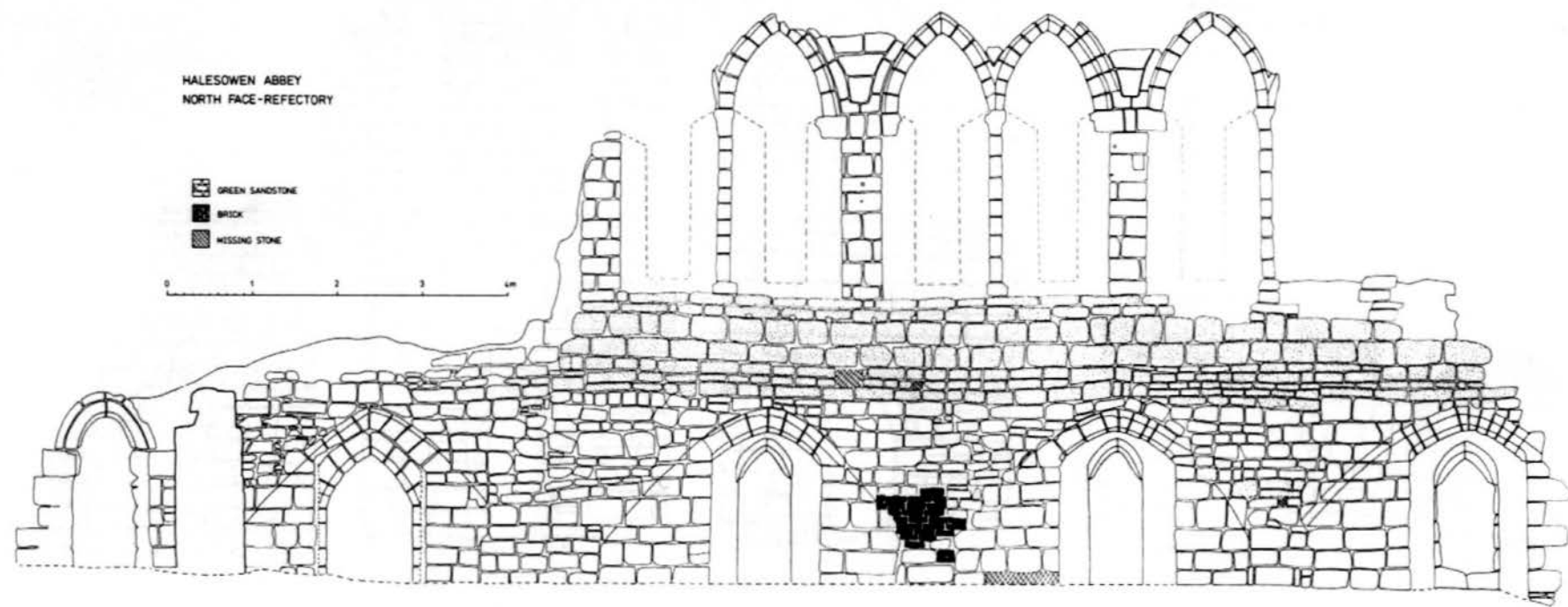

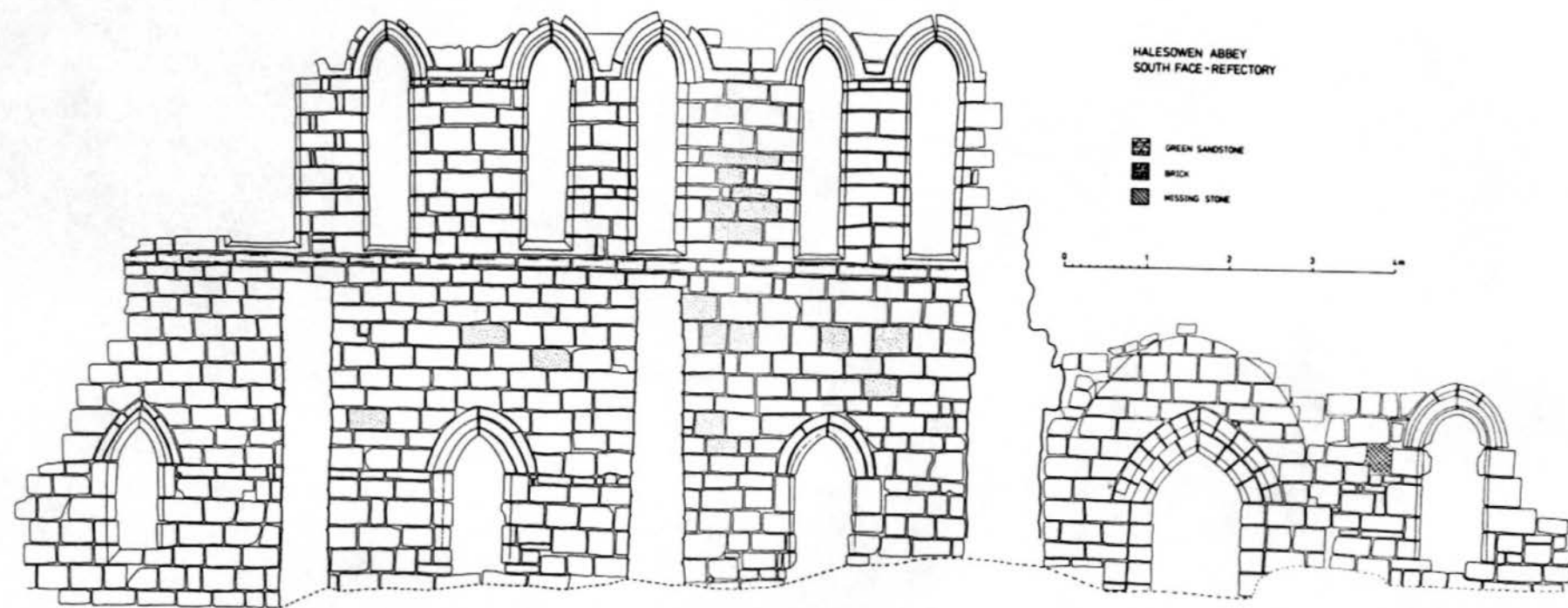
