# 27 BARTHOLOMEW STREET

Card: Reputed to have formed part of gatehouse to St Nicholas Priory; apparently only early C19 industrial building.

### HEATH BARTON, BEACON LANE

Card: 2-storey L-shaped building, cob walls, thatch roof; heavily modernised. Ovolo mullions survive in windows overlooking the road.

Card: Only the guest hall of St Katherine's Priory still remains - 1st-floor hall, solar, garderobe, service end. Converted to Tudor farmhouse; roof replaced but evidence for spere truss & base cruck. Rich in C13 and late C16 - early C17 detail

### ST ANNE'S ALMSHOUSES, BLACKBOY ROAD

Card: part of original range apparently surviving.

# ST MARTIN'S CHURCH, CATHEDRAL CLOSE

Card: C15, chancel arch possibly earlier, ceiled wagon roof; C17 monuments, some from St John's, Fore St; late C17 reredos & altar rails

#### 2 CATHEDRAL CLOSE

Card: 3 storeys, top floor jettied, prob also 1st floor before modern shop was built.

According to Tothill's plan, ground floor had side passage through to small courtyard & garden behind; 2 rooms front & rear on each floor, separated by massive Heavitree stone stack.

Ground-floor rear retains lateral beam on N side with triple ovolo moulding; frontage altered in 1970.

### 3 CATHEDRAL CLOSE

Card: 4 storeys, originally 3 with top floor added when facade remodelled in C19; includes a cellar.

## 4 CATHEDRAL CLOSE

Card: 4 storeys with Heavitree-lined cellar which includes a well. Again original passage through to small courtyard & garden as in 2 & 3; each floor divided into front & rear room by stack. 1st-floor front room includes restored late C16 panelling.
