 Communicated at Alston, July 10th 1884.

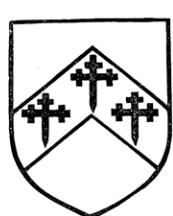
DEAR SIR,

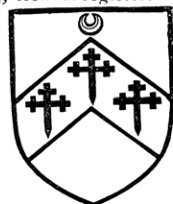

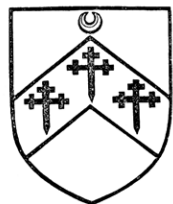
