HE Derby Borough Rental of 1611, set out below, was with a quantity of miscellaneous documents in one of the lofts of our office in S. Michael's

Churchyard. It is written on two strips of parchment, and, from rough notes upon it, was evidently used as a working list by the collectors. The writing has perished in places, particularly in the money column down the margin.

Some of the principal rents are for substantial holdings which still remain the property of the Corporation, but many of the smaller sums are of the nature of acknowledgments for conveniences encroaching on the highways. Pentices, and perhaps porches, would be forerunners of the modern shop blinds. Bulks comprise, I suppose, any projecting building. Outside stairs are still to be seen on Cockpit Hill. One of the last of the street corner posts from the top of Full Street disappeared only a few years ago on the coming of the tram lines, which brought with them the much graver encroachments of their own standards.
