Che Registers of the Parish of Kedleston, Derbyshire, 1600=1812.

SANCTION for the transcript of these Registers has been kindly given by the Right Hon. Earl Curzon, of Kedleston, K.G., Patron of the Living, and the Rev. G. Furness Smith, Rector of Kedleston.

Volume I (1600 to 1741) is on parchment and consists of 23 leaves, size II inches by 6 inches stitched. It was bound by the late Lord Scarsdale, Rector of Kedleston for over 60 years, in a thick handsome case of white vellum, with gold border lines and lettered in gold "Kedleston Register 1507 to 1741." The first page is blank, on the second are written some entries of the Curzon family, 1597-8 and 9, and the Dale family 1586 to 1598. The writing is very faint and must have been taken from some earlier register now non-existent. On the first nine and half pages the ink is very much discoloured. The register is in Latin down to March 3rd, 1602 and in English afterwards except for a few entries in mixed English and Latin. The register is interesting, containing as it does many entries of members of the Curzon family. There is also an extract from the will of Edward Baskervill, 1715, underneath the record of his burial, an unusual occurrence in a parish register, but doubtless introduced here because it recorded the foundation of a local charity which is still administered for the benefit of the parish. Near the end of the volume is a copy of the "Protest against Popish Innovations," which was drawn up by the House of Commons in 1641 and circulated for signature. The Kedleston copy is signed by the minister. two members of the Curzon family, and 33 other members of the congregation, having been read out in church on July 4th, 1641. Such entries in parish registers are very rare and of great value, as giving a complete list of all males of 18 years and upwards in each parish on a given date. As there is no note of any "Recusants" or dissentients, as is sometimes the case, it is assumed that every male in the parish above the age of 18 is recorded. So far only two other parishes have been found in Derbyshire to give this record, viz.: South Wingfield and Pentrich. The register is well kept, the writing for the most part of it is good, neat and very small, but in some places it is discoloured and faint, making the writing difficult to decipher. The entries are mixed down to the year 1700, but a column by the side denotes whether "Bap.", "Nup.", or "Bur." Afterwards the entries are kept separate for each year and headed accordingly.

Volume II (1741 to 1812) is on parchment, with the exception of the first two pages, and consists of 25 leaves, of which $6\frac{1}{2}$ are not used, size $13\frac{3}{4}$ inches by 8 inches, and is bound in a stiff parchment cover. The entries are kept separate year by year until 1754, when only Baptisms and Burials are entered, the Marriages being found by themselves in the next volume. This register is interesting from the number of strangers from other parishes that are found in it; also persons employed at the Hall including some of the carvers at work during its erection. There is a remarkable number of private baptisms and of those "received into the Church." The register is in English and badly kept near the end, and in places very scrawled.

Volume III (1755 to 1812) is the usual printed Marriage Register on paper, four entries on each page, and is only partly used, there being only 41 entries. It is bound in a brown paper cover.

Every care has been exercised in the transcription of the copy and the transcriber has been helped by Mr. E. E. Taylor, the late Sir Henry Bemrose's librarian, and Mr. Ernest B. Smith of Derby.

The Registers have been copied as nearly verbatim as is possible, but in order to save repetition, such phrases as "was baptised," "were married," and "was buried," are simply entered "bap.", "mar.", and "bur." The names of the months have been shortened and the following abbreviations have been adopted:-

b.—bachelor.

s.—the son.

d.—the daughter. sp.—spinster.

co.—county of. p.—parish of.

w.—widow or widower. lic.—marriage licence.

Blank spaces shown —— denote that the entry is deficient in the register, whilst that which cannot be read is marked (illeg.) illegible. Names which are doubtful are marked with a query (?).

power & as lawfully as I may, I will oppose & by All good wayes & meanes, indeauour to bring to condigne punishment, all such as shall either by force, Practise Counsels, Plotts, Conspiracyes or otherwyse, doe anythyng to the contrary of any thyng in this psent ptestacon contayned; And further that I shall in all iust & honorable wayes indeauour to pserve the Union & peace betweene the 3 kingdoms of England, Scotland & Irland, & neither for hope, feare, nor other respect shall relinquish this pmise vowe & ptestation.
