

Derbyshire Clergy.

Additions to the REV. J. C. COX's lists:
 compiled by W. E. GODFREY.

THE names in the following list are extracted mainly from Jeayes', *Derbyshire Charters*, and are those of incumbents not given by Dr. Cox in the main lists in his *Derbyshire Churches*, or of whom the information is incomplete or incorrect. In many instances Cox and Jeayes are found to tally, as would only be expected, and no account is taken of these. The dates given in the present list are the dates of the charters, either definite or approximate, and indicate the period when the clergyman was alive, and not the year of his induction or death.

The names selected are those which Jeayes qualifies by the descriptions rector, parson, vicar, and those of chaplains where it is clear to what particular church they are attached. Names followed by *clie*, *cleric*, *clericus*, have been omitted, for while some of them may have been clerks in holy orders, others would be chantry priests, chaplains to manorial lords, and some clerks in the sense of accountants. Incumbents of neighbouring counties, of which there are many, have been omitted as outside the scope of this journal.

A complete revision of Dr. Cox's lists is desirable for they contain many errors of transcription. He obtained most of his material from the muniments at Lichfield Cathedral, and this is what is said of him in the Historical Manuscripts Commission, 14th Report, app. pt. viii, 205, where the Lichfield muniments are described; "I am,

however, bound to point out that errors of transcription are extremely frequent . . . Thus in the description of charter B1, out of seven names of witnesses, Dr. Cox makes mistakes in five." In the circumstances it is clear that many errors would be discovered in Dr. Cox's lists if they could be checked with his original sources, and many additional names could be added.
