Derbyshire Clergy List II.

(The first list appeared in *D.A.J.*, n.s., Vol. 6, 1932).

THE object of this further list is the same as previously—to collect the scattered references to Derbyshire incumbents into a whole, where they may be better compared with Cox's main lists in his *Derbyshire Churches* in order to place them in their correct positions.

This, whilst adding a number of new names, cannot in any sense be regarded as a final list. Many more names still lie scattered about in Yeatman's *Feudal History of Derbyshire*, in the same author's *History of Chesterfield*, in some of the appendices in Cox's *Derbyshire Churches* and even in the body of that work. There must also be quite a number yet undetected in *D.A.J.* volumes, which I have scanned rather than digested minutely.

It will be noticed that one or two names have no references. The reason for this is that for years I have jotted down odd names of Derbyshire incumbents as I have come across them in reading, but have occasionally

omitted to note the reference. Sooner or later, however, these will be rediscovered and the names found to be correct. I have endeavoured not to repeat names already given in Cox's main lists or in Derbyshire Clergy, List I, except where it was necessary to fix dates of men undated by Cox.

Attention is drawn to *An Elizabethan Clergy List*, by Cox, in *D.A.J.*, Vol. VI, and to *A Guide to Tideswell*, by the Rev. J. M. J. Fletcher (for Tideswell).
