The following is a summary of work undertaken in 1951 on collections connected with Derbyshire:—

TRUSLEY HALL. Deeds and papers of the Ballidon family of Derby, Stapenhill and Stanley. 16th-18th centuries.

Deeds and papers of the Wilmot family of Chaddesden. 16th-18th centuries.

ALTON MANOR, IDERIDGEHAY. Deeds of the Walthall family, 16th-20th centuries. Mainly relating to Kirk Ireton and Darley Dale.

RADBOURNE HALL. Miscellaneous papers of the Pole family. Mainly 17th-19th centuries.

Brookhill Hall. Deeds and papers of the Coke family of Brookhill, par. Pinxton, including deeds from Suckley, co. Worcs., and Little Hereford, co. Salop. 12th-20th centuries. Some official and personal correspondence of Sir William Coke, Puisne Justice of Ceylon, 1808-19.

Snelston Hall. Deeds and papers of the Harrison, Evans and Stanton families of Snelston, with some medieval deeds of co. Lancs., and others of later date relating to lands in co. Staffs., Birmingham and elsewhere. 12th-20th centuries. In progress.

Alfreion Park. Deeds and papers of the Palmer-Morewood family of Alfreion and co. Warwick. In progress.

Barnes Papers. 18th-19th century ledgers, accounts and papers of John Brocksopp, ironmaster of Grasshill. Papers of the Wragg family of Stretton, 17th-18th centuries. Deposited by Lt.-Col. T. H. Barnes of Ashgate House in Chesterfield Public Library. In progress.

NORTON. Deeds relating to Wormhill and Norton belonging to Mrs. Bagshawe of the Oakes Norton. In progress.

GLAPWELL DEEDS. A collection of 460 deeds mainly relating to the Manor of Glapwell, including a considerable number of medieval deeds concerning Beauchief and Darley Abbeys belonging to the Derbyshire County Library. In progress.
