THE EXCAVATION OF THE SNELS LOW AND LEAN LOW ROUND CAIRNS

- Snels Low: west quadrant trench, showing cairn on left and stone capping in section. Scale, in feet, stands on limestone bedrock
- 2 Snels Low: central cairn, removed in foreground by robber trench which penetrated to the primary burial which lay under the clay, right centre. Scale in feet.
- 3 Snels Low: remains of crouched primary burial. Upper part disturbed; molar tooth between leg bones. Scale in inches.
- 4 Lean Low: western burial.
