



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

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
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


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THE FENLAND PROJECT No. 3, NORFOLK: MARSHLAND AND THE NAR VALLEY

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GAZETTEER: EXPLANATORY NOTES

The gazetteer offers, in abbreviated form, information on the sites found during the survey and those chance finds and earlier discoveries considered relevant to the report. Fuller details can be found in the Sites and Monuments Record for Norfolk. Although the headings in the gazetteer are largely self-explanatory, these notes are intended to clarify the more ambiguous entries and also demonstrate the limitations of the record.

No. The ordinary numbers - those without the U or A prefix - are those given to sites at the time of their discovery. The finds are marked with these numbers and are stored by the Norfolk Museums Service according to these parish numbers. In the gazetteer the complete sequence of numbers is not always present; this is usually because an assessment of the finds after processing has down-graded the site or attributed it to a period not relevant to the present survey.

'U' numbers cover sites where for one reason or another the evidence of previous work could not be verified during the present programme of fieldwork. Included within this category is excavated evidence, sites now destroyed for which confirmation is supplied by earlier reports of a reliable standard, aerial photographs etc. U numbers have also been given to sites where the date is uncertain and may not be relevant to this report (e.g. post-medieval), and where interesting material was recovered but not in sufficient quantity to classify as a site.

'A' numbers include individual artefacts, coin hoards, chance finds and other features such as burials.

All the categories include data known prior to the survey.

Grid Reference All references are to grid square TF.

Date Where a worked flint or burnt flint site cannot be attributed to a

specific period it has been given a 'prehistoric' label. It has been assumed that all 'pot-boiler' sites are prehistoric unless there is contradictory dating evidence.

Nature All entries are included in the list of standard abbreviations and are self-explanatory.

Soil Although many of the Marshland sites are on roddons whose silt fill may differ from the surrounding soil, the entry refers to the prevalent soil in the locality. On the upland edge the soils are described according to the writer's assessment, and not in terms of the Soil Survey's general categorisation.

Height has been estimated in relation to spot heights on the large-scale Ordnance Survey maps. The heights in the gazetteer should thus be used as a general guide only.

Area Again, this has been estimated from the dimensions of the site and should be taken as a general guide.

Artefacts Where both pottery and flint have been found on a single site in the Nar Valley, the letters 'F' and 'P' have been used. Weights have been calculated to the nearest 10g. More detailed lists of the pottery and worked flint analyses are included in the survey archive housed by the Norfolk Museums Service.

SMR no. etc In addition to the Norfolk Sites and Monuments number, the scheduled number in the county series is included where applicable. The fieldwork code number is one given during the survey, and finds are stored according to this number by the Norfolk Museum Service.
