Introduction to the Gazetteer

Gazetteers have been produced for each parish. Survey was occasionally conducted on small areas of parishes adjacent to the main area of survey. In such cases the largely unsurveyed parishes have a separate parish code and the site is listed within the main parish eg Wigtoft in Gosberton.
