## Introduction to the Gazetteer

Gazetteers have been produced for each parish. Survey was occasionally conducted on small areas of parishes adjacent to the main area of survey. In such cases the largely unsurveyed parishes have a separate parish code and the site is listed within the main parish e.g. Old Leake in Wrangle. Details of each site are listed under a series of columns:

### COL 1 (Parish Code)

Identification code for each site; usual prefix is first three letters of parish e.g. DOG 1 is the first site found in Dogdyke during Fenland Survey. 'U' prefixes denote previously known sites whose presence was unverified by Fenland Survey. 'A' denotes artefacts found during Fenland Survey. UA denotes previously known artefacts.
