Description: Visual and microscopic examination using Meiji stereo microscope 7-75x magnification A strip of gold made from a base layer of gold with wire work edging and bands of decoration on the surface. Bands of herringbone wire work made of seven wires and plain gold with four lines raised from the surface. These appear alternate.

Associated Objects: None noted to date

Pre-Conservation Condition: Visual and microscopic examination using Meiji stereo microscope 7-75x magnification

The object has been bent in the centre causing a slight v shape. One end is bent over at a 90 degree angle. The opposite end appears to have a small loss. There is some wear to the surfaces but some areas are still soil covered.

On the reverse, at the end with the loss there appears to be a wire in the soil, the may be held in place by the soil.

There are some areas of wear and compression at the bend.

The is an area of delamination, visible along the edge, there is also a break in the gold by the delamination.
