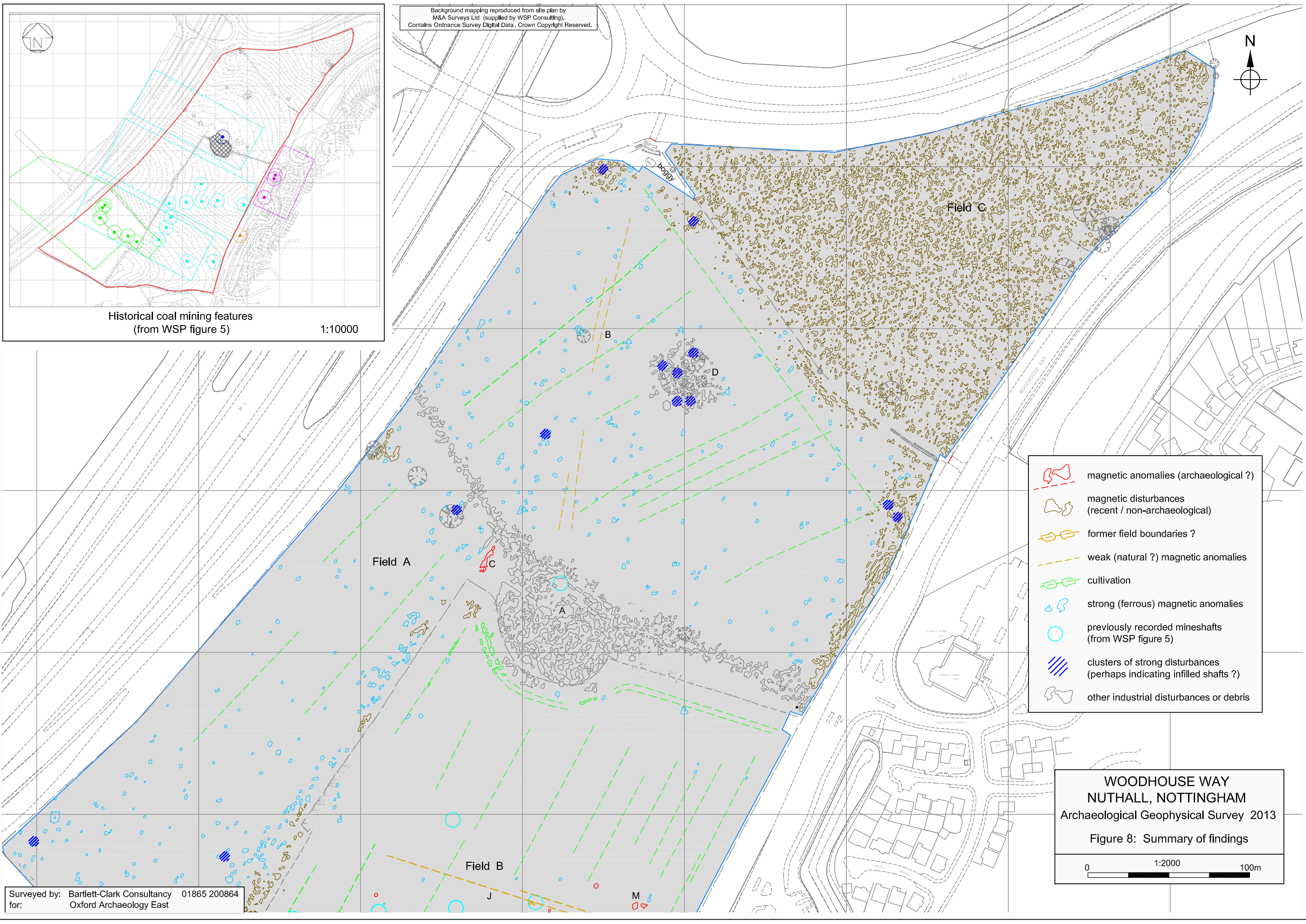











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Historical coal mining features

-  former field boundaries ?
-  weak (natural ?) magnetic anomalies
-  cultivation
-  strong (ferrous) magnetic anomalies
-  previously recorded mineshafts (from WSP figure 5)
-  clusters of strong disturbances (perhaps indicating infilled shafts ?)
-  other industrial disturbances or debris
