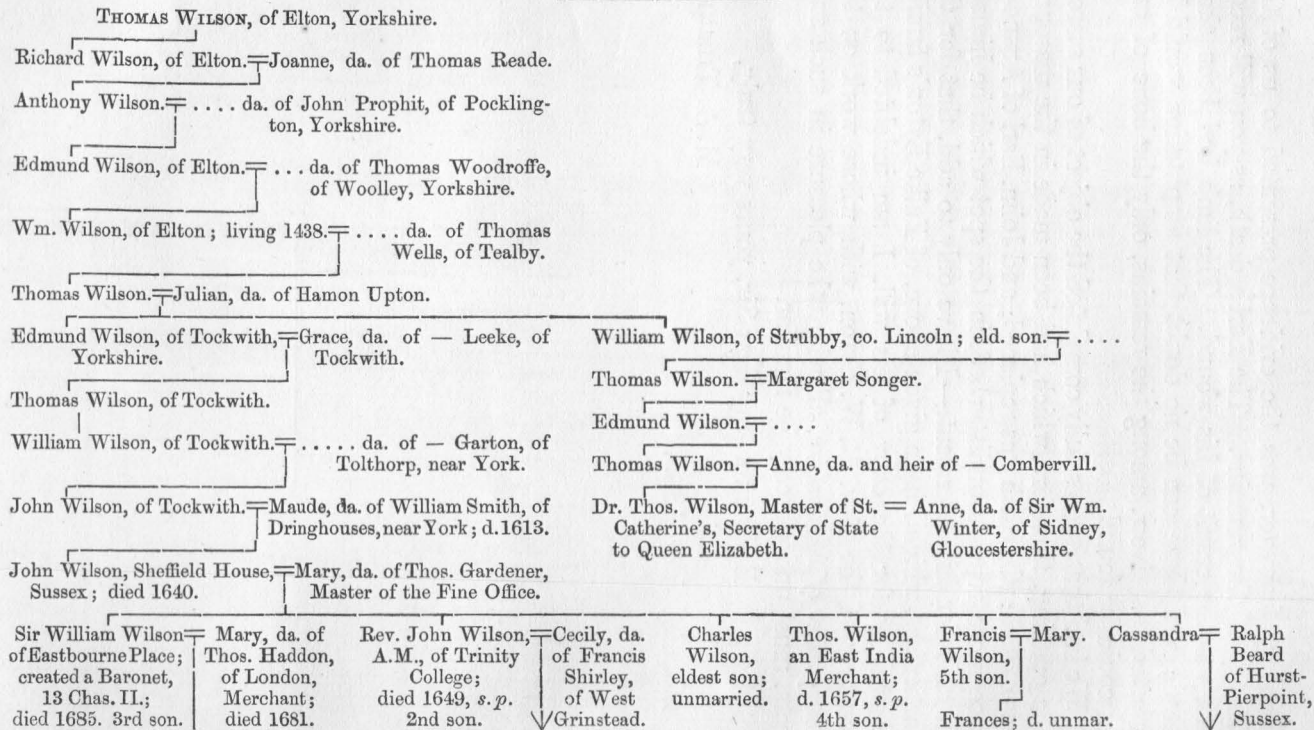


PEDIGREE OF THOMAS WILSON, ESQ.
