

Archivist's Note

XTH12

This project involved the archaeological monitoring of excavations at the Wick Sewer Access Chamber, Ham Sewer Access Chamber and the Pump Chamber located west of Wick Lane. These works are all described in the watching brief report. No finds or samples were recovered.

One piece of additional archaeological monitoring was carried out on Crossrail-related utilities works in Bow Road adjacent to St Mary's Church (TQ 3760 8292). A watching brief was maintained to ensure that no burials associated with the church were present. The monitoring revealed only modern deposits and services. A few fragments of animal bone were recovered but no human remains were observed. The only records for this are a series of digital photographs and a plan showing the location of the works.
