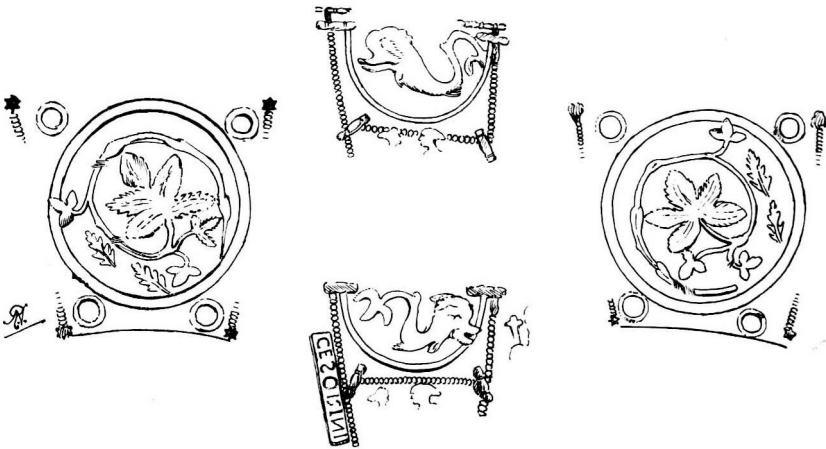

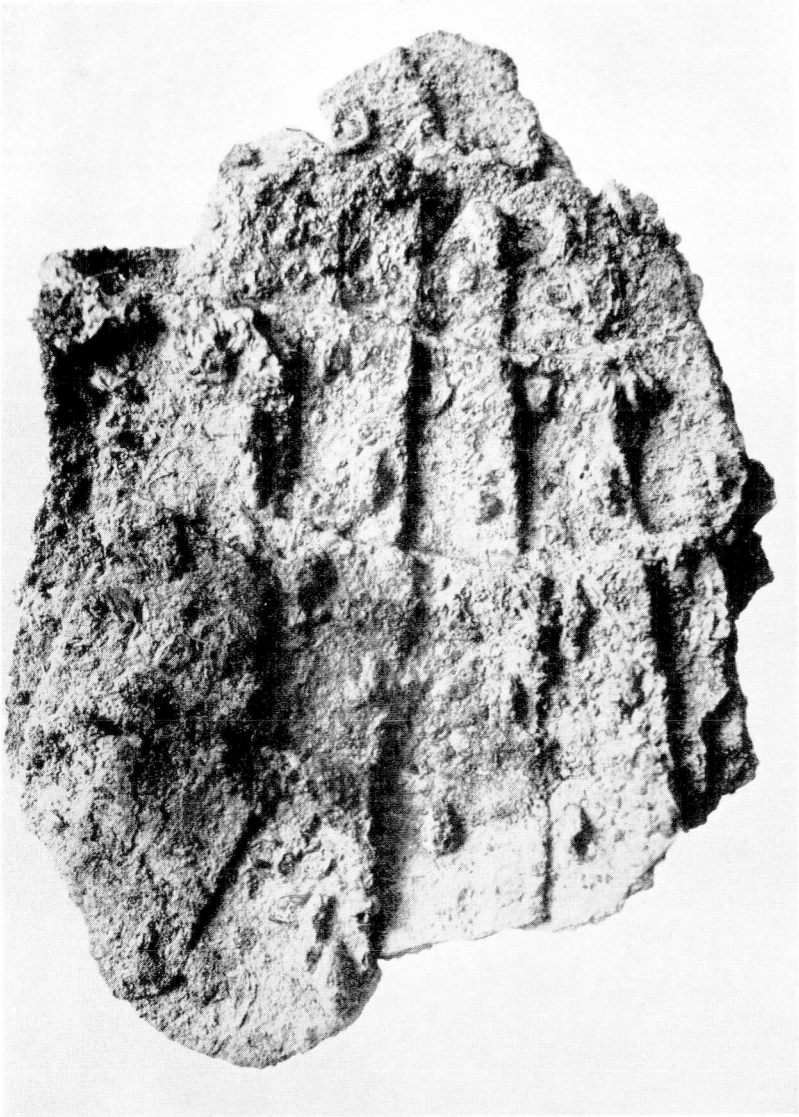

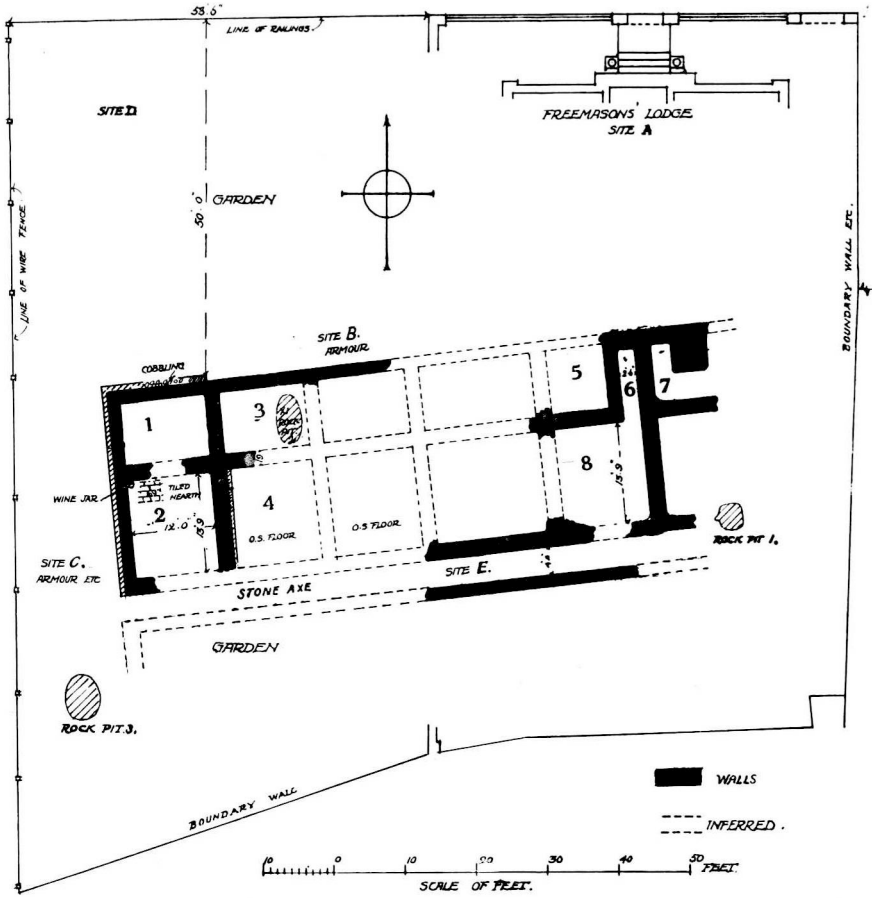

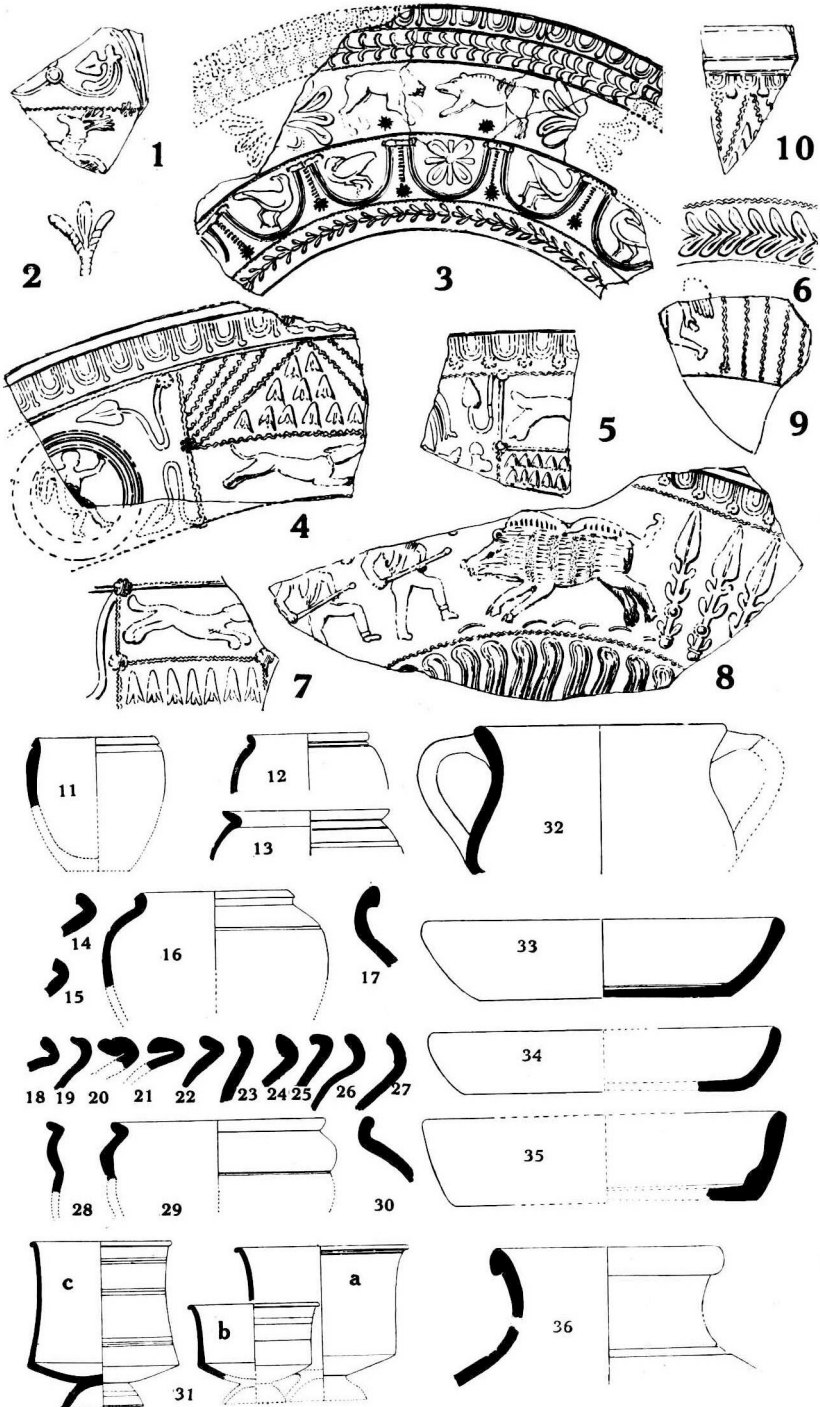

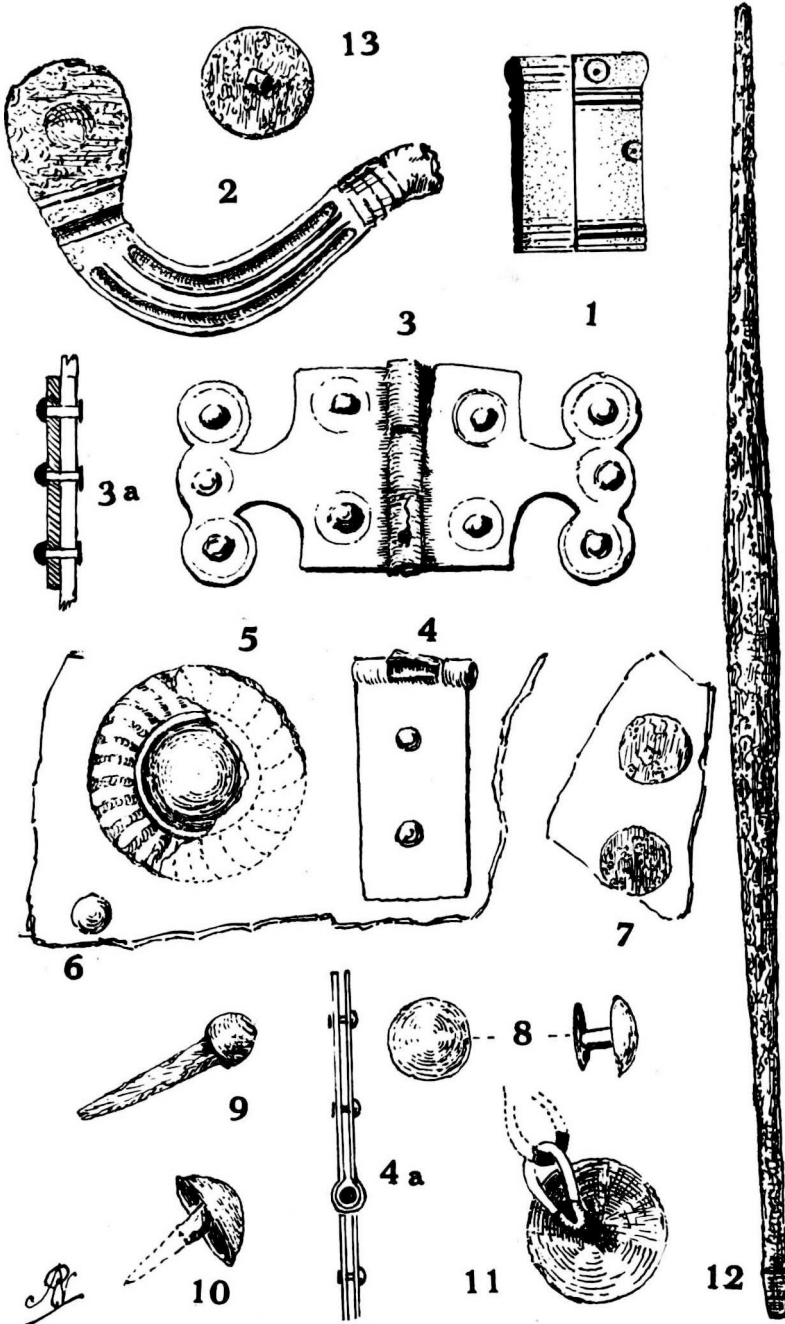

Plan of Roman buildings.

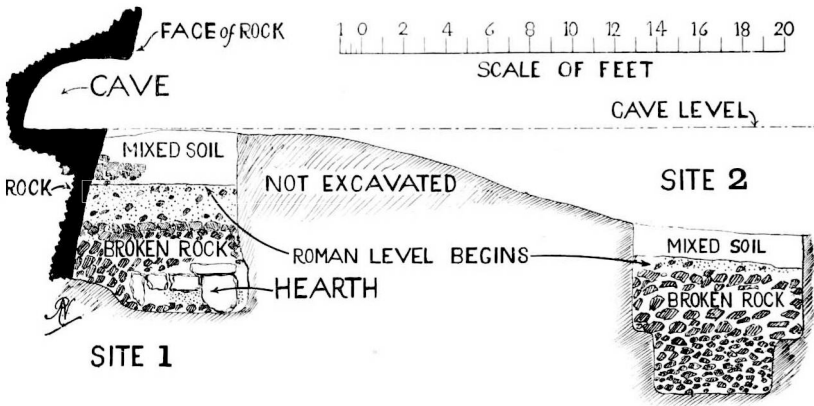

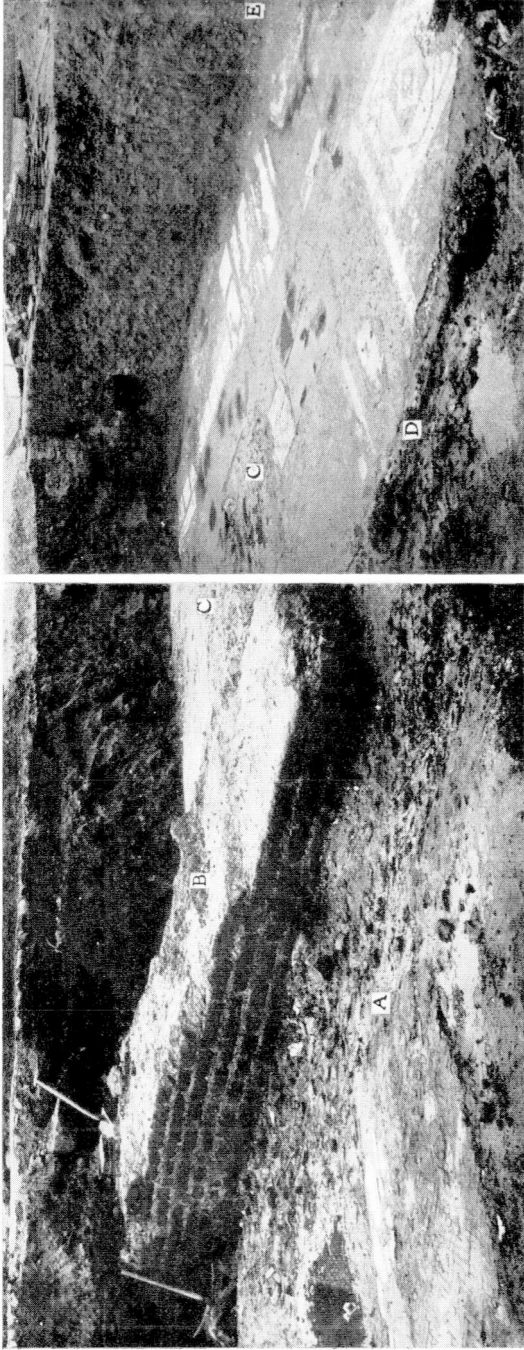

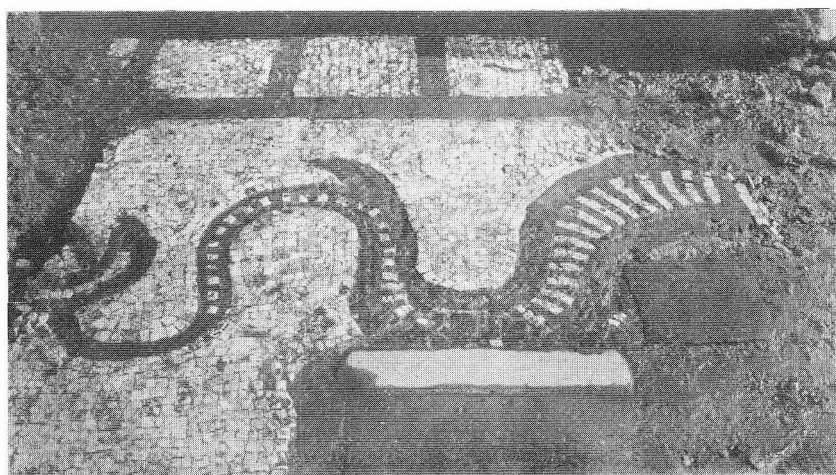

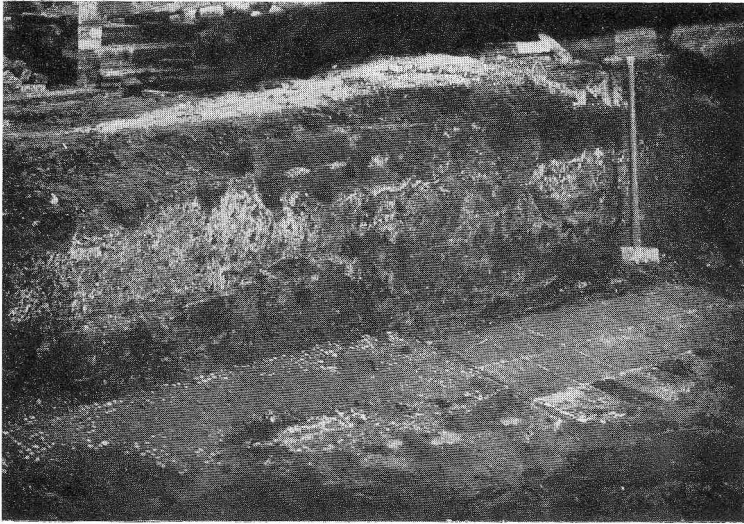

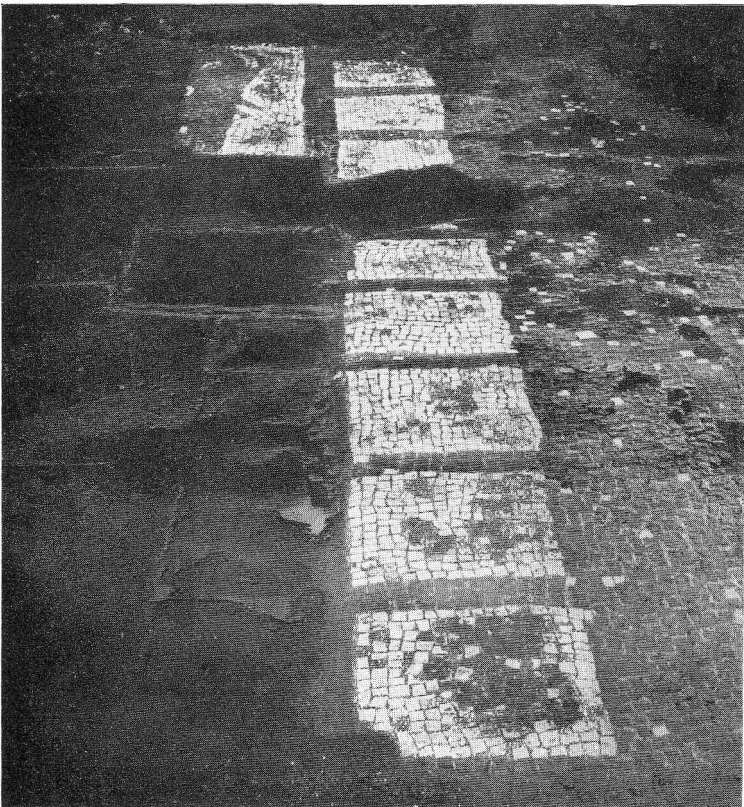

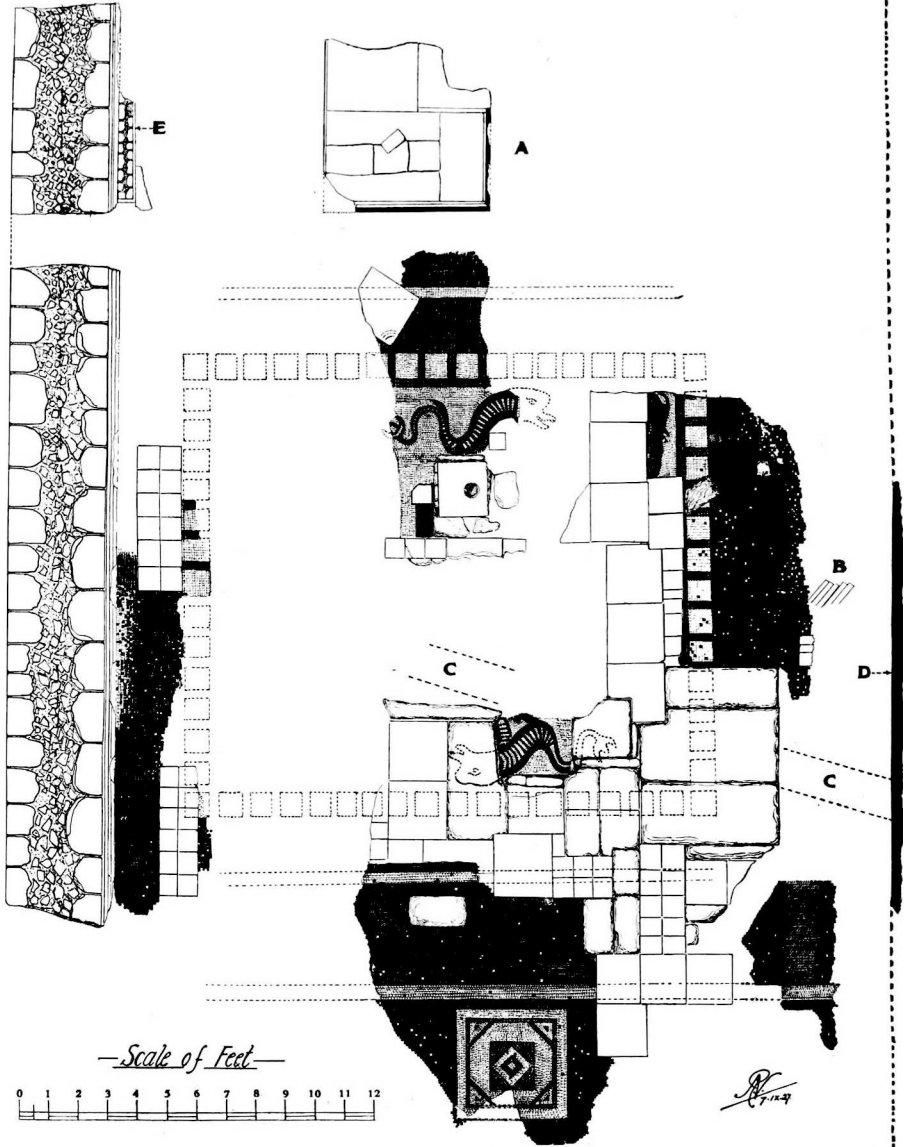

Plan of mosaic floor discovered 1909-10.

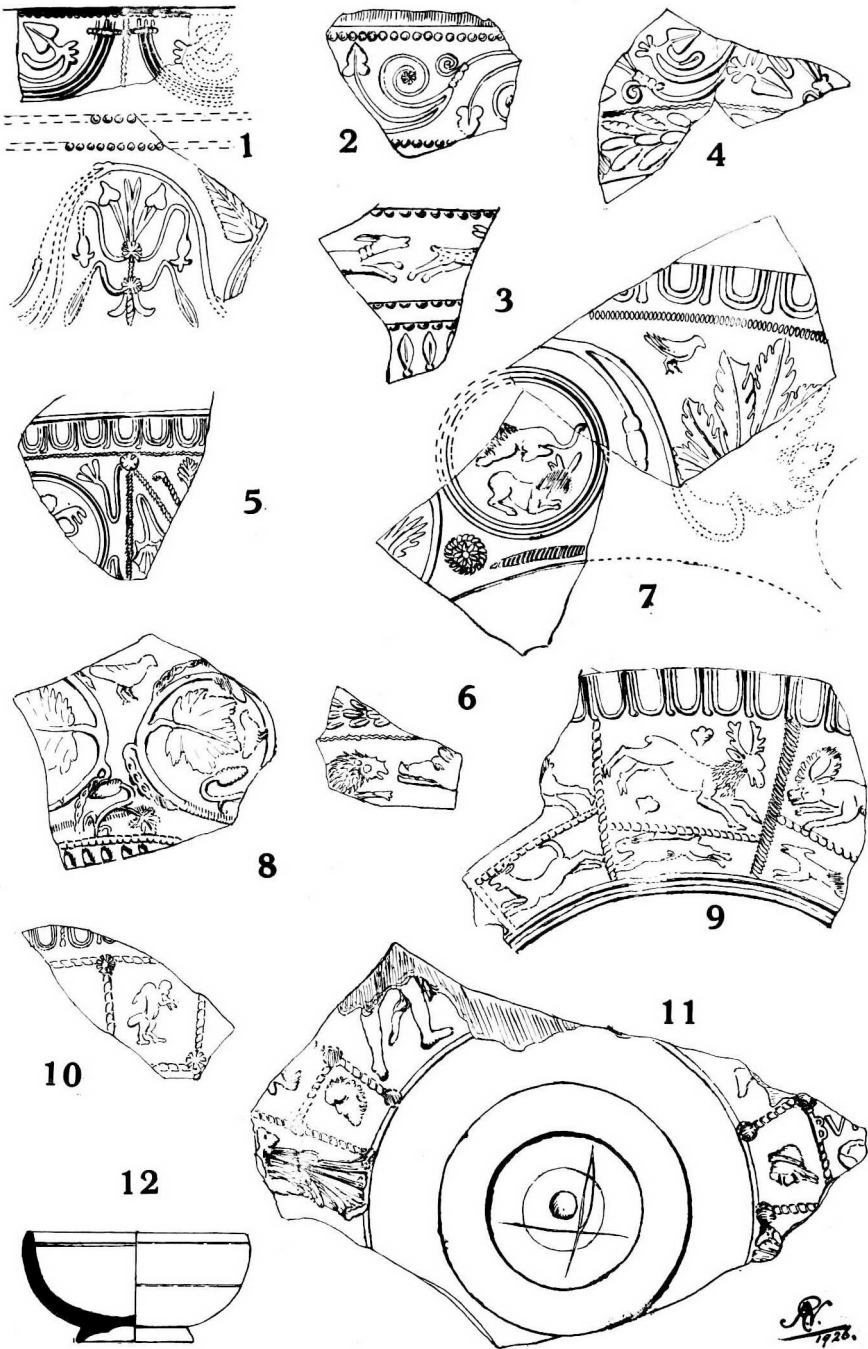

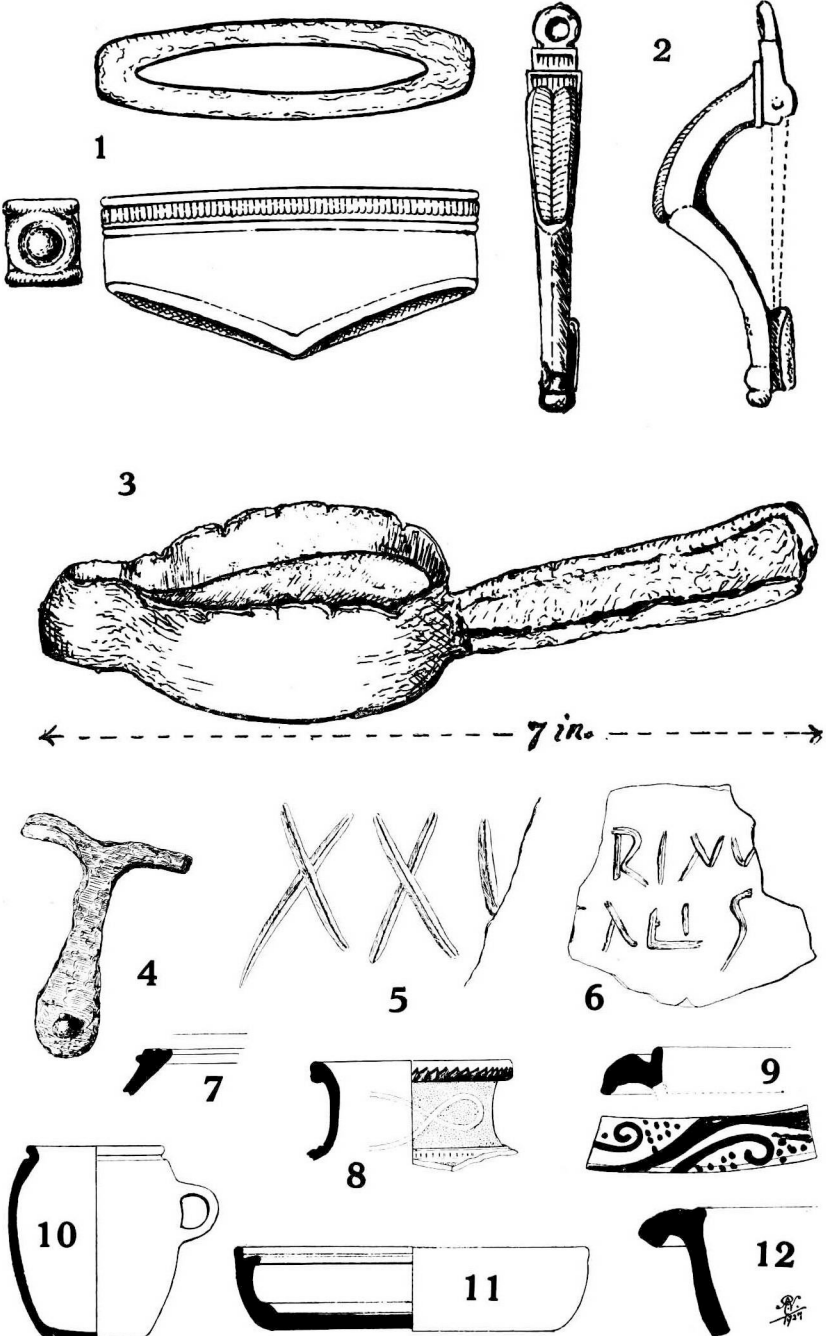

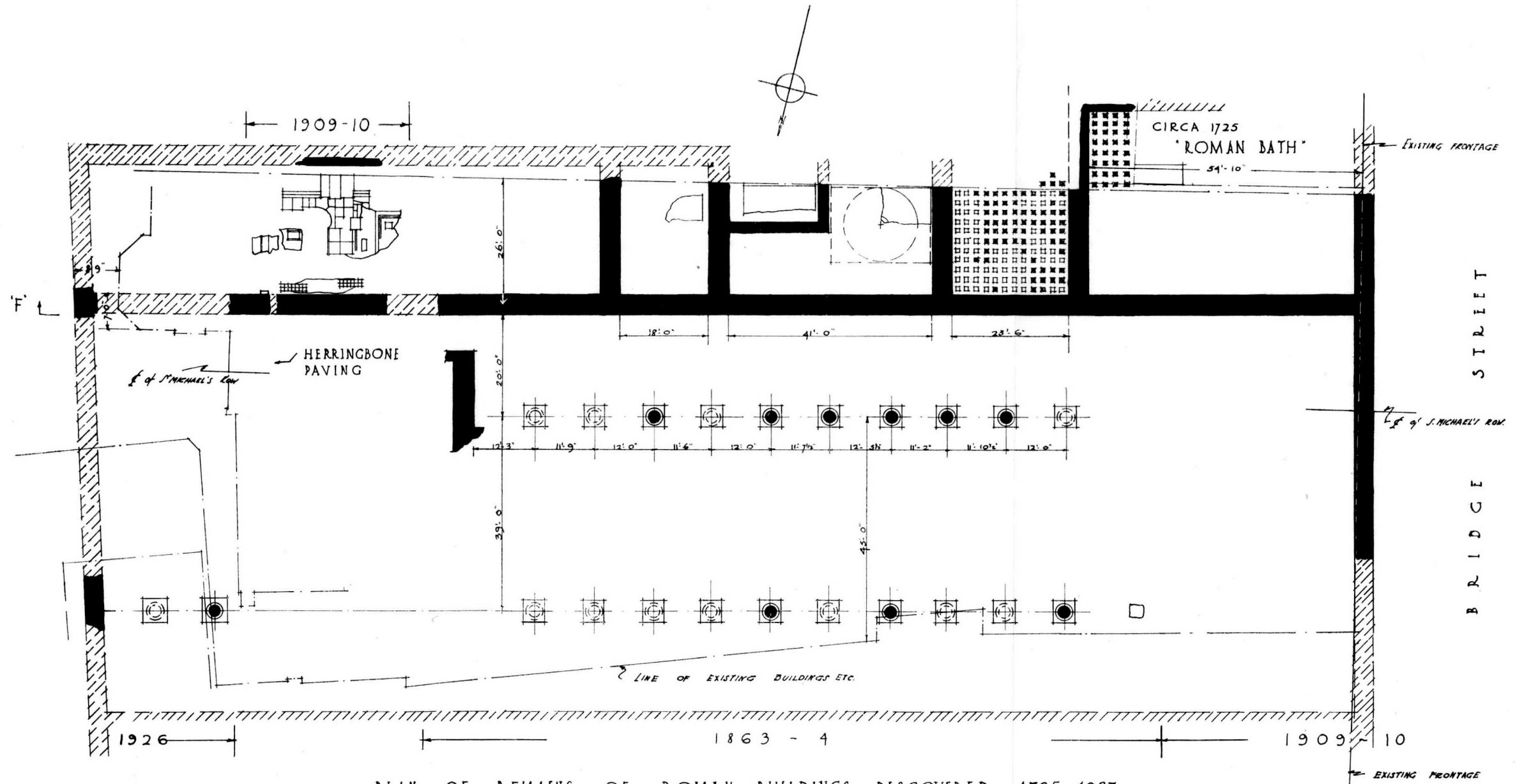

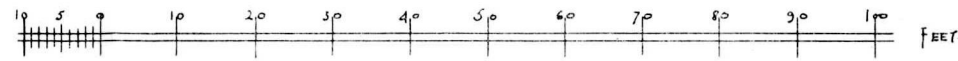

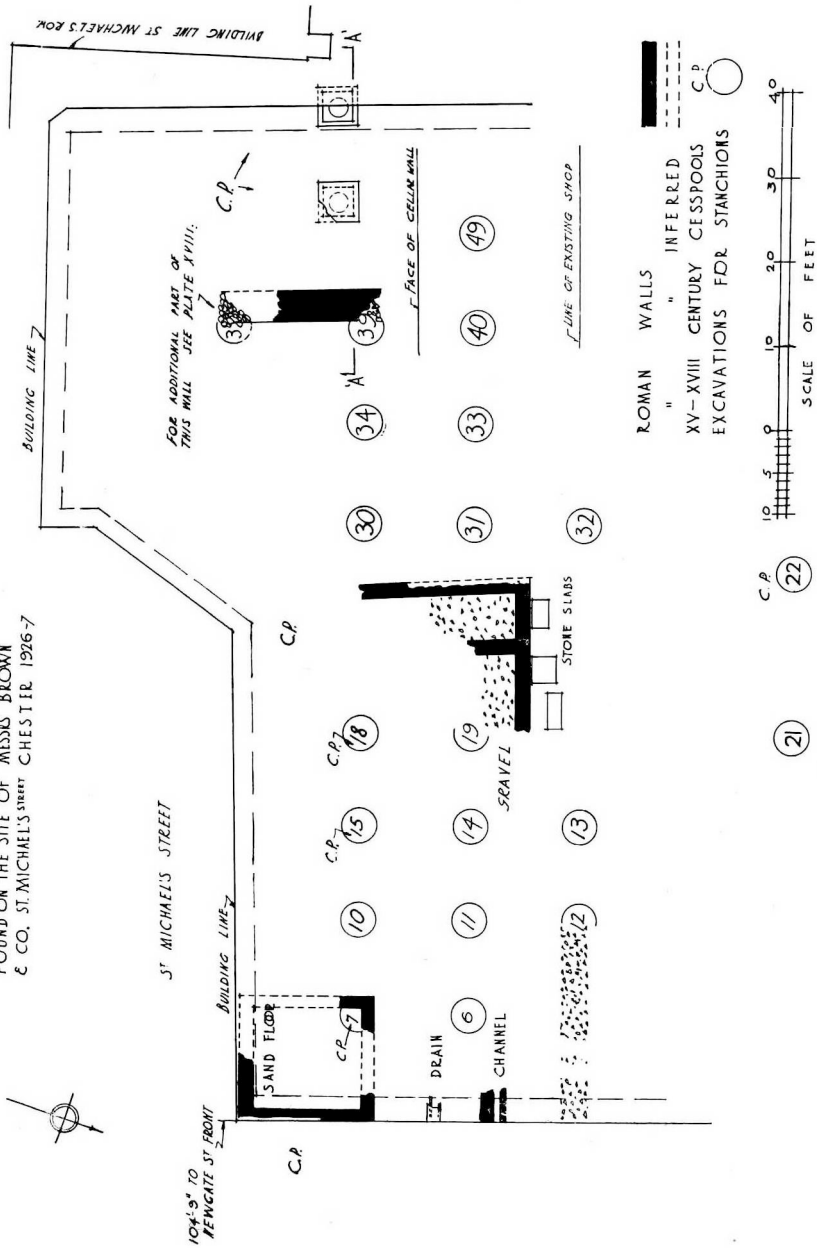
PLAN OF REMAINS OF ROMAN BUILDINGS DISCOVERED 1725-1927
ON THE SITE OF St. MICHAELS ARCADE CHESTER.



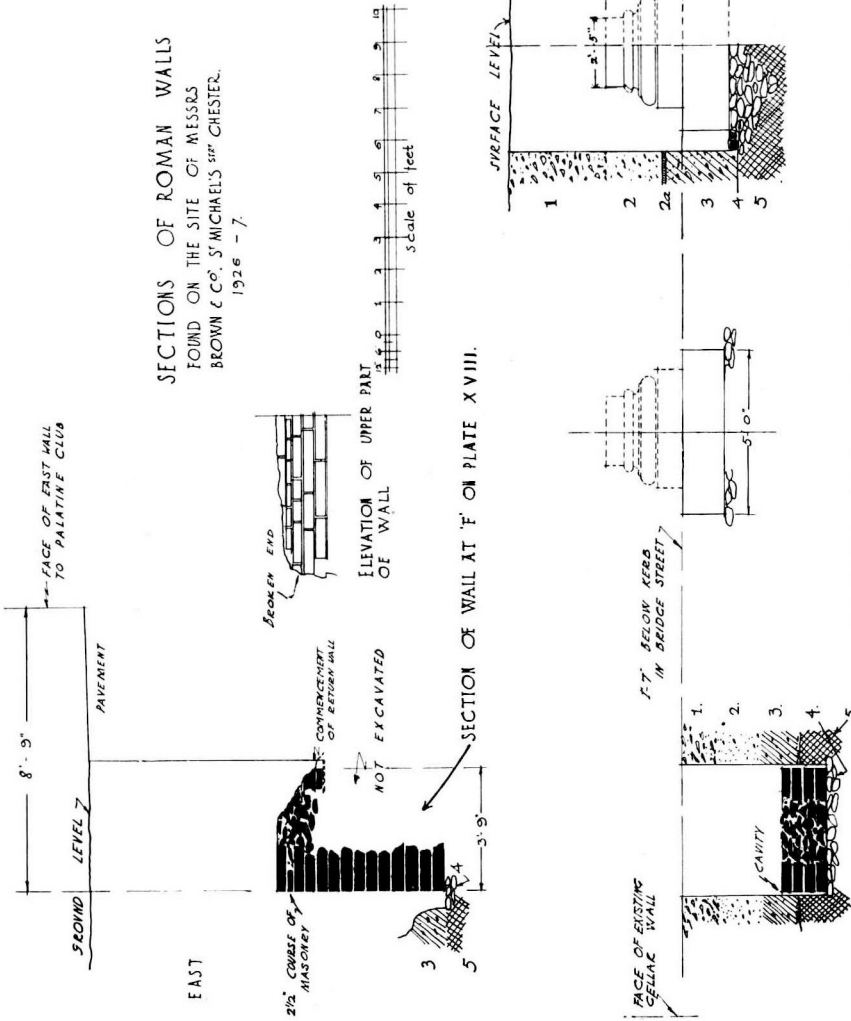

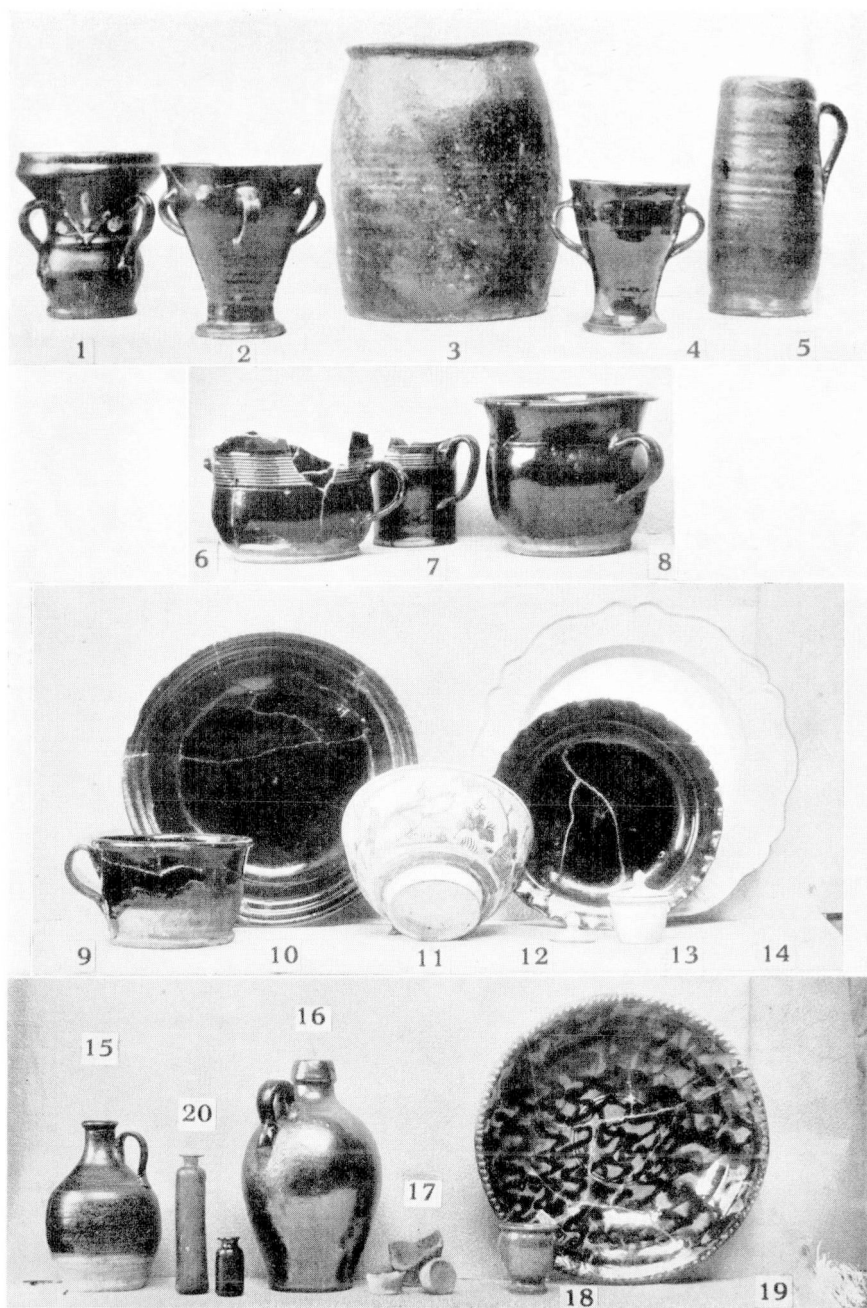
PLAN OF REMAINS OF ROMAN BUILDINGS

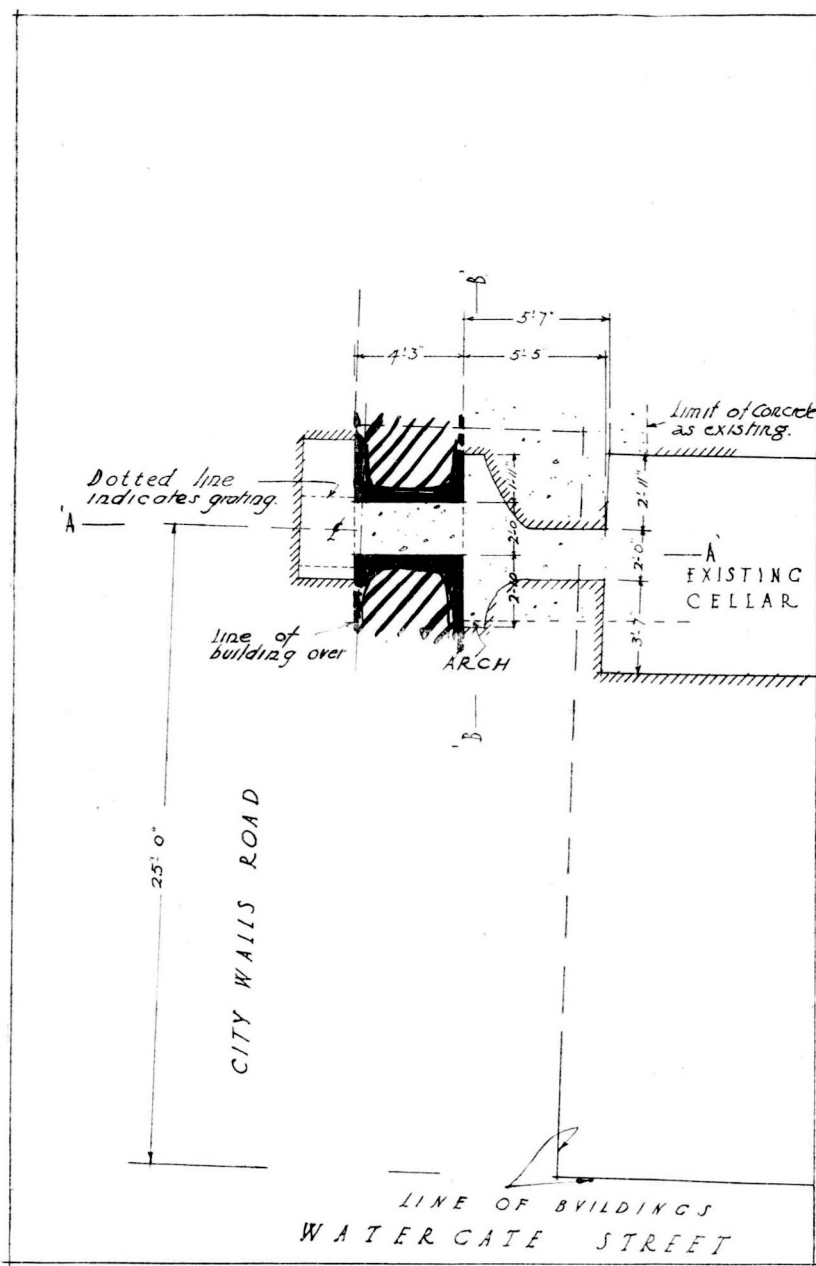

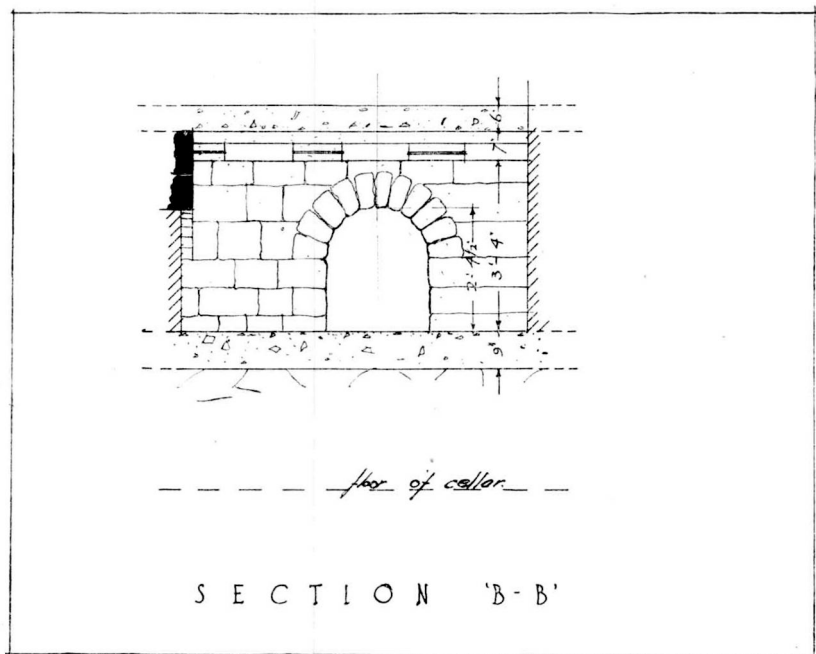

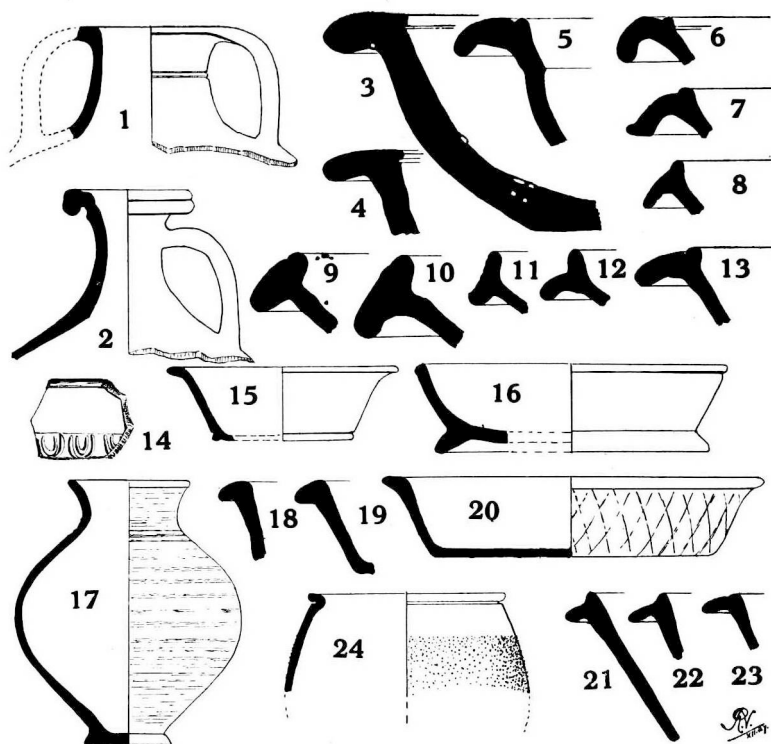

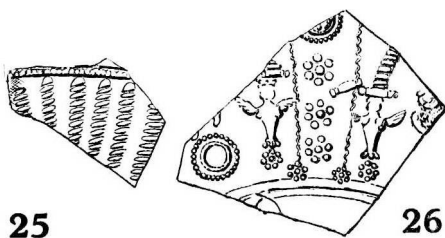

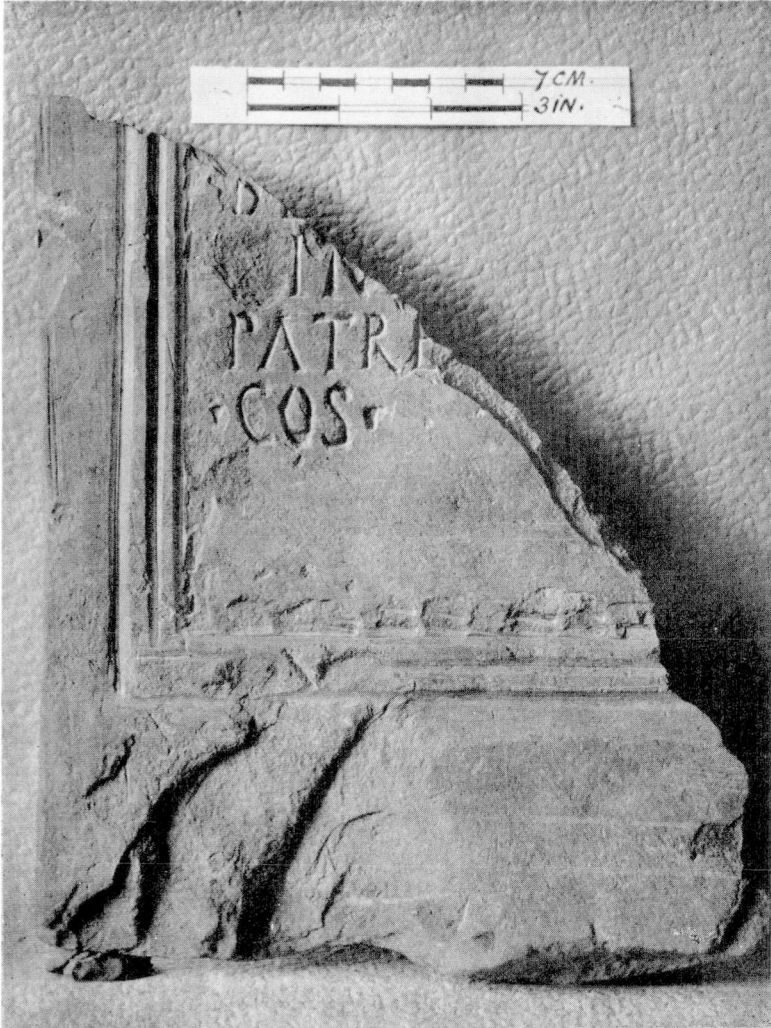


The Coarse pottery (quarter-size).

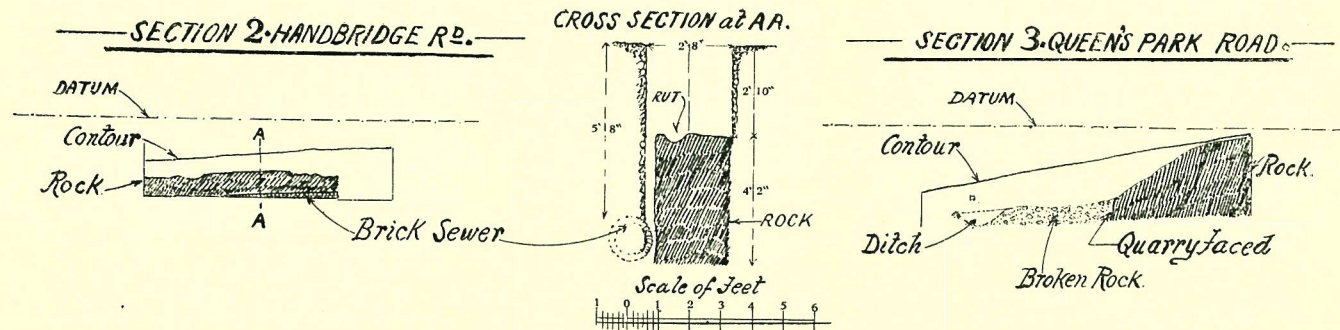

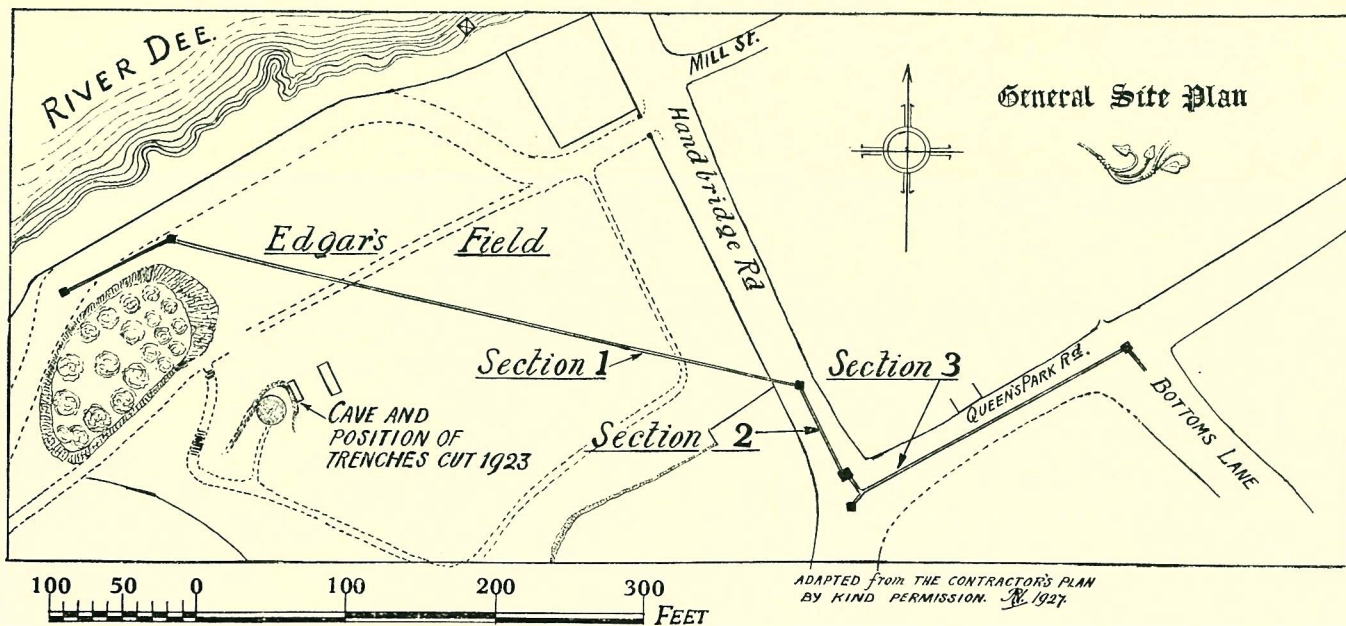
