The conical jug form above has only one parallel in the Chilvers Coton report (Mayes and Scott (1984, Fig. 19, 13) and the decoration is unparalleled. The form is found in London-type ware jugs (Pearce et al 1985) where it dates to c 1270-1310, although the decorative scheme is vertical and linear rather than, as here, horizontal/linear. Like the Cologne drinking jug from F2338 **Figure CD09.1-3**, the jug may have been discarded after the handle had broken.
